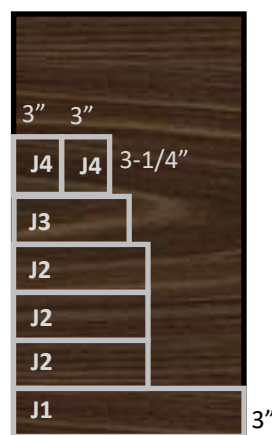
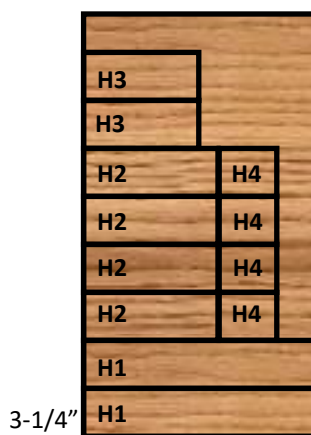

A		50352-1 Sapphire	3/8 YD	(2) 5-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (14) 5-1/2" squares A1
B		50352-2 Amethyst	5/8 YD	(1) 11" X WOF strip, subcut (3) 11" squares B2 and (2) 5-1/2" squares B1 (1) 5-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut (7) 5-1/2" squares B1
C		50354-1 Sapphire	1-7/8 YD	(1) 11" X WOF strip, subcut (2) 11" squares C2 and (4) 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangles C3 (2) 5-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" squares C1 (7) 3" X WOF strips, sew together via short ends. See Border Assembly for subcut measurements. FOR BINDING: (7) 2-1/4" X WOF strips, sew short ends together

F		37098-6 Mustard	1-1/8 YD	(1) 11" X WOF strip, subcut (3) 11" squares F2 (1) 5-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares F1 (4) 1-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" X 19-1/2" strips F4, (8) 1-1/2" X 10-1/2" strips F5 and (2) 1-1/2" X 9-1/2" strips F6 (6) 1-1/2" X WOF strips, sew together via short ends. **General Instructions:**

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.



# At the Cross

Piecing Instructions: (Refer to images below)

## Block 1A - 1G:

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) C2 square and place right sides together with (1) D2 square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of drawn line, then cut on drawn line. Press HST units open, square to 10-1/2".
2. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) A1 square and place right sides together with on the C corner. Sew on the drawn line, then press. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Square to 10-1/2", make (1) BLOCK 1A.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using chart below to complete remainder of BLOCK 1s. *Note: you will have (1) CD HST unit and (1) BC HST unit left over for another project.*

## Block 2A - 2M:

4. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (8) A1, (3) B1, (8) C1, (5) D1, (2) F1 and (3) G1 squares.
5. Place (1) A1 square with right sides together on the left side of (1) C3 rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on right side with another A1 square. Square to 5-1/2" X 10-1/2", make (2) BLOCK 2A.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 using chart below to complete remainder of BLOCK 2s. *Note: Pay close attention to direction of diagonal line (indicated by line on the chart) to make each block.*



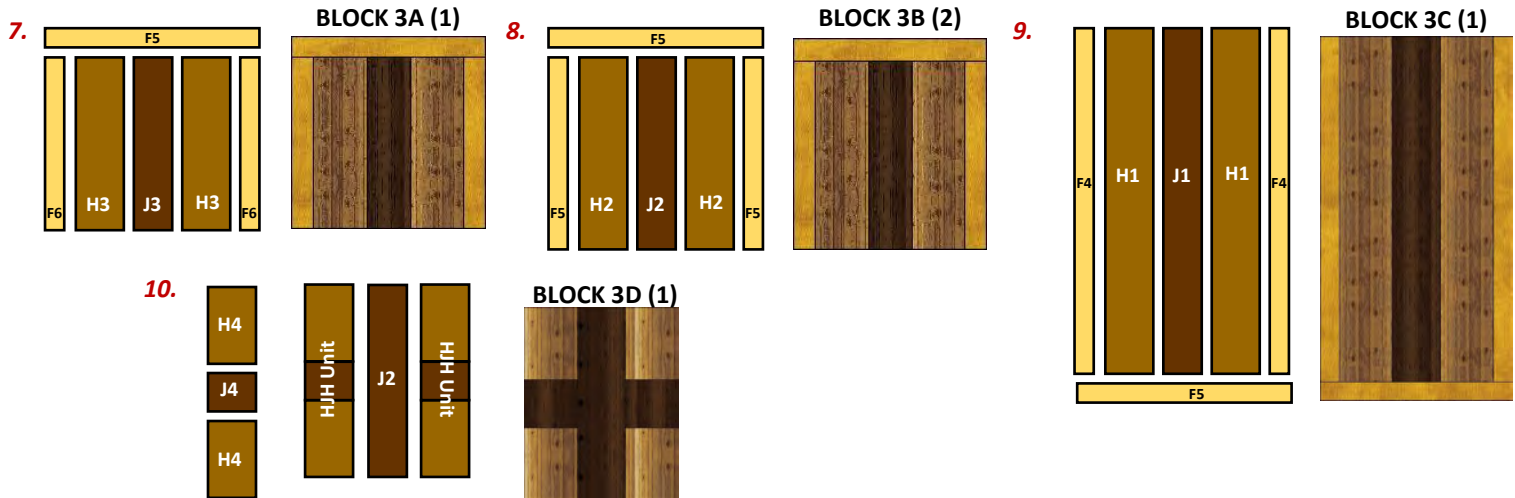

## Block 3A - 3D:

7. Sew (1) H3 to each side of (1) J3, then sew (1) F6 to each side. Sew (1) F5 to top to complete BLOCK 3A, square to 10-1/2".
8. Sew (1) H2 to each side of (1) J2, then sew (1) F5 to each side. Sew (1) F5 to top to complete BLOCK 3B. Make (2), square to 10-1/2" X 11-1/2"
9. Sew (1) H1 to each side of (1) J1, then sew (1) F4 to each side. Sew (1) F5 to bottom to complete BLOCK 3C, square to 10-1/2" X 20-1/2".
10. Sew (1) H4 to each end of (1) J4, make (2) HJH Units. Sew (1) HJH Unit to each side of (1) J2 to complete BLOCK 3D, square to 8-1/2" X 10-1/2".



**Assembly Instructions:** (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation)

### Quilt Assembly:

11. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.
  - Row 1: A1 Square - Block 2A - Block 2C - Block 2G - Block 2D - A1 square
  - Row 2: Block 2B - Block 1A - Block 1C - Block 1D - Block 1B - Block 2C
  - Row 3: Block 2D - Block 1B - Block 1D - Block 3A - Block 1D - Block 2H
  - Row 4: Block 2J - Block 1D - Block 3B - Block 3D - Block 3B - Block 2M
  - Row 5: Sew together Block 2E, 1E and 1D, then sew together Blocks 2A, 1G and 1F. Sew these 2 sub-rows together, then sew to the left side of Block 3C. Sew together Blocks 1D and 2K, then sew together Block 1B and 2D. Sew these 2 sub-rows together, then sew to the right side of Block 3C to complete Row 5.
  - Row 6: A1 Square - Block 2B- Block 2F - Block 2L - Block 2C - A1 square

### Border Assembly:

#### Border 1:

9. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 60-1/2"), cut (2) F 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 52-1/2"), cut (2) F 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

#### Border 2:

10. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) C 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 57-1/2"), cut (2) C 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
