Subcut (82) 1-1/2" x 8" rectangles.</p> <p>INNER BORDER: (7) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and Subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 55" strips, and (2) 2-3/4" x 67-1/2" strips.</p>




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
Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Corner unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" **P** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3-1/2" **<fabric 1>** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **P** corner triangle.


Repeat with another 2" **<fabric 2>** square at the opposite corner of the same **<fabric 1>** square to complete (1) corner unit, measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (4) corner units.



2. Middle unit. Sew (1) 2" **P** square and (1) 2" **<fabric 2>** square to make a middle unit, measure 2" x 3 1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (4) middle units.




3. Sew (2) corner units to the opposite long sides of (1) middle unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.



4. Sew (2) corner units to the opposite sides of (1) 2" **<fabric 2>** square to make a row unit.



5. Sew all row units to make a pieced block, measuring 8" x 8" raw edge to raw edge.





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
6. Make a total number of blocks in the following P/<fabric 1>/<fabric 2> combinations:

(6) Blocks: P/K/L, P/D/M, P/R/E, P/H/N, P/I/F, P/T/O, and P/S/Q

(3) Blocks: P/C/J and P/B/G

Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (6) pieced blocks and (5) 1-1/2" x 8" P sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.





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2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (6) 1-1/2" x 8" **P** sashing rectangles and (5) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" tonal prints cornerstones to make a pieced sashing row.

Make a total number of (2) pieced sashing strips for **O, N, M** cornerstones.

Make a total number of (1) pieced sashings trip for **E** cornerstones.

3. Arrange and sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border. Sew (2) 2-3/4" x 67-1/2" **P** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2-3/4" x 55" **P** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.


2. Outer border. Sew (2) 4" x 72" **A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4" x 62" **A** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

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Finishing

1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together.
2. Baste and quilt as desired.
3. Attach **N** binding to complete quilt.
