



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PIECED BLOCK

1. Sew together (1) A, B, C, and D 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle each, along the long sides.






2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **E** 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of **Step 1** unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another **E** square at the bottom right corner of the same unit to complete (1) **Pieced Block**. Block measures 8-1/2" square unfinished. Make (30).










Sew on drawn line.

Trim 1/4" from sewn line.

Copen and press to reveal
E corner. Repeat on the opposite corner.

Measures 8-1/2" square unfinished.

3. Pieced Rows: Noting orientation, arrange and sew together (5) Pieced Blocks, as shown. Make (6) rows.






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QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- 4. Sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.
- 5. Sew (2) **E** 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **E** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips to complete quilt top.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **F** 2-1/4" strips.
