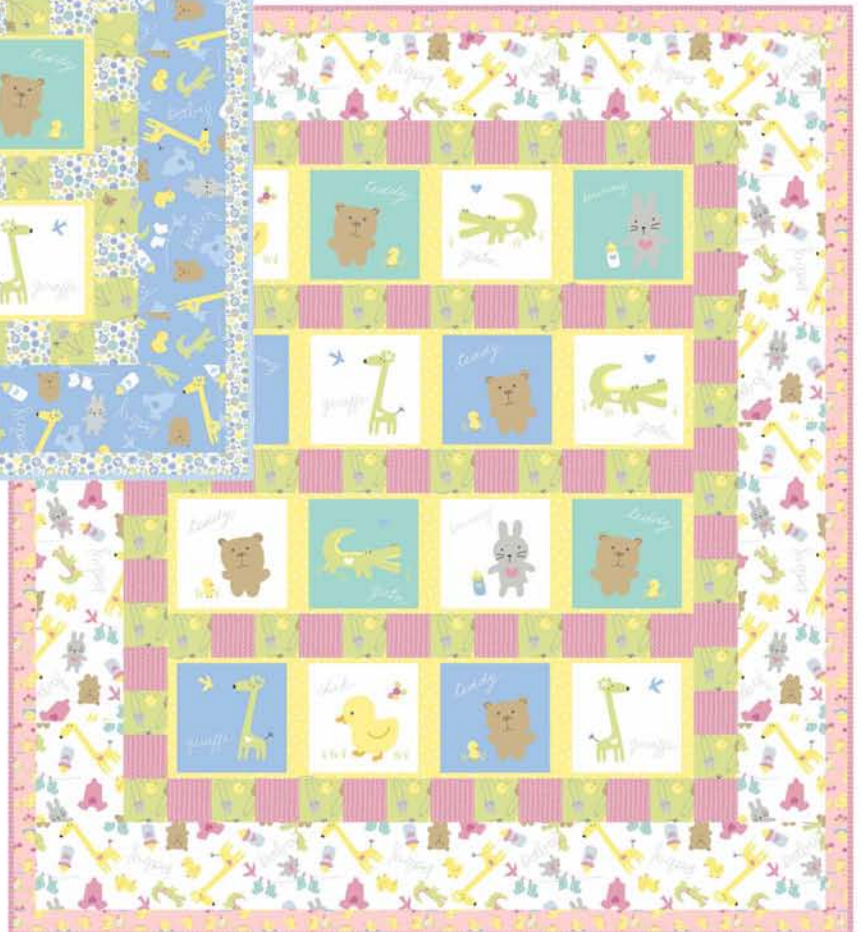



Baby Boy Quilt Cutting the Fabric

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

All cuts are the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.

Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	1 yard	35119-X Multi	Center Rows	Fussy Cut 4 strips 6" x 24 1/2" Unfold fabric and cut the 24 1/2" first leaving about an inch of yellow on each end. Then cut the strips apart having 1/2" yellow above and below.
	5/8 yard	35120-2 Blue	Wide Border	Cut 4 – 4 1/2" strips
	1/4 yard	35120-4 Green	Checkered Sashing	Cut 3 – 2 1/2" strips
	3/8 yard	35124-2 Blue	Binding	Cut 5 – 2 1/4" strips
	1/2 yard	35125-1 White	Narrow Border Checkered Sashing	Cut 4 – 1 1/2" Cut 3 – 2 1/2" strips

Additional Material Needed:

- 1 1/3 yards fabric for backing
- 44" x 48" Quilt Batting

Pink Baby Girl Quilt

Cutting the Fabric

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

All cuts are the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.

Fabric Picture	Quantity for Pink	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	1 yard	35119-X Multi	Center Rows	Fussy Cut 4 strips 6" x 24 1/2" Unfold fabric and cut the 24 1/2" first leaving about an inch of yellow on each end. Then cut the strips apart having 1/2" yellow above and below.
	5/8 yard	35120-1 White	Wide Border	Cut 4 – 4 1/2"
	1/4 yard	35121-3 Pink	Narrow Border	Cut 4 – 1 1/2"
	3/8 yard	35122-4 Green	Checkered Sashing	Cut 3 – 2 1/2" strips
	5/8 yard	35124-3 Pink	Checkered Sashing Binding	Cut 3 – 2 1/2" strips Cut 5 – 2 1/4" strips

