SAMPLE	QTY	CUTTING FOR THE QUILT
 32396-X	3 1/2 yards	Allow extra to fussy cut blocks and borders with directional cuts. You need 8 of the desired motifs after the borders are cut. Quilt center: Cut 8 blocks 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" square centering desired motifs within block. Border #6: Cut 2 strips lengthwise 66" x 5" for sides. Cut 6 strips 5" x remaining WOF(about 30"). Piece 3 crosswise strips. Make 2. Trim each to 74 1/2" long for top and bottom.
 32395-X	1 1/4 yards	Allow extra to fussy cut blocks. You need 8 of the desired motif. Save leftovers for placemats and napkins. Quilt center: Cut 8 blocks 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" square centering desired motifs within block.
 32401-6	1 1/8 yards	For sashing strips and cornerstones. Sashing: Cut 28 strips 1 1/8" wide. Save leftovers for placemats and napkins. Cornerstones: Cut 5 strips 1 3/8" wide. Cut 25 pieces 3 1/2" long. Cut 25 pieces 3 3/8" long. Save leftover for placemats and napkins.
 32399-4	1 yard	For sashing strips and cornerstones. Sashing: Cut 14 strips 1 3/4" wide. Save leftovers for placemats. Cornerstones: Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" wide. Cut 25 2 1/2" squares. Divide squares diagonally. Save leftovers for placemats and napkins.
 32398-4	1/4 yard	For border #1. (Starch well to maintain stability of narrow strips.) Cut 6 strips 1" x WOF. Piece together. Cut 2 pieces 53" long for sides. Cut 2 pieces 54" long for top and bottom.
 32398-2	1/2 yard	For border #2. Cut 6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Piece together. Cut 2 pieces 54" long for sides. Cut 2 pieces 58" for top and bottom.
 32398-3	3/4 yard	For border #3 and binding. Border: (Starch well to maintain stability of narrow strips.) Cut 6 strips 1" x WOF. Piece together. Cut 2 pieces 58" long for sides. Cut 2 pieces 59" for top and bottom. Binding: Cut 8 strips 2 1/4" wide x WOF. Piece together for binding. Finish binding 3/8" wide.
 32397-2	1 3/4 yards	Fussy cut border #4 with directional cuts: Cut 2 strips lengthwise 59" x 3 1/2" for sides. Cut 4 strips across 3 1/2" x remaining WOF(about 33"). Piece 2 crosswise strips. Make 2. Trim to 65" long for top and bottom. Save leftovers for placemats and napkins.
 32401-1	3/8 yard	For border #5. (Starch well to maintain stability of narrow strips.) Cut 8 strips 1" wide. Piece together. Cut 2 pieces 65" long for sides. Cut 2 pieces 66" long for top and bottom.
 32398-3	4 5/8 yards	For backing. Cut in half crosswise. Seam together to make backing about 83" wide.
Batting		80" x 80"



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Assembling the quilt

You will need standard quilting tools and rulers.
A 2 1/2" square ruler is helpful but not required.
1/4" seams allowed unless otherwise noted.
WASH ALL FABRICS TO PRE-SHRINK.

-Make cornerstones: Sew bias side of triangles to each side of 3 1/2" flowered strip. Cut diagonally across the flowered strip. Sew a unit to each side of 3 3/8" strip matching the centers carefully. Trim to 2 1/2" square. Make 25.



-Make sashing: Strip piece 1 1/8" flower to each side of blue and yellow check. Cut 40 units 10 1/2" wide. Save leftovers for placemats.

-Make sashing rows: Starting and ending with a cornerstone, sew 4 sashing pieces with cornerstones in between. Make 5 rows.

-Make block rows: Starting and ending with sashing, sew 4 block centers, alternating fabrics, with sashing in between. Make 2 rows. Make two more rows starting with the alternate fabric from the first two you made. Make 2 rows.

-Make Quilt Center: Alternating block rows to create a checkerboard effect, sew sashing rows in between block rows. Sew a sashing row to top and bottom of quilt. Make sure to match seams and corners carefully.

-Add borders: Add each border in order starting with #1 and working out. Always sew the side borders first, then add the top and the bottom borders. Then move on to #2 etc.

-Make quilt sandwich: Smooth backing out on a clean flat surface. Layer batting and quilt on top. Pin and/or baste well.

-Quilt as desired. Trim evenly squaring sides and bind as directed. stick out like a pocket handkerchief. Roll up and tie. Arrange in a basket for your guests. Have fun!!



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FOR PLACEMATS: 18" x 14" Finished. Fussy cut centers 13" x 9". Make sashing and cornerstones the same as the quilt, but cut 2 sashing units 13" long for top and bottom and 2 units 9" long for sides. Add backing and batting. Quilt as desired. For each placemat, make a tie to finish 3/8" x 18". Fold in half. Insert into binding on back 4" down from the top. Bind to finish 1/4" wide.



FOR NAPKINS: Use all the leftover fabric. Cut squares 14". Hem or bind as desired.



FOR PICNIC: Place a set of utensils about 4" up from bottom of mat. Fold up bottom of mat to form a pocket. Gather napkin attractively on top to stick out like a pocket handkerchief. Roll up and tie. Arrange in a basket for your guests. Have fun!!

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
