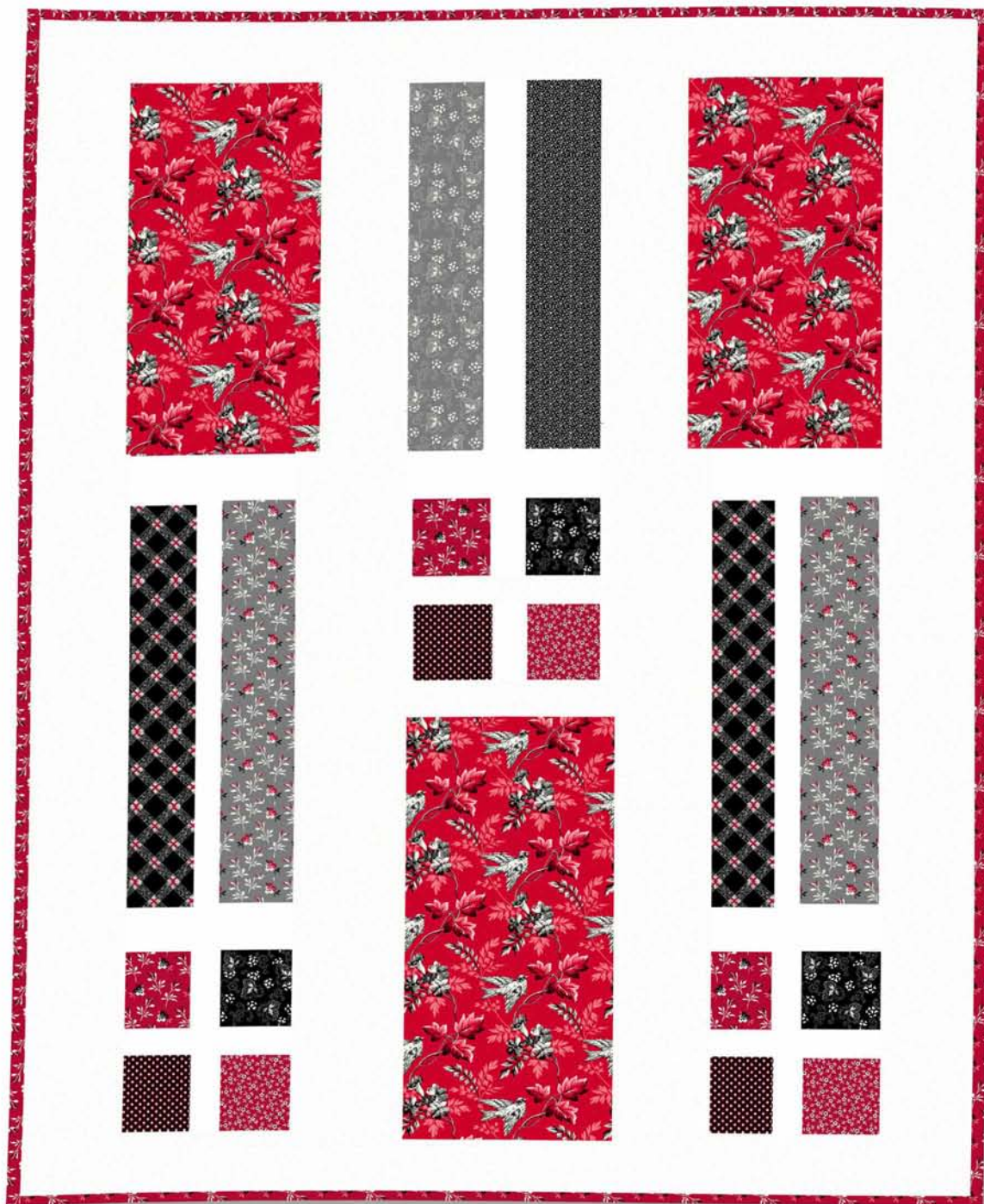

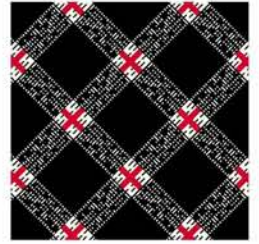

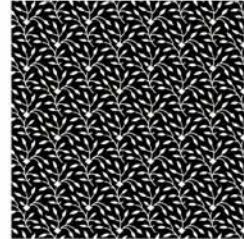

FABRIC & CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

FABRIC A: 39572-1 Red = $\frac{7}{8}$ yard

Cut 3 pieces $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "

