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Blue and Brown Star Quilt

Size: 68 1/2" x 85 1/2"

Block Size: 6"

Fabric Requirements:

fat-quarter each of 10 light patterns

fat-quarter each from 20 blue and brown patterns

2 1/2 yards setting squares and triangles Pattern 36009-4

2 1/3 yards border (cut lengthwise) or 1 1/2 yards if pieced Pattern 36004-1

3/4 yard binding Pattern 36007-2

5 1/2 yards Backing

Cutting Instructions:

From assorted lights, cut:

(504) - 2" squares

*Cut in groups of eight

From one blue or brown, cut:

(1) - 3 1/2" square

(4) - 2" squares

(4) - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

This is the cutting instructions for one block. Using all of your blues and browns, cut enough for 63 blocks. You will be using the same light and one blue or brown to assemble each block.

From your setting fabric, cut:

(48) - 6 1/2" squares

(7) - 9 3/4" squares, cutting each in half diagonally twice for a total of 28 triangles.

(2) - 7 1/2" squares, cutting each in half diagonally once for a total of 4 corner triangles.

From your border fabric, cut:

4 strips 5" x Length of fabric

*8 strips 5" x Width of fabric if piecing the border

From your binding fabric, cut:

8 strips - 2 1/2" x width of fabric

Block Construction:

1. Mark a diagonal line on wrong side of eight 2" light squares.

2. Align a 2" light square on one end of a dark 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle.

3. Sew on drawn line. Trim, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press towards triangle.

4. Sew a second 2" square to the opposite side of the rectangle.

5. Repeat for a total of four flying geese units.

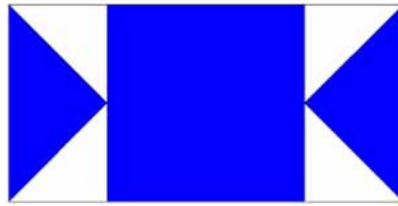
6. Add a 2" dark to each side of two of the flying geese units.



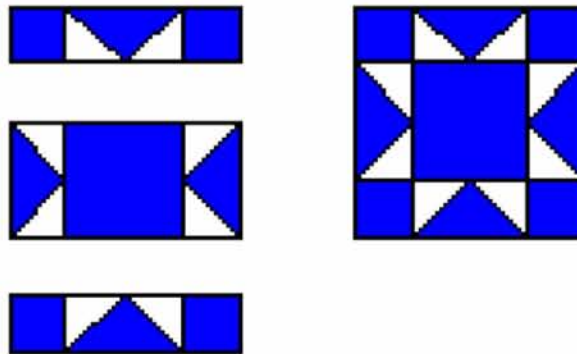
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7. Add remaining two flying geese units to each side of the center 3 1/2" square.



8. Next, sew the three rows together to complete one block.



9. Repeat for a total of 63 blocks.

Quilt Assembly:

1. Using the quilt diagram, lay out quilt in diagonal rows.
2. Measure down center of quilt and cut two borders to this length. Add to each side of the quilt.
3. Measure across center of the quilt and cut two borders to this length. Add to top and bottom of the quilt.

Quilt and Bind.
