

Use spray starch on the narrow borders to help stabilize the pieces. Save leftover fabric for bindings and backings on the accessories!

SAMPLE	KEY/ SKU	QTY	PLACEMENT IN THE QUILT
※ ※ 	36126-X	1 Panel	Quilt center. See instructions for trimming motifs to size. Should finish 28 1/2" wide x 21 1/2" long.
A Sangara	36128-X	7/8 yd	Music Border. Cut on length Cut 2 pieces 4" wide x 28 1/2" long.
XXXX	36132-3	1/4 yd	Border #1. Cut on WOF. •Cut 2 pieces 28 1/2" long x 1 1/2" for side borders. •Cut 2 pieces 30 1/2" long x 1 1/2" for top and bottom borders.
	36130-1	1/2 yd	Border #2 Cut on WOF •Cut 2 pieces 30 1/2" x 4 1/2" for side borders. •Cut 2 pieces 38 1/2" x 4 1/2" for top and bottom borders.
*****	36132-1	<mark>7/8</mark> yd	Border #3. Cut on WOF •Cut 2 pieces 38 1/2" x 1 1/2" for side borders. •Cut 2 pieces 40 1/2" x 1 1/2" for top and bottom borders. Binding-Cut 7 strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Seam together with diagonal seams. Press in half. Letters- Follow Templates for letters
	36132-2	1 1/2 yds	Border #4 cut on length •Cut 2 pieces 40 1/2" x 4 1/2" for side borders. •Cut 3 pieces 48 1/2" x 6 1/2" for top and bottom borders.
90000 00000000000000000000000000000000	36129- X	3 yds	Cut in half crosswise. Sew together along the length. Save trimmings!!!





Making the quilt:

- 1. Cut a 7 1/2" square out of template plastic. Carefully center the template on top of one of the "days" and make marks that will let you place the template in the same place on each one of the "days".
- 2. Carefully trim each "day" to 7 1/2".
- 3. Put the "days" in order from 1 to 12. Sew 1, 2, 3, and 4 into a row.
- 4. Make two more rows using the rest of the "days".
- 5. Sew the three rows together.
- 6. Measure the center. It should be 28 1/2" x 21 1/2".
- 7. Sew the "music" border to the top and the bottom of the center.
- 8. Add the gold border to the sides.
- 9. Add the gold border to the top and bottom.
- 10. Repeat with the other borders as listed on the cutting chart.
- 11. Using the "Merry Christmas" graphic provided, turn the lettering upside down and with a light box or window, trace the letters onto the paper side of double sided fusible (such as steam a seam). Follow the manufacturer's directions for fusing.
- 12. Carefully cut out the letters and fuse to the top border of the quilt. Follow the placement as shown in the picture.
- 13. Create a sandwich of the top, batting and backing.
- 14. Quilt as desired, but I would suggest stitching the edges of the letters down and once again echo the letters about 1/16" outside the letter. This technique will make the letters stand out nicely.
- 15. Trim and bind.
- 16. Hang on the wall impress your family and friends by knowing all the words to "The 12 Days of Christmas!"
- 17. Enjoy!
