Piece strips and subcut <br> (2) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |

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## BLOCK 1

1. Sew (2) $\mathbf{M} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) $\mathbf{D} 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, followed by sewing (2) $\mathbf{M} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom of $\mathbf{D}$.
2. Sew (2) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the opposite long sides of Step 1 unit, followed by (2) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom of same unit to complete (1) Block 1. Make (2). Block measures 12-1/2" x 15-1/2" unfinished.

3. Sew (2) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, as shown below, to make a row unit. Make (2).
4. Sew row units to the opposite long sides of (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to complete (1) Block 2, measuring 12-1/2" x 15-1/2" unfinished. Make (7).


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QUILT ASSEMBLY - Refer to quilt image for fabric placement guide.
5. Sew together Blocks 1 and 2 and (2) M 1-1/2" $\times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to make a pieced row. Make (3).
6. Sew pieced rows together, alternating with (2) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to complete quilt center.
7. Outer Border: Sew (2) M $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) M $3^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.
