- 33460-3 Tan 1 + 3/4 yards
- 33461-1 Black 1/4 yards
- 33461-2 Red 1/2 yards (for binding)
- 33462-1 Black 1/2 yards
- 33462-3 Tan 1/2 yards
- 33462-4 Tan/Black 3/4 yards
- 33463-1 Black 3/4 yards
- 33463-2 Red 1/3 yards
- 33464-1 Black 7/8 yards
- 33464-5 Cream 1 + 1/2 yards

## Fabric Cutting Instructions:

Wash, starch, and press all fabrics before cutting. (not required)

- 33459-1 Black
  - One 10 1/2" X 10 1/2" square
  - Four 16 1/4" X 16 1/4" squares

- 33459-2 Red
  - Four 5 1/2" X 5 1/2" squares
  - Seven 2 1/2" X Width of Fabric

- 33460-1 Black
  - Four 6 1/4" X 6 1/4" squares
  - Eight 3 1/2" X WOF

- 33460-3 Tan
  - Four 16 1/4" X 16 1/4" squares
  - Twenty-four 3 3/4" X 3 3/4" squares

## Sewing Instructions

- All seams are 1/4 inch.
- All half-square triangles are cut oversized, sewn, and then trimmed to exact size.



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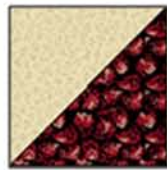
## • Half-Square Triangle Units (HST)

All units are made by using two squares of the same size. Draw a diagonal line on the back of one square. Place squares with right sides together and stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line, open, and press to one side. Then, trim to the exact size that will be given.

**Center Star Block:** Make the following HST as indicated using the  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Using one square of each color yields two HST units. For example, four white squares and four black squares will yield eight HST units. After stitching and pressing, trim all HST units to exactly  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

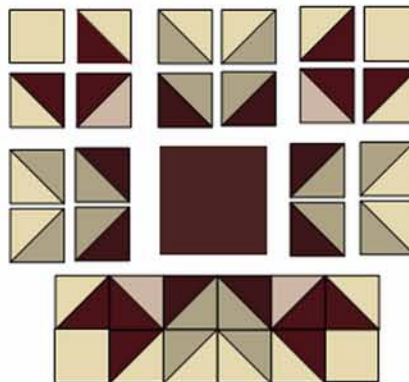

## Assembling the Center Star Block

In addition to the twenty-eight HST units, use one  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square (black floral) for the center and four  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (tan) for the corners. Assemble as shown in the diagram.

After assembly, the block should measure  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $30\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Frame the block using the black strips. Attach the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the left and right sides of the block. Press toward the strips. Then attach the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and the bottom of the blocks. Press. The center block should now measure  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $32\frac{1}{2}$ ".



## Corner Blocks:

Make the following HST as indicated using the  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Using one square of each color yields two HST units. After stitching and pressing, trim all HST units to exactly 3" X 3".

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## Assembling the Corner Star Blocks

In addition to the HST units, use one 5 1/2" X 5 1/2" square (red floral) for the center and four 3" X 3" squares (black) for the corners. Assemble as shown in the diagram.



After assembly, the block should measure 15 1/2" X 15 1/2".

Make four corner blocks.

Do not frame these blocks.



## Large Setting Blocks:



Make HST units using four black floral and four tan floral 16 1/4" X 16 1/4" squares. Press toward the dark fabric and trim to exactly 15 1/2" X 15 1/2". Make eight.



Connect two HST units as shown in the diagram to form a flying geese unit. Attach a 1 1/2" X 15 1/2" strip to each end. Press toward the strips. Make four.

## Border Blocks:



Make HST units using thirty-six black and thirty-six cream 5 1/4" X 5 1/4" squares. Press toward the dark fabric and trim to exactly 4 1/2". Make seventy-two.



