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


	2 yards	34078-X Multi	Narrow Outer Border 20 Border Triangles 8 Border Triangles 4 Border Squares	Cut 8-2 1/2" strips Make 2-2 1/2" x 84 1/2" Make 2-2 1/2 x 88 1/2" Cut 2-13 1/4" strips cut 5-13 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice. Cut 1-6 7/8" strip. Cut 4-6 7/8" squares. Cut each square on the diagonally once. Cut 1-6 1/2" strip. Cut 4-6 1/2" squares.
	3/4 yard	34079-1 Brown	96 Star Points 12 Star Center Squares	Cut 3-5 1/4" strips. Recut into 24-5 1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. Cut 2-4 1/2" strips. Recut into 12 squares.
	1 1/4 yard	34079-2 Pink	4 Border Squares 1 Center Square 84 Sawtooth Border Triangles	Cut 1-4 1/2 strip. Recut 4-4 1/2" squares. Cut one more 4 1/2 " square.. Cut 9-2 5/8 " strips. Using template cut 84 Sawtooth triangles.
	1/3 yard	34080-2 Pink	48 Triangles	Cut 2- 5 1/4" strips. Recut into 12-5 1/4" squares. Cut diagonally twice.
	1 1/4 yard	34082-3 Tan	48 Background Squares 48 Background Triangles	Cut 6-4 1/2" strips. Recut into squares. Cut 2-5 1/4" strips. Recut into 12-5 1/4" squares. Cut diagonally twice.



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	7/8 yard	34082-4 Red	24 Border Triangles	Cut 2-13 1/4" strips. Recut into 6-13 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice. diagonally xxxx twice.
	1 1/4 yards	34084-4 Red	80 Sawtooth Border Triangles 4 Border Squares 60 Triangles	Cut 9-2 5/8 " strips. Using template cut 80 triangles. Cut 4-2 1/2" squares. Cut 2-5 1/4" strips. Recut into 15-5 1/2" squares. Cut diagonally twice
	3/4 yard	34085-1 Brown	Border Strips	Cut 4-4 1/2" strips. Make 2-4 1/2"x 64 1/2". Make 2-4 1/2"x 72 1/2".
	3/4 yard	34085- 3 Tan	96 Star Points 12 Star Center Squares	Cut 3-5 1/4" strips. Recut into 24-5 1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. Cut 2-4 1/2" strips. Recut into 12 squares.
	3/4 yard	34083-3 Tan	52 background triangles 12 Background Squares	Cut 2-5 1/4" strips. Recut into 13 squares. Cut diagonally twice. Cut 2-4 1/2" strips, recut into 12 squares.

Hints

- Use inexpensive white paper plates to organize your cut strips and pieces. They can be written on for reminders and to aid in keeping count of your pieces. They can be stacked on top of each other to save for a future sewing time. And re-used over and over.
- I mix a solution of half starch and half water in a spray bottle for use before ironing. I think it results in more accurate cutting.
- Check and double check that you are actually sewing an accurate 1/4 inch seam.
- The template for the first border is not the same size on each side! Mark your template so you know which side is the bottom-- include seam allowance! (The 'A' should be right side up.) The bases of the 'A's are the outside edges of the first border.



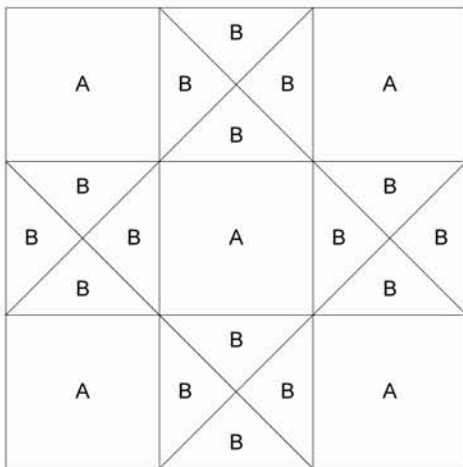
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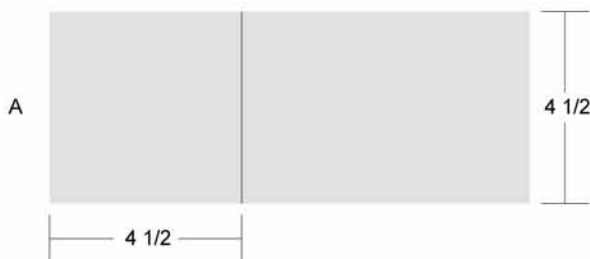
Reach for the Stars

(Refer often to the pictures be sure to use the correct fabrics for each star.)

