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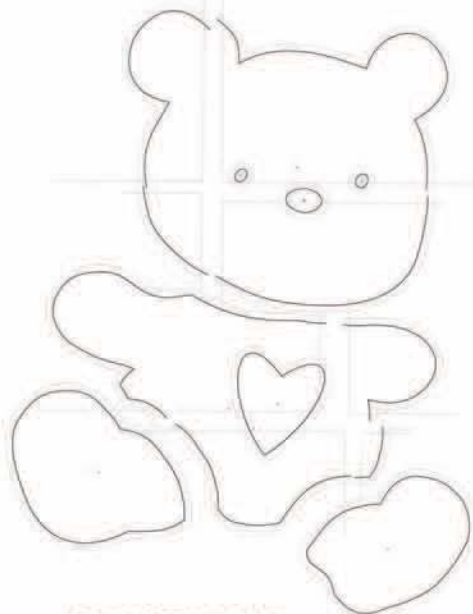
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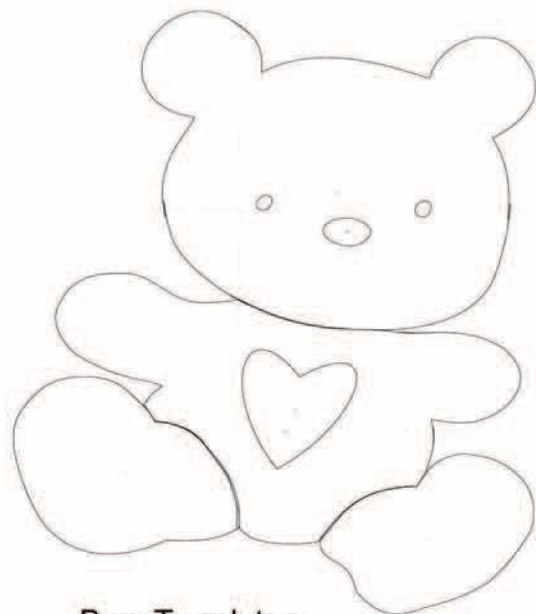

	32594-2 Pink	3/8 yard	Checkerboard squares
	32595-2 Pink	1 yard	Center square background and outer border
	32599-2 Pink	3/8 yard	Inner border, border cornerstones, heart and nose
	32597-4 Yellow	1/2 yard	Checkerboard squares and binding
	32599-4 Yellow	1/8 yard	Inner border cornerstones
	32600-2 Pink	1 1/2 yards	Fussy cut middle borders
	Fleece*	5/8 yard	Bear

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SAMPLE	SKU	CUTTING FOR THE QUILT
	32594-2 Pink	Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" wide x WOF. Cut 10 RECTANGLES 5 1/2" x 6 1/2".
	32595-2 Pink	Cut 1 piece 20 1/2" long x 30 1/2" wide. Make sure the stripe runs up and down as shown in the picture. Cut 5 strips 2 1/2" wide x WOF. Set aside for outer border. Do not cut finished lengths until quilt center is complete.
  Do not cut finished lengths until quilt center is complete.	32599-2 Pink	Cut 4 strips 1 1/2" wide x WOF. Set aside for border #1. Cut 1 strip 4 1/2" X WOF. Cut 4-4 1/2" squares for cornerstones of border #2. Trim remainder of strip down to 2 1/2". Cut 4-2 1/2" squares for cornerstones of outer border. Cut nose and heart using templates provided for trim on bear.
	32597-4 Yellow	Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" wide x WOF. Cut 10 RECTANGLES 5 1/2" x 6 1/2". Cut 6 strips 2 1/2" wide. Set aside for binding.
	32599-4 Yellow	Cut 1 strip 1 1/2". Cut 4-1 1/2" squares for cornerstones of border #1.
  Do not cut finished lengths until quilt center is complete.	32600-2 Pink	The fabric for the middle border is DIRECTIONAL. For side borders, cut 2 strips 42 1/2" along the length of fabric. The strip will be about 4 1/2" wide, but adjust width to make the motif complete with seams. For top and bottom borders, cut 2 strips 32 1/2" across the fabric. Cut the same width as the side borders.



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## Assembling the quilt center:

1. Alternating the pink and yellow rectangles, sew 4 rows of 5 rectangles. Begin two rows with pink and two rows with yellow.
2. Sew two rows together to make a checkerboard. Make two. Have one start with a pink rectangle and the other with a yellow rectangle. Refer to picture.
3. Sew one set of two rows to the top of the stripe block and two rows to the bottom. Refer to the picture.
4. Measure size of quilt center. Trim pink border #1 fabric to size of length of center. Sew to sides of quilt center. Trim pink border #1 fabric to size of width of quilt center. Add cornerstones. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
5. Repeat measuring and sewing borders as above for other borders.

## Finishing the quilt:

1. Make sandwich of quilt top, batting, and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Sew binding strips together with diagonal seams. Press in half. Bind edges.
4. Place bear onto quilt as desired. Refer to the picture or make up your own placement.
5. Attach to the quilt using your favorite applique method.
6. Add the heart, nose and eyes. Play with the placement to get exactly the facial expression you like! If you are having a hard time getting a face you like, tape the templates together and draw (in pencil!!) until you have what you want. Refer to the picture, but remember that it is this that will make each bear unique to your quilt!!
7. Mark the lines on the bear. Quilt into flurr with a narrow satin stitch. Define the nose, the forehead, the ears, feet, and body lines.
8. Wrap your baby girl up in the quilt and bear hug her well!
