
Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	1/2 yard	35318-2 Tan	Center of Diamond in the Square Block	Cut 4 – 4" strips. Then cut into 36 – 4" squares.
	7/8 yard	32406A-3 Red	Friendship Star Block Tree Block	Cut 5 – 2 ¼" strips. Then cut into 76 - 2 ¼" squares.* Cut once diagonally.  Cut 8 – 1 7/8" strips. Then cut 152 – 1 7/8" squares.  Cut 8 - Template D
	1/2 yard	35319-4 Ivory	Inner Border Friendship Star Paw Block	Cut 5 – 2 1/4" strips. Then cut into 76 - 2 1/4" squares.  * Cut once diagonally  Cut 2 – 1 7/8" strips. Then cut into 38 – 1 7/8" squares.
	1 1/8 yard	35320-1 Red	Diamond in the Square Bear Block Binding	Cut 7 – 3 ½" strips. Then cut into 72 – 3 ½" squares. Cut once diagonally.  Cut 6 – 2 ¼" strips
	5/8 yard	35321-3 Brown	Borders  Tree Block  Trunk	Cut $4 - 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips Cut $5 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips Cut $4 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " square
	1/4 yard	32408A-1 Tan	Tree Block Background	Cut 8 – Template A Cut 8 – Template B  Cut 8 – 2 1/4" square or Template C
	1 Panel	35317P-X Multi	Center Panel	Cut the panel 24 ½" x 38 ½" leaving an equal amount of tan fabric on each side. This should be about 2" on each side.











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#### Additional Material Needed:

- 3 1/4 yards for backing
- 56" x 66" Quilt Batting

#### Cutting the Fabric

Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

All cuts are the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.

Suggestion: Make sample blocks to check correct size of finished blocks


\*You can make the diagonal cut after sewing a quarter inch seam allowance on both sides of a pencil drawn diagonal line.

### Making the Quilt

#### Making the blocks

- 1. This quilt is made using three blocks patterns.
  - A. 4 Tree Blocks Unfinished block  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Finished size is 5" square
  - B. 38 Friendship Star Block Unfinished 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Finished size is 4" square
  - C. 36 Diamond in the Square Block Unfinished 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Finished size is 5" square

Making the Tree Block A:



Sew each A to D. Press. Sew B to D as indicated. Press. Make two units for each block. Sew 2 Tan C pieces to trunk C as indicated. Press toward darker fabric. Sew three units together to make one block. Make 4 blocks.












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Making the Friendship Star Block B






Sew Pine Cone fabric triangle to Bear Paw triangle. To do this quicker Chain Stitch the 156 triangle units together. Press toward dark fabric.

Arrange the 4 Pine Cone fabric squares and 1 Bear Paw square with the 4 Triangles Units as indicated. Sew together. Press. Make 38 blocks.

Making the Square in the Diamond Block C





Mark center points on square and triangle as shown. I fold in half and press. You could mark with a pencil or pin. Matching center points sew a triangle to opposite sides. Press out. Snip off ears. Sew two other triangles on remaining sides matching center points. Press out. Make 36.

### <u>Putting the Quilt Together</u>

- 1. Sew 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 28  $\frac{1}{2}$ " border to top and bottom of panel. Sew 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 ½" border to sides of panel. Press.
- 2. Sew 10 Friendship Star (B) blocks together for each side. Press seams open. Sew on. Sew 9 B blocks together for the top and bottom. Press seams open and attach.
- 3. Sew 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 ½" border to top and bottom of panel. Sew 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 ½" border to sides. Press and trim as needed.








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4. Sew 10 Square in the Diamond (C) blocks together to form border strip. Press. Make 2 sets. Sew to sides of quilt top. Make 2 sets of 8 Block C. Attach a Block A to each end with trees pointing up. See Quilt picture. Sew to top and bottom.

#### Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Divide backing into 2 lengths. Join panels lengthwise. Seam will run horizontally.
- 2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Use temporary fabric spray adhesive for basting. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Join 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.

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



