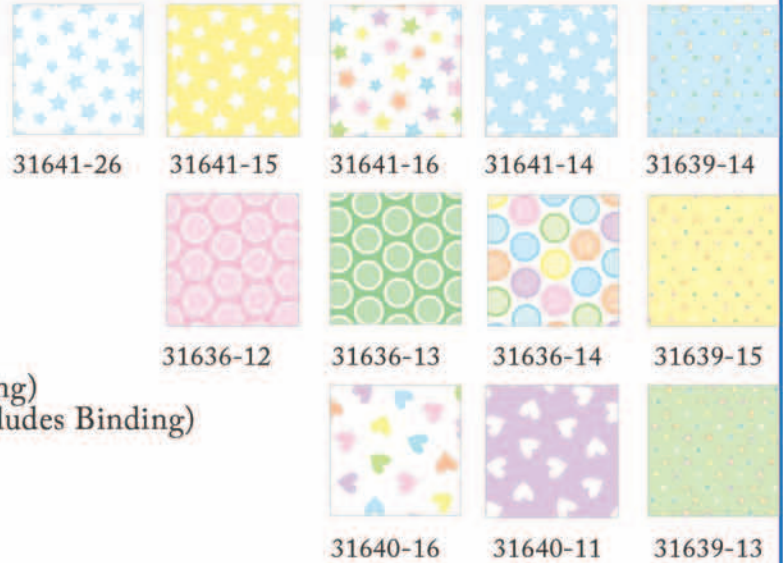

Blocks

Binding, Backing and Batting

 50” x 65” Warm & Natural Batting

Special Notions

- Scrap Batting
 8-1/2” Circle Template
 1-1/2 Yards of 18” Wide Double Sided Web
 3/4 Yard of Lightweight Interfacing
 1 Sheet of Plastic Mylar for Template

Instructions

- Pre-wash all fabric and spray with Mary Ellen’s Best Press Starch.
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4” seam allowance.
- Finished Block including seam allowance is 14” square.
- There are TWO options for applying the Circles – Option 1: Stuffed and partially fused OR Option 2: Totally fused.

Step 1 – Cutting the Fabric

1. Set A:
 - a. 31636-14 White-Multi – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - b. 31636-13 Light Green – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - c. 31636-12 Light Pink – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
2. Set B:
 - d. 31639-14 Light Blue – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - e. 31639-15 Light Yellow – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - f. 31641-14 Light Blue – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
3. Set C:
 - g. 31641-13 Light Green – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - h. 31641-15 Light Yellow – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.
 - i. 31641-26 Light Blue-White – Cut (2) strips at 5” x WOF.



Block



4. Circles, Borders and Binding:

- j. 31640-11 Light Purple – Cut (3) strips at 1" x WOF (Inner Side Borders)
- k. 31640-11 Light Purple – Cut (3) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF (Top and Bottom Binding)
- l. 31640-11 Light Purple – Cut (2) strips at 8-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (6) 8-1/2" squares for Option 1 or 2.
- m. 31640-16 White-Multi – Cut (3) strips at 8-1/2" x WOF – Option1: Sub-cut into (12) 8-1/2" squares OR Option 2: Sub-cut into (6) 8-1/2" squares.
- n. Scrap Batting and Lightweight Interfacing – Option 1: Cut (12) 8-1/2" squares from each.
- o. Double Sided Web – Option 1: Cut (6) 8-1/2" squares – Options 2: Cut (12) 8-1/2" squares.
- p. 31639-15 Light Yellow – Cut (3) strips at 3" x WOF for the Top & Bottom Outer Borders.
- q. 31639-15 Light Yellow – Cut (3) strips at 2-1/4" x WOF for the Side Outer Borders.
- r. 31639-13 Light Green – Cut (3) strips at 1" x WOF (Inner Top & Bottom Borders).
- s. 31639-13 Light Green – Cut (3) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF (Sides Binding).

Step 2 – Block Background

- 5. To make the blocks take (1) strip of each color from each SET and sew together to make new strips at 14" x WOF.
- 6. Make TWO new strips from each SET.
- 7. Sub-cut each SET into (12) 14" x 5" rectangles.
- 8. Sew (1) of each SET RECTANGLE together to make the Block BACKGROUND – Make 12.

Step 3 – Preparing the Circles

- 9. There are TWO ways that the circles can be done.
- 10. Option 1:
 - A. Using the 8-1/2" square of "Step 1 – 4m" cut out an 8-1/2" circle – Make 12.
 - B. Layer (1) of each – Scrap Batting, 8-1/2" Circle and the Lightweight Interfacing – Using the raw edge of the circle sew a 1/4" seam allowance all the way around – turn and press.
 - C. Using the template provided trace onto the Plastic Mylar and cut each section out.
 - D. Fuse SIX of the 8-1/2" square Double Sided Web to the WRONG side of the 8-1/2" squares from "Step 1 – 4l".
 - E. Trace the templates you just made onto the Double Sided Web and cut each piece out.
 - F. Remove the paper and layer onto the WHITE as shown in the picture of the main block – remember to alternate the position of each DARK piece as shown on the Cover Picture.
 - G. Fuse onto the WHITE and sew the CIRCLES to each of the "Block Background" – Do not always put them in the same position as this will give added movement to the quilt.
- 11. Option 2:
 - A. Using (12) of the Double Sided Web 8-1/2" squares fuse to the WRONG side of SIX of the 8-1/2" squares from "Step 1 – 4l and Step 1 – 4m".
 - B. Using the Plastic Mylar templates trace each piece onto the paper side and cut out all the sections.
 - C. Layer onto the "Block Background" remembering to alternate colors on each block.
 - D. You can place them close together to create the circle or leave a little space between each piece to give a whole new look to the quilt top.
 - E. Fuse to each block when satisfied with the position.