Additional Material Needed:

- 1 1/3 yards for backing
- 44" x 48" Quilt Batting



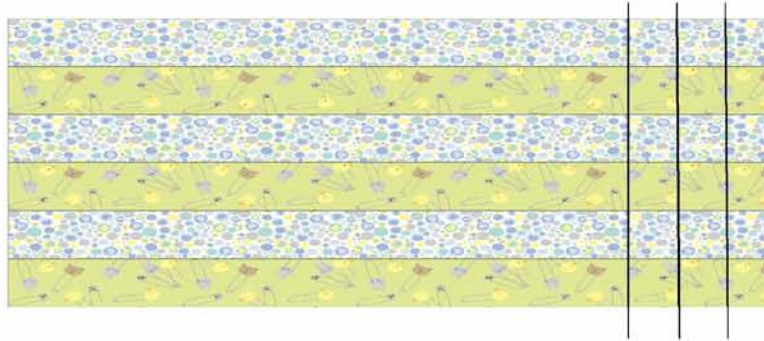

Making the Quilt

Checkered Border and Sashing

1. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together alternating the colors. Press in one direction. Cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.



2. Sew two pieces together end to end to create the inner sashing between panels. Make 5. Sew the sashing between the panels as shown reversing the order of the last row. Press toward panels.



Put white block first →



3. Sew three pieces together end to end to create the side sashing. Remove two blocks from one end for a total of 16 blocks. Make two strips. Sew to sides making sure the alternating blocks continue around the quilt. Press.

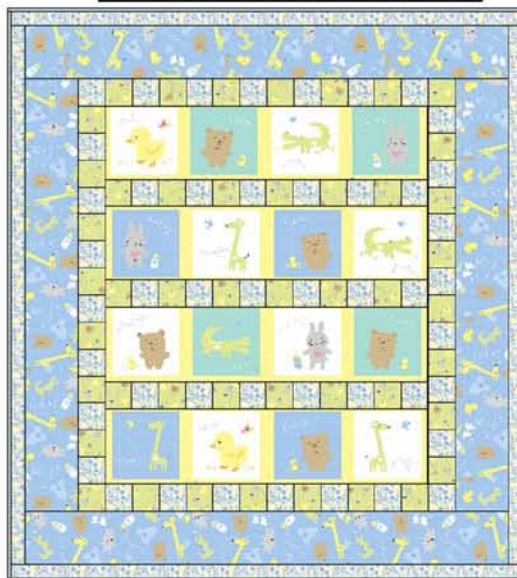


1. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blue piece to each side. Press. Trim even. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blue piece to top and bottom. Press. Trim even.
2. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " narrow border piece to each side. Press. Trim even. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " border pieces to top and bottom. Press. Trim even.
3. Give the quilt top a good pressing.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. I use temporary fabric spray adhesive for basting. Quilt as desired.
2. Join $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.