FABRIC B: 39576-3 Grey = $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

FABRIC C: 39577-2 Black = $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

From each SKU Cut 1 piece $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "

FABRIC D: 39575-2 Black = $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

FABRIC E: 39573-3 Grey = $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

From each SKU Cut 2 pieces $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "

FABRIC F: 39576-2 Black = $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

FABRIC G: 39578-2 Black = $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

FABRIC H: 39574-1 Red = $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

From each SKU cut 3 pieces $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

FABRIC I: 39573-1 Red = 1 yard

Cut 3 pieces $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 7 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (used for $\frac{1}{2}$ " binding)

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FABRIC J 32190-3 * White on White = $3 \frac{1}{4}$ yard * from Ebony and Ivory

Cut 6 pieces $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (Width of Fabric)

From 3 of these strips cut 9 pieces $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the remaining strips Cut 3 pieces $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ ", from the remaining material cut 6 pieces $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 3 pieces $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Cut 4 pieces $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Cut 4 pieces $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

SEWING THE QUILT

FOUR PATCH BLOCK

- 1) Take the $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " pieces (FABRICS F, G, H and I) and the 6 - $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " and 3 - $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " of FABRIC J and arrange sew them together according to the following diagram. Make 3 sets.



COLUMN 1 AND 3 (Outer Columns)

- 1) Take one of the FABRIC A pieces ($12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ ") and sew a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip of FABRIC J to the bottom.
- 2) Take one of the FABRIC D and one of the FABRIC E ($5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ ") pieces and sew a FABRIC J $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " between the two, join this to the bottom of the unit you just sewed in step 1.
- 3) Sew a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip of FABRIC J to the bottom of the unit you just finished.
- 4) Add a four patch block to the bottom of this column.
- 5) Repeat these steps to create a second identical column.

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COLUMN 2 (Middle Column)

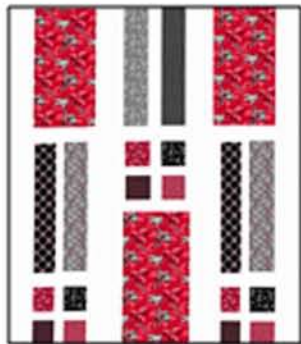
- 1) Take one of the FABRIC B and one of the FABRIC C (5 ½" x 24 ½") pieces and sew a FABRIC J 2 ½" x 24 ½" between the two.
- 2) Take one of the four-patch units you made and sew a 2 ½" x 24 ½" to the top and bottom of the block. Attach this new unit to the bottom of the unit you created in step 1.
- 3) Add a 12 ½" x 24 ½" piece of FABRIC A to the bottom of this column.

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP

- 1) Take the 5 ½" x WOF pieces of FABRIC J and splice them together on the diagonal to create 2 pieces 5 ½" x 64 ½". Sew these strips between columns 1 and 2 and between 2 and 3.



- 2) Take the 10 ½" x WOF pieces of FABRIC J and splice them together on the diagonal to create 2 pieces 10 ½" x 64 ½". Sew these strips to the outsides of Column 1 and 3.



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- 3) Take the $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF pieces of FABRIC J and splice them together on the diagonal to create 2 pieces $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ ".



FINISHING THE QUILT

- 1) Take the backing fabric ($5\frac{1}{4}$ yards) and cut into two equal pieces of $2\frac{3}{4}$ yards each. Cut off selvages and sew together creating a center seam.
- 2) Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Trim the quilted quilt.
- 3) BINDING: Sew the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Strips of FABRIC I together, Attaching binding sewing with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance to give a $\frac{1}{2}$ " finished binding.