1. First make the one center red star. Refer to the diagram and lay out the correct pieces. For the star you will need 4 tan background squares, 4 tan background triangles, 12 red triangles and 1 pink square.
2. Sew the star point unit first. Join 2 red triangles on the short side to make a larger half square triangle. Repeat with 1 red triangle and 1 tan triangle. Now join the 2 halves together careful to align the center seams. Make 4 units. Press seams open as you go.
3. Referring to the block picture sew the units as pictured to the background and center squares. Press seams to alternate sides.



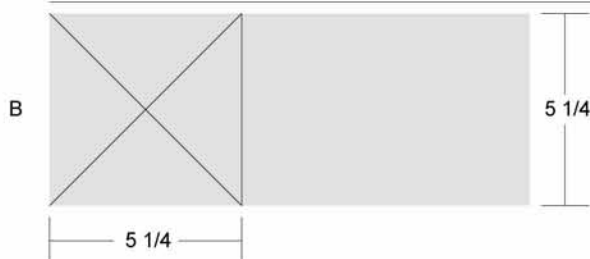

Star Point Unit



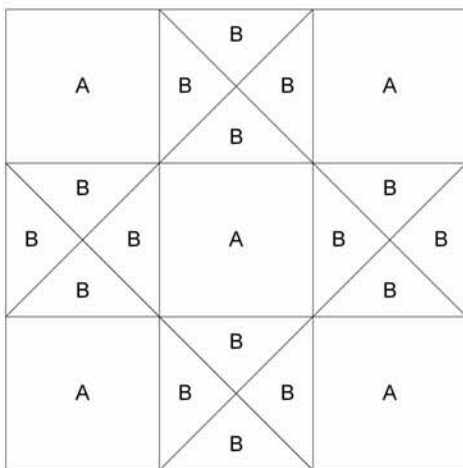

12 Brown Stars

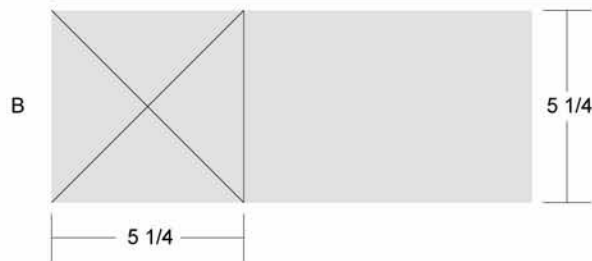
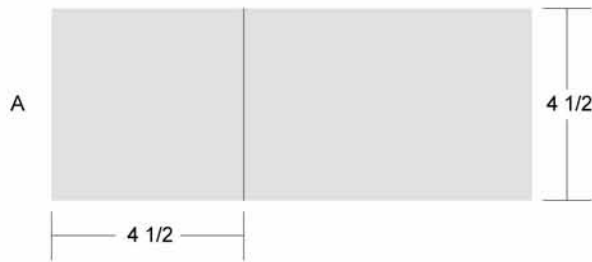
1. For the brown stars you will need 48 tan background squares and 48 tan triangles, 12 brown squares and 48 pink triangles.
2. Refer to the picture and make 48 star point units.
3. Join them to the background and center squares as described above. Press as usual.

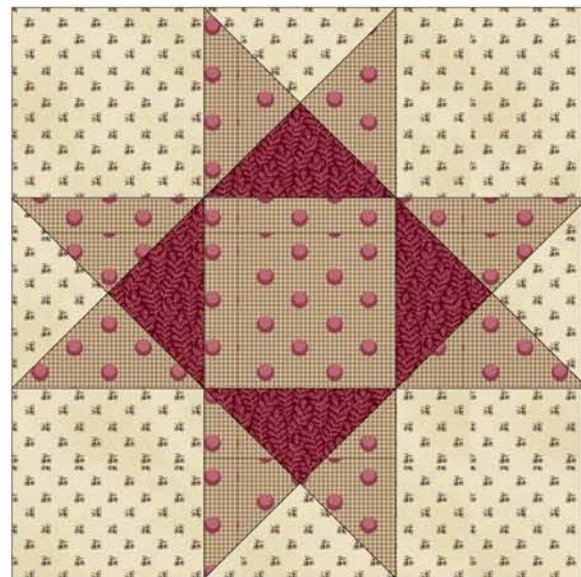
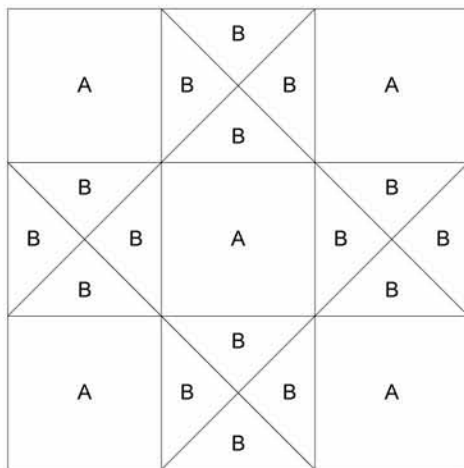

