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Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Snowflakes - White on White

- Cut two 2 ½" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 2 ½" squares.
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2" x 4" strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.
- Cut one 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric B: Snowflakes - Green

- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric C: Palette - Saddle

• Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 ½" x 2" strips.

Fabric D: Texture - True Red

- Cut two 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 2" x 11" strips and four 2" x 7 ½" strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 1 ½" x 10 ¾" strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 1 ½" x 12 ¾" strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2 ½" x 16" strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2 ½" x 18" strips.
- Cut two 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 2" x 7 ½" strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ½" x 7 ¼" strips.
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2" x 7 3/4" strips.
- Cut two 2 ½" x 26" WOF strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Cut five 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1" x 3 ½" strips.
- Cut two 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1" x 6 ½" strips.
- Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric E: Winter Wishes Panel - Multi

- Cut one 10 ¾" block centered on the two snowmen (E-1).
- Cut one 14" x 16" block centered on the Christmas tree (E-2)
- Cut two 4 ½" x 11" blocks. One centered on the birdhouse and one centered on the packages.
- Cut four 4 ¼" x 7 ½" blocks, each centered on a gift tag.
- Cut one 23" x 7 3/4" block centered on the group of snowmen.
- Cut eight 2 ½" blocks, each centered on a red snowflake.



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Cutting Instructions - Continued:

Fabric F: Stacked Snowmen - Multi

• Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 3 ½" x 5 ½" strips.

Fabric G: Scenic – Deep Blue

• Cut three 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H: Texture – Cut Grass

- Cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric I: Scenic – Light Blue

- Cut two 5 ½" x 64 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Cut two 5 ½" x 50 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Fabric J: Presents - Red

• Cut one 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 5 ½" squares.

Fabric K: Snowflakes - Light Blue

- Cut one 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and twelve 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- Cut four 2" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- Cut one 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 1 ¾" x 2 ½" strips.
- Cut eight 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut six 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing: Boxes - Light Blue


• Cut two 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 68" x 82" for the pieced back.




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Block Assembly:

- 1. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ¾" Fabric D strip to each side of one 10 ¾" Fabric E block (E-1). Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ¾" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E (E-1) block. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" square to make one Block One square (Fig. 1).
- 2. Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16" Fabric D strip to each side of one 14" x 16" Fabric E block (E-2). Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-2). Trim the block to measure 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make one Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).




- 3. Sew one 2" x 11" Fabric D strip to each side of one $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" Fabric E block (E-3). Sew one 2" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-3). Trim the block to measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make one Block Three rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.
- 4. Sew one 2" x 7 ½" Fabric D to each side of one 4 ¼" x 7 ½" Fabric E block (E-4). Sew one 1 ½" x 7 ¼" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-4). Trim the block to measure 6 ½" x 8 ½" to make one Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make four Block Four rectangles total.






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
- 5. Sew one 2" x 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of one 23" x 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric E block (E-5). Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block (E-5). Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make one Block Five rectangle (Fig. 5).
- 6. Sew one 1" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one 5 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip. Sew one 1" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F strip to make one Block Six rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make four Block Six rectangles total.



7. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each end of one 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G strip to make one Block Seven rectangle (Fig. 7).



8. Sew one 2" x 4" Fabric A strip to each side of one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" Fabric C strip to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make four Unit 1 strips total.




9. Place one 2 ½" Fabric A square on the left side of one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.






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
- 10. Place another 2 ½" Fabric A square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make one Unit 2 strip (Fig. 12).
- 11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make four Unit 2 strips total.



- 12. Sew one $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to each end of one Unit 2 strip to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make four Unit 3 strips total.
- 13. Repeat Steps 9-10 using four 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strips and eight 2 ½" Fabric A squares to make four Unit 4 strips (Fig. 14).




- 14. Sew one 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric A strip to each end of one Unit 4 strip to make one Unit 5 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make four Unit 5 strips total.
- 15. Repeat Steps 9-10 using four 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strips and eight 2 ½" Fabric A squares to make four Unit 6 strips (Fig. 16).





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- 16. Sew one Unit 6 strip to the top of one Unit 1 strip lengthwise. Sew one Unit 5 strip to the top of the new block lengthwise. Sew one Unit 3 strip to the top of the new block lengthwise. Sew one 1" x 8 ½" Fabric A strip to the top of the new block lengthwise to make one Unit 7 block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Unit 7 blocks total.
- 17. Sew one 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one Unit 7 block. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block to make one Block Eight square (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Block Eight square.
- 18. Sew one 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one Unit 7 block. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 block to make one Block Nine square (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Block Nine square.
- 19. Sew four 2 ½" Fabric E blocks (E-6) and three 1 ¾" x 2 ½" Fabric K strips together, alternating them, to make one Unit 8 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip.





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20. Follow Figure 21 and sew two 1 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric K strips, four Block Four rectangles, eight 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strips, two 6 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric K strips, four 2" x 22 ½" Fabric K strips, four Block Six rectangles, two Block three rectangles, two 2 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric K strips and one Block Two rectangle together to make one Unit 9 block.




Quilt Top Assembly – Refer to the Quilt Layout on Page 10 while assembling the quilt top:

- 21. Sew one 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block Eight square, one 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric K strip, one Unit 8 strip, one 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block One square, one 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block Eight square and one 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric K strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One.
- 22. Sew one 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strip to each end of one Unit 7 strip. Sew one 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 strip to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 23. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block Nine square, one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block Five rectangle, one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric K strip, one Block Nine square and one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric K strip to make Row Four.
- 24. Sew Row One, Row Two, the Unit 9 block, Row Three and Row Four together in that order to make the Center Block.
- 25. Sew one 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 26. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.



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- 27. Sew one $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $64 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square to each end of one $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $50 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 28. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 29. Sew the seven
 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D
 strips together, end to
 end with 45-degree
 seams, to make the
 binding. Fold this long
 strip in half, lengthwise
 with wrong sides
 together, and press.
- 30. Bind as desired.
