

## Botanical Pop

4. Use the red thread to machine appliqué the flowers. I used a narrow zig zag stitch.
5. Sew the borders to the quilt center, mitering the corners.
6. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Trim edges of top, batting and back even with each other.
4. Sew the binding strips into a long row and fold in half, wrong sides together. Sew to raw edges of quilt and secure to back with slip stitch.

## Fabric Requirements:

Fat 1/8ths of the following fabrics (a fat eighth is 9" x 22") for block centers

27376-1

27370-1

27373-2

27378-2

1 yard 27372-8 for block outside (white with gray stripes)

1/2 yard of 27374-1 for center block and flower cutouts

1/2 yard of 27369-1 (sashings)

1 yard of 27372-7 for border

1/2 yard of 27368-7 for binding

2 yards backing

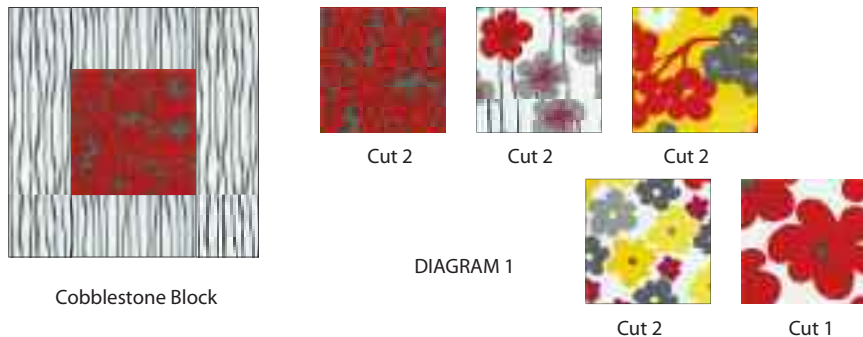
1/2 yard lightweight fusible webbing

Small spool of red thread for machine applique of flowers

52" square batting

## Cutting the fabrics

1. Cut 2 squares, 6-1/2", from EACH of 4 fabrics: 27376-1, 27370-1, 27373-2, and 27378-2. Cut 1 square, 6-1/2", from 27374-1. Diagram 1



2. Cut (18) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" AND (18) x 10-1/2" strips from the white with gray stripes (27372-8). Take care to orient the strips vertically for ALL the

strips. Diagram 2

3. Cut 5 squares of fusible webbing slightly larger than the red flowers (27374-1) and fuse to wrong side of each selected flower. Take care that the entire flower is covered on the back side by the fusible web. Cut out the five flowers.

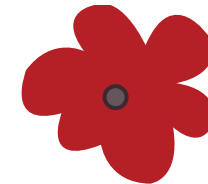

4. Cut (12) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" AND (4) 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips from the sashing fabric (27369-1).
5. Cut (4) 5" x 47" from border fabric (you will need to cut and piece this fabric in order to get the length for the mitered corners).

## Building the blocks

1. Refer to the quilt photo and sew a total of 9 Cobblestone Blocks. Take care to orient the stripes in the blocks so they all run vertically. See Diagram 4.

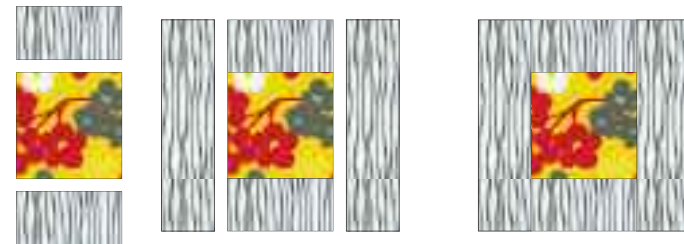

## Quilt Assembly

1. Sew 3 blocks and 4 short sashing strips into a row, beginning and ending with the sashing strips. Make 3 of these rows. Press seams toward the sashings. Refer to the colored quilt picture for block placement.
2. Sew the 3 block rows together with the 4 long sashing strips, beginning and ending with the sashing strips. Press seams toward the sashings.
3. Arrange the five red flowers around the quilt center as desired. Remove the paper from the fusible side and fuse in place with warm to hot iron. Allow to cool.