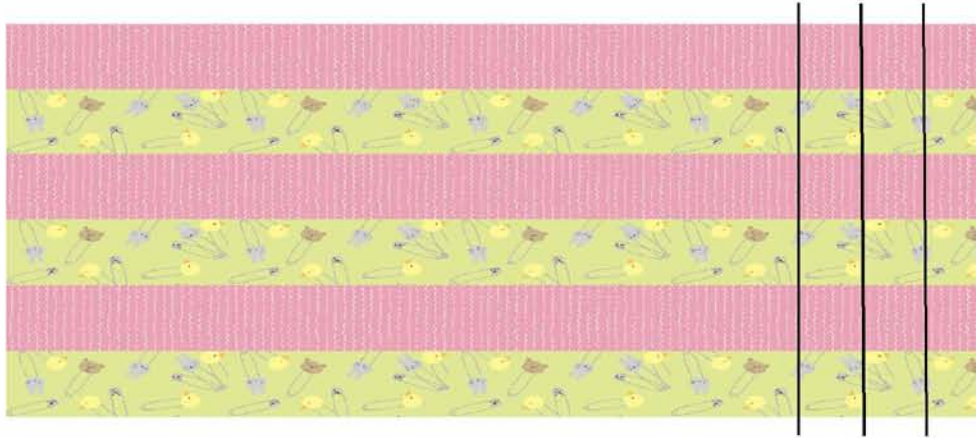

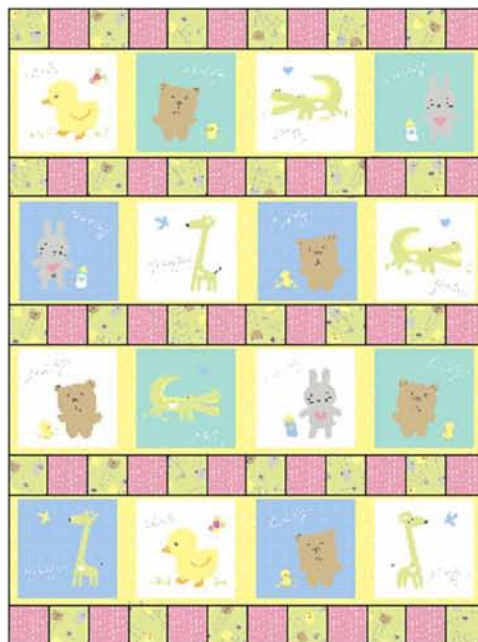
Baby Girl Quilt Making the Quilt

Checked Board

1. Sew the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together alternating the colors. Press. Cut into 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.



2. Sew two pieces together end to end to create the inner sashing between panels. Make 5. Sew the sashing between the panels as shown reversing the order of the last row. Press toward panels.



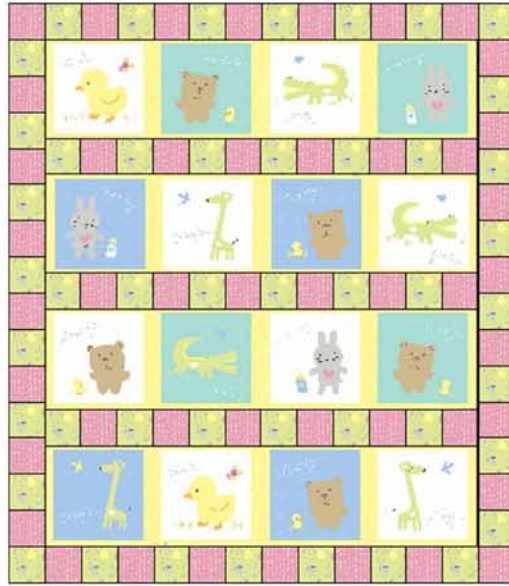
Put pink block first →



3. Sew three pieces together end to end to create the side sashing. Remove two blocks from one end for a total of 16 blocks. Make two strips. Sew to sides making sure the alternating blocks continue around the quilt. Press.

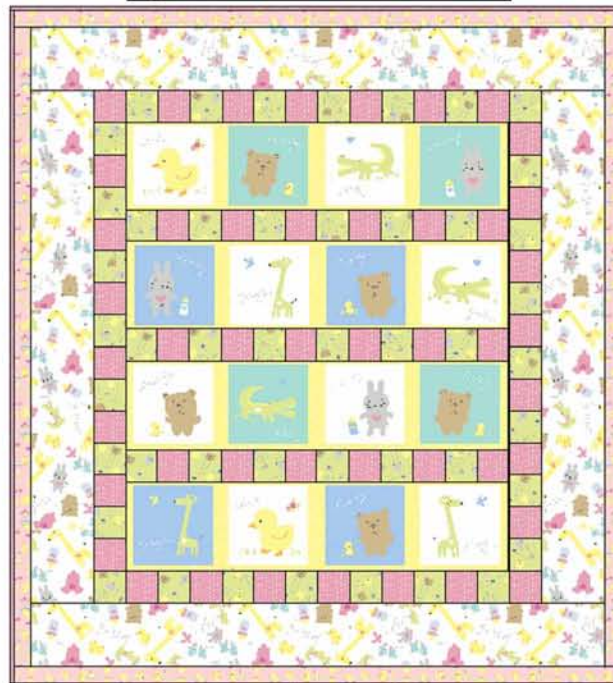


1. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blue piece to each side. Press. Trim even. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blue piece to top and bottom. Press. Trim even.
2. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " narrow border piece to each side. Press. Trim even. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " border pieces to top and bottom. Press. Trim even.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. I use temporary fabric spray adhesive for basting. Quilt as desired.
2. Join $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.