Connect seventeen HST units as shown in the diagram. Notice the white triangle is in the lower left. Make two strips like this. Each strip should measure 4 1/2" X 68 1/2".

There will be four HST leftover for the corners.

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## Assembling the Quilt Top

### Center of the Quilt:

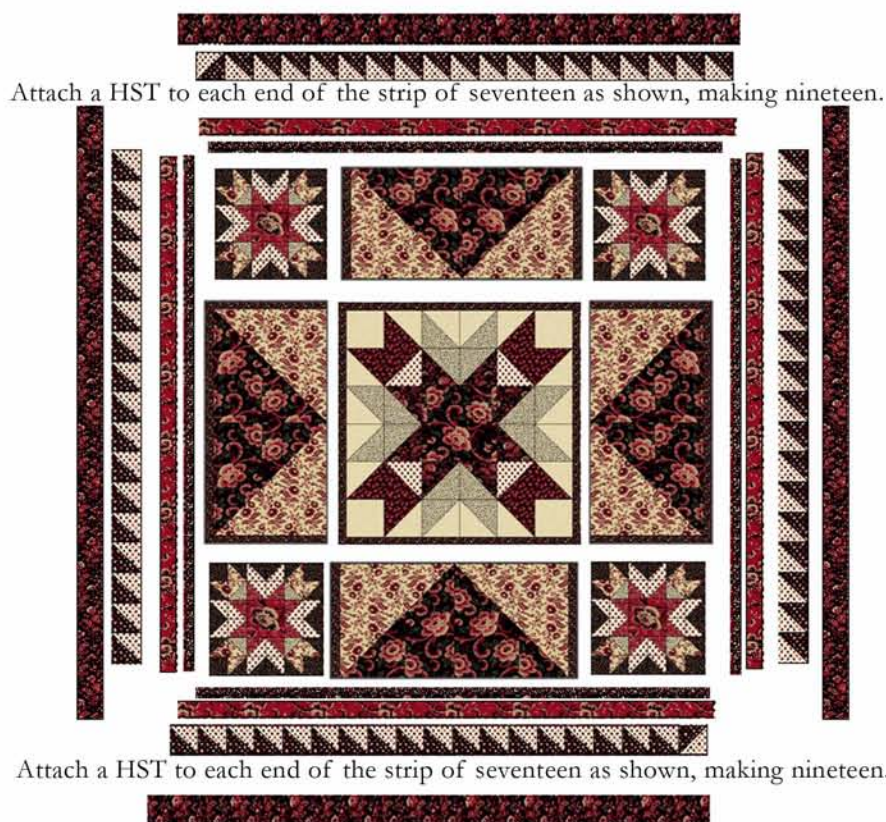
1. Attach a Corner Star Block to each side of the large flying geese unit.
2. Attach a flying geese unit to each side of the Center Star Block.
3. Attach a Corner Star Block to each side of the large flying geese unit.
4. Connect the three rows together. Press. The center of the quilt should measure. 62 1/2" X 62 1/2".

### Borders:

1. Connect the seven 1 1/2" black strips end to end using a bias seam. Press seams open. From this cut two strips 62 1/2" long and attach to the left and right sides of the quilt. Cut two strips 64 1/2" long and attach one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt.
2. Connect the seven 2 1/2" red floral strips in the same manner. Cut two strips 64 1/2" long and attach to the sides of the quilt. Cut two strips 68 1/2" long and attach to the top and bottom of the quilt.
3. Attach the HST borders to the sides of the quilt. Note direction of triangle shown in the diagram. Add a HST to each end of the remaining strips of seventeen as shown. Attach to the top and bottom of the quilt.
4. Connect the eight 3 1/2" black floral strips in the same manner. Cut two strips 76 1/2" long and attach to the sides of the quilt. Cut two strips 82 1/2" long and attach to the top and bottom of the quilt.

### Finishing:

Layer, baste, and quilt. Use red fabric 33461-2 to make bias strips for the binding.



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
