## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Snowflakes - White on White

- Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " strips.
- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $1^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $1^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric B: Snowflakes - Green

- Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric C: Palette - Saddle

- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2$ " strips.

Fabric D: Texture - True Red

- Cut two 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ strips and four $2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 103 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 123 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{4} \mathbf{"}^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one 2" $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two $211 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut five $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one 1 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1 " x 3 1/2" strips.
- Cut two $1^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric E: Winter Wishes Panel - Multi

- Cut one $103 / 4$ " block centered on the two snowmen (E-1).
- Cut one $14^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ block centered on the Christmas tree (E-2)
- Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ blocks. One centered on the birdhouse and one centered on the packages.
- Cut four $4 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ blocks, each centered on a gift tag.
- Cut one $23^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ block centered on the group of snowmen.
- Cut eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blocks, each centered on a red snowflake.

## Cutting Instructions - Continued:

Fabric F: Stacked Snowmen - Multi

- Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric G: Scenic - Deep Blue

- Cut three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric H: Texture - Cut Grass

- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric I: Scenic - Light Blue

- Cut two $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Fabric J: Presents - Red

- Cut one $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric K: Snowflakes - Light Blue

- Cut one $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips and twelve $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ strips.
- Cut one $2 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut four 2" x $221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut six $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 48 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

Backing: Boxes - Light Blue

- Cut two $68 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $68^{\prime \prime} \times 82^{\prime \prime}$ for the pieced back.

## Block Assembly:

1. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 103 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one $103 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E block ( $\mathrm{E}-1$ ). Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 123 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E (E-1) block. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make one Block One square (Fig. 1).
2. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each side of one $14^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E block (E-2). Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-2). Trim the block to measure $16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 18 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ to make one Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

3. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E block (E-3). Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-3). Trim the block to measure $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make one Block Three rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.
4. Sew one 2" $\times 7 \frac{1}{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric $D$ to each side of one $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E block (E-4). Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-4). Trim the block to measure $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ to make one Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make four Block Four rectangles total.

5. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4 "$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one $23^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4 "$ Fabric E block (E-5). Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-5). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make one Block Five rectangle (Fig. 5).
6. Sew one $1^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each side of one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip. Sew one $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F strip to make one Block Six rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make four Block Six rectangles total.

7. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each end of one $44 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric $G$ strip. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G strip to make one Block Seven rectangle (Fig. 7).

8. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to each side of one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make four Unit 1 strips total.

9. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.

10. Place another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance to make one Unit 2 strip (Fig. 12).
11. Repeat Steps $9-10$ to make four Unit 2 strips total.

12. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square to each end of one Unit 2 strip to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make four Unit 3 strips total.
13. Repeat Steps $9-10$ using four $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips and eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares to make four Unit 4 strips (Fig. 14).

14. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to each end of one Unit 4 strip to make one Unit 5 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make four Unit 5 strips total.
15. Repeat Steps $9-10$ using four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips and eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares to make four Unit 6 strips (Fig. 16).

16. Sew one Unit 6 strip to the top of one Unit 1 strip lengthwise. Sew one Unit 5 strip to the top of the new block lengthwise. Sew one Unit 3 strip to the top of the new block lengthwise. Sew one $1^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top of the new block lengthwise to make one Unit 7 block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Unit 7 blocks total.
17. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one Unit 7 block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block to make one Block Eight square (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Block Eight square.
18. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one Unit 7 block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block to make one Block Nine square (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Block Nine square.
19. Sew four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E blocks (E-6) and three $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric K strips together, alternating them, to make one Unit 8 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip.

Follow Figure 21 and sew two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strips, four Block Four rectangles, eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{112 " ~ F a b r i c ~ K ~ s t r i p s, ~ t w o ~}{} 6^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric K strips, four 2" $\times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strips, four Block Six rectangles, two Block three rectangles, two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strips and one Block Two rectangle together to make one Unit 9 block.

Quilt Top Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout on Page 10 while assembling the quilt top:
21. Sew one $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block Eight square, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Unit 8 strip, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block One square, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Unit 8 strip, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block Eight square and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 " \prime}$ Fabric K strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One.
22. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6{ }^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ Fabric K strip to each end of one Unit 7 strip. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 strip to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Three.
23. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block Nine square, one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block Five rectangle, one $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip, one Block Nine square and one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip to make Row Four.
24. Sew Row One, Row Two, the Unit 9 block, Row Three and Row Four together in that order to make the Center Block.
25. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481_{2 \prime \prime}^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $K$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
26. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

27. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J square to each end of one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
28. Layer and quilt as desired.
29. Sew the seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
30. Bind as desired.
