Yardage is based on 42" width fabric. Border measurements include 2" extra plus seam allowances.

Fabric	Yards	Cut
33798-X Multi	7/8 yard	9 strips 3" x WOF; subcut into (18) 20" strips
33802-4 Yellow	3/4 yard	12 strips 2" x WOF; subcut into (24) 20" strips
33802-6 Pink	5/8 yard	9 strips 2" x WOF; subcut into (18) 20" strips
33802-3 Blue	1 1/4 yards	8 binding strips 2 1/2" x WOF 9 strips 2" x WOF; subcut into (18) 20" strips
33802-5 Gray	3/8 yard	9 strips 2" x WOF; subcut into (18) 20" strips

From 1/4 yard each of the remaining fabrics, cut 3 strips 3" x WOF and subcut each into (2) 20" strips
33799-1 Cream / 33799-2 Green / 33800-2 Green
33800-3 Blue / 33801-3 Blue / 33801-4 Yellow
33803-6 Pink / 33805-3 Blue / 33805-4 Yellow
33806-4 Yellow / 33806-5 Gray

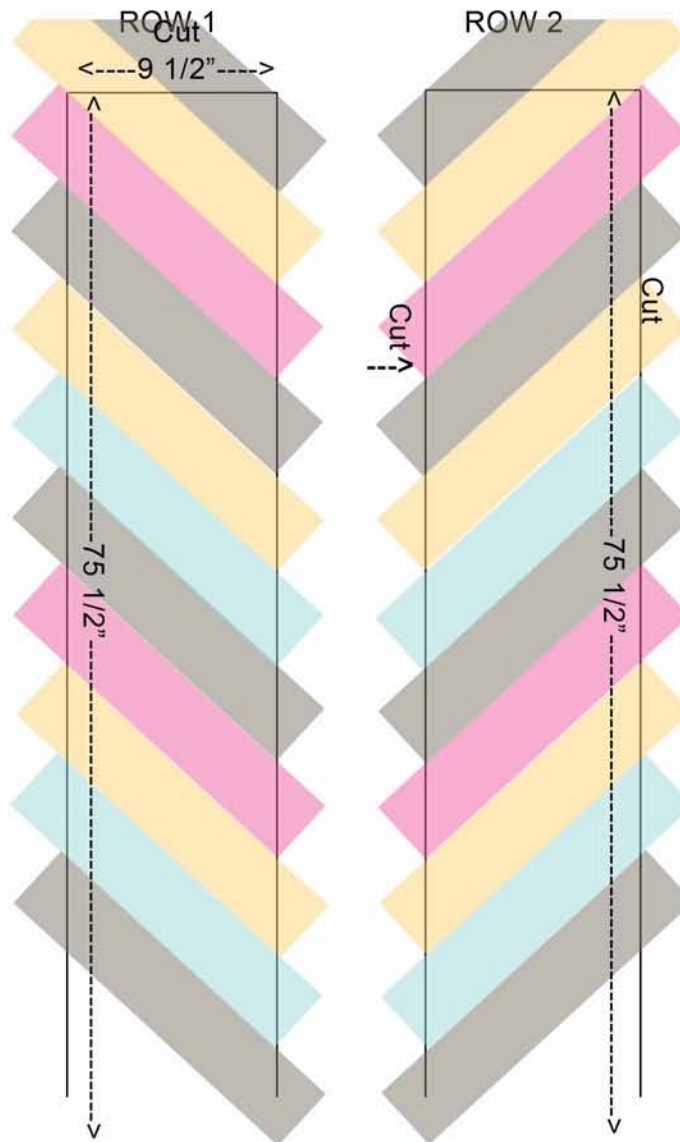
33804-X Multi	7/8	7 strips 3 1/2" x WOF, pieced and cut into: 2 side borders 77 1/2" long 2 top/bottom borders 62 1/2" long
Backing	5 1/8	2 vertical panels 35" x 89"
Batting	Twin	

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Assembly

1. Cut strips as directed in the Fabric and Cutting Requirements.
2. Referring to the quilt picture and the Row 1 diagram, join strips into a vertical row as shown, staggering the ends. The ends of the strips should be on a 45 degree angle. Measuring from the center, trim the row to measure $9\frac{1}{2}"$ x $75\frac{1}{2}"$. Make 3 Row 1.
3. Refer to the quilt picture and the Row 2 diagram. Make 3 Row 2.



4. On a design wall or large flat surface, and handling the rows carefully to avoid stretching and unraveling the seams, arrange the rows alternately to achieve the chevron effect in the pictured quilt. Matching centers, ends, and seams, join the rows.

5. Measure the quilt through the center from the top raw edge to the bottom raw edge. Trim the side borders this length. Matching centers and ends. Join the borders to the sides of the quilt. Similarly, measure the quilt through the center from side to side, including the borders you just added. Trim the top and bottom borders this length. Join them to the quilt.
6. If you wish to mark quilting motifs, do so now.
7. Join the backing panels along the long edges. Layer the backing, batting, and top. Baste. Quilt the marked motifs, quilt in the ditch around the block patches, or quilt as desired. Bind the quilt to finish.