12 Dk. Tan Stars

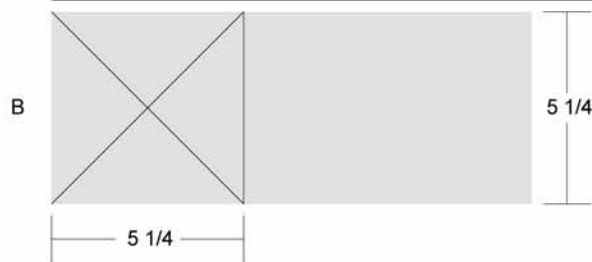
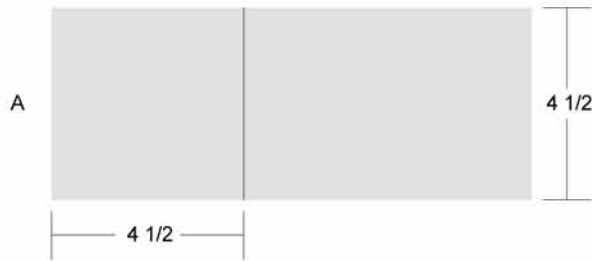
1. For the tan stars you will need 48 tan background squares and 48 dk. tan triangles, 12 dk. tan squares and 48 red triangles.
2. Refer again to the picture and make 48 star point units.
3. Join them to the center dk. tan squares and to the tan background squares. Press as usual.
4. Sew the Ohio star blocks together in rows then join the rows together as pictured.

The Sawtooth Border

1. This dynamic border treatment is challenging! But definitely worth the effort. Gather your precut template triangles - 84 pink and 80 red.
2. The long side of the triangles are the outside of the border. The reds all are on the star block top side. And the pink are all on the side toward the brown border. Each of the sides of the Sawtooth border begin and end in pink triangles. Trim to correct length.
3. Each of the long sides require 21 pinks and 20 reds. First sew them in 20 pairs one half pink and one half red, joining the short sides together to make a diamond. Sew the assembled border strip to the sides of the top. Trim the excess pink half triangle even with the sides of the quilt top.
4. Measure the assembled Sawtooth border for accuracy and trim off extra pink half triangles. Add the red squares to the ends of your 2 borders and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

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Solid Brown Border

1. Measure the length of the top and join two brown strips and cut to that length and sew to the long side of the top. (Approximately.) Two $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$ and two $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 72\frac{1}{2}''$.
2. Repeat the steps above, deducting for the pink square corner stones. Sew the pink squares to the ends and join to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Large Red and Brown Floral Border

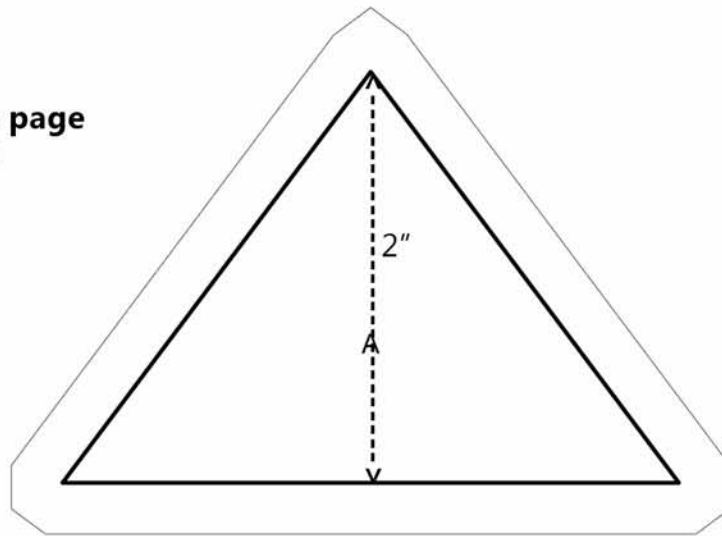
1. You will need the 24 red border triangles, the 20 brown floral border triangles and the 8 brown floral triangles and the 4 brown floral squares.
2. Using the Sawtooth border piecing technique...join the short sides of the two different colored triangles to make a diamond. Make 5 pairs join the pairs and add a brown triangle to each end. Make 4 of these pieced borders. Sew one to the top the other to the bottom.
3. Sew the 4 brown floral squares to the remaining pieced border strip ends.
4. (Pre-checking for correct lengths.) Sew the assembled narrow brown floral borders to the long sides and then to the top and bottom.

Finishing

Quilt and bind your quilt using your favorite method. **ENJOY!**
