


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















Fabric Requirements:

7/8 yard 35370-2 Black (includes binding)

5/8 yard 39024-X Multi

1/8 yard 39023-1 Black

3/8 yard 39020-X Multi

1/4 yard 39021-3 Red

Scraps of Green solid

1 Fat quarter 39019-X Multi

1 yard Backing

### **Cutting:**

35370-2 Black solid

Cut (1) 17" x 20 1/2" rectangle for center

Cut (4) 2 1/4" x width of fabric strips for binding

39024-X Multi ipads and notebooks

Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips for side borders

39020-X Multi computer keyboards

Fussy cut (2) 26 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips centering the keyboard for top and bottom borders Note: you will lose a row of keyboards inbetween the strips you cut

39023-1 Black stacks of books

Cut (1) 26 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip for bottom middle border

39021-3 Red pencils

Cut (1) apple following apple template provided on page 3.

39019-X Multi award icons

Fussy cut a minimum of 6 icons to scatter onto the center section of quilt top Note: this is the perfect time to pick one for a special teacher and personalize it with their name


Green scraps

Cut (1) apple stem and leaves for top of apple using template provided.

#### Assembly:

- 1. Take apple, stem pieces and icons and lay them onto the black center fabric. Arrange them following the picture or as you like. Make sure you place them at least 2" from the outer edge. Applique following your favorite method. We used Misty Fuse® on the back to secure the position, then added a zigzag stitch around the outside edge in a matching color.
- 2. Take the (2) ipad and notebooks strips and attach them to each side of the center rectangle.
- 3. Take the (1) stack of books strip and add it to the bottom.
- 4. Take (1) computer keyboard strip and attach it to the top. Take the other strip and attach it to the bottom.
- 5. Take the completed top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- 6. Take the binding strips and sew them together then bind off your quilt.

This also makes a perfect wall hanging so you might want to add a rod pocket at the top back of the quilt before you add the binding.
