## CALISTO PATIO TILES

Quilt Designed by Jean Ann Wright
Featuring fabric from the Calisto Collection by Anna Griffin
Skill level: Beginner
Finished Quilt Size: 62" x 62"

\*In cutting wof indicates cutting across the width of the fabric.

There are 3 different color combo quilts to choose from gold, cornflower and sage.

Fabric A large floral - 2-1/4 yd in one colorway: 30439-1 gold, 30439-2 cornflower, 30439-3 sage

Cut (1) 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" center square; cut remainder into (1) 3-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (4) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares. Cut (2) 6-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" squares and (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles; cut Cut (7) 6-1/2" x wof strips for borders. Sew together end-to-end and recut into (2) 6-1/2" x 50-1/2" vertical borders and (2) 6-1/2" x 62-1/2" horizontal borders.

Fabric B moiré print - 3/4 yd in one colorway:

30440-1 gold, 30440-2 cornflower, 30440-3 sage

Cut (1) 3-1/2" x wof strip recut into (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles and (4) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares. Cut (6) 3-1/2" x wof strips for borders. Sew the border strips together end-to-end then recut into (4) 51" border strips.

Fabric C stripe -3/4 yd in one colorway:

30441-1 gold, 30441-2 cornflower, 30441-3 sage

Cut (2) 6-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 6-1/2" squares. Cut (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.

## Fabric D allover floral\* – 1-1/4 yd in one colorway:

30442-1 gold, 30442-2 cornflower, 30442-3 sage

Cut (3) 1-1/2" x wof strips, cut into (32) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces. Cut (3) 1-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (2) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips. Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from each strip cut (1) 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip and (1) 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" strip. Cut (4) 1-1/2" x wof strips, recut (2) strips to 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" and (2) strips 1-1/2" x 36-1/2". Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips and trim to 42-1/2" long. Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips sew together end-to-end then sew the longest remainder from cutting previous strips to recut into (2) 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips. Cut (5) 1" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end and recut into (4) pieces 1" x 48-1/2" long for folded borders

\*Fabric D allover floral - 2/3 yd from one colorway:

30442-1 gold, 30442-2 cornflower, 30442-3 sage

(7) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding.

\*Fabric E curved stripe – 3-3/4 yd from one colorway:

30444-1 gold, 30444-2 cornflower, 3044-3 sage

Piece together to make the quilt backing 66" x 66" square.

#### Sewing:

- \*Note: The quilt is assembled by sewing successive borders around the center square. Refer to the diagram on 3rd page for the progression of the border rounds.
- 1. Sew a fabric D 12-1/2" strip to each side of the center 12-1/2" square. Sew a fabric D 1-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the center square.
- 2. Sew a fabric D 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each end of a fabric C 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, then sew a fabric B 3-1/2" square to each end of the fabric D strips. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- 3. Sew a fabric D 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each end of a fabric C rectangle. Sew a fabric fabric B rectangle to each end of the fabric D strips. Sew to opposite sides of the center assembly.
- 4. Sew a fabric D 20-1/2" border to opposite sides of the center assembly, then sew a fabric D 22-1/2" to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- 5. Sew two fabric C 6-1/2" squares and 1 fabric A 6-1/2" square into a row, separating them with (4) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" fabric D strips. Make 2. Sew to the sides of the center assembly.
- 6. Sew (2) fabric C 6-1/2" squares and (3) fabric A 6-1/2" squares in a row separating them with (4) fabric D 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- Sew a fabric D 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to opposite sides of the center assembly and a fabric D 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- 8. Sew the next row with (2) fabric A 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles and (3) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" fabric C rectangles, separating them with (6) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" fabric D strips. Make 4. Sew (2) of the rows to opposite sides of the quilt assembly. Sew a fabric A 3-1/2" square to each end of the remaining (2) rows, then sew these rows to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- 9. Sew a fabric D 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to opposite sides of the center assembly and a fabric D 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the center assembly.
- 10. Center and sew the fabric B borders to each side of the quilt top. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric.
- 11. Fold the fabric D 1" border strip in half lengthwise and press the fold line for a narrow folded border. Pin the folded border to the fabric B border with folded edge in towards the quilt center and raw edges aligned with outside edge of quilt center. Baste in place on the vertical sides first, then the top and bottom.
- 12. Sew the fabric A 6-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the fabric A 6-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

#### **Finishing**

- 13. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste, then quilt the layers together.
- 14. Fold the fabric D binding lengthwise and press, then and sew to quilt top. Turn binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.