Step 4 – Finishing the Quilt

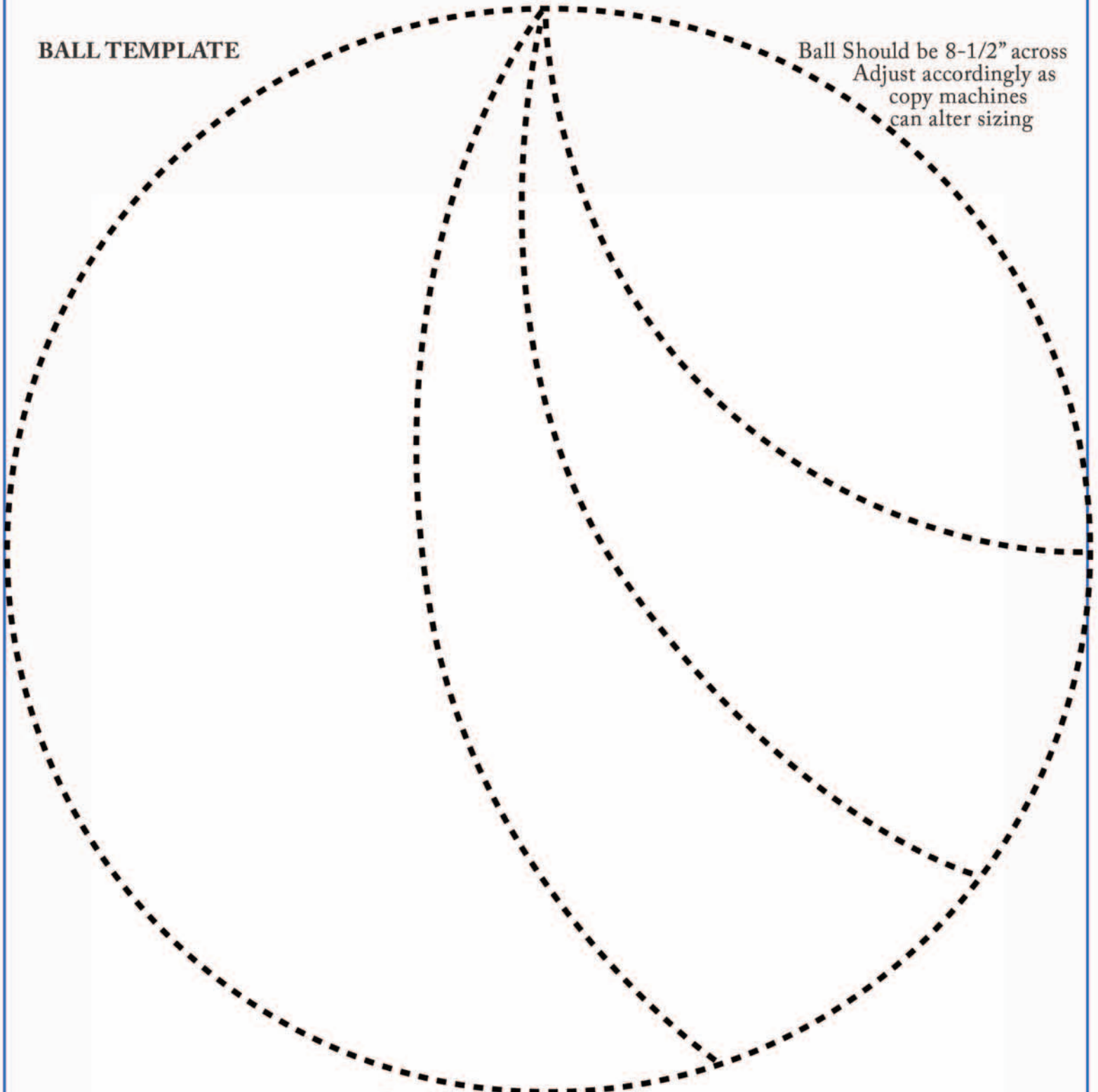
- 12. Using the COVER PICTURE as your guide sew THREE blocks together into rows – REMEMBER to rotate each block within each row – Make (4) rows.
- 13. Sew the rows together.
- 14. Sew on the inner border using "Step 1 4j" for the sides and "Step 1 4r" for the top and bottom.
- 15. Sew on the outer border using "Step 1 4q" for the sides and "Step 1 4p" for the top and bottom.
- 16. Layer the BACKING, BATTING and QUILT TOP and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew on the BINDING "Step 1 4k" for the top and bottom and "4s" for the sides to finish the quilt.
