## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE UNITS: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) G 5-1/2" square. Lay a marked square right sides together with (1) B 5-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" on opposite sides of the drawn line and cut on the line. Press each half-square triangle (HST) unit open and trim to measure 5" square. Make a total of (20) B/G HST units.
2. In the same way, make the indicated number of each HST combination shown below.

3. BLOCK UNITS: Lay out (2) B/G HST units, (1) B $5^{\prime \prime}$ square, and (1) H 5" square into a block as shown. Note proper rotation of HST units. Trim block to 9-1/2" square.
4. In same way, make remaining blocks units with remaining HST units as shown below.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY Refer to Quilt Diagram on page 3

5. ROW ASSEMBLY: Sew together (7) blocks into (8) rows as shown in Quilt Diagram.

Note proper placement of blocks. Sew rows together to complete quilt top.

## FINISHING

6. With the backing laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form the quilt sandwich.

Baste the sandwich and quilt as desired.
7. Bind using G 2-1/4" strips to finish the quilt.
