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




This flower garden quilt is made from 9" blocks that combine to create interesting paths around the garden. These blocks are not for beginners. So put your thinking caps on and create something truly wonderful for a special person in your life.

Purple Quilt	Turq Quilt	Quantity	Placement & Cutting
32545-1 	32545-2 	2- 1/4 yds	Border #6 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 3 1/2" x 73 1/2" 2 @ 3 1/2" x 55 1/2" ALLOW EXTRA FOR MITERS & DIFFERENCES IN PIECING!
32546-3 	32546-2 	2 yds	Border #4 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 3" x 67 1/2" 2 @ 3" x 49 1/2" ALLOW EXTRA FOR MITERS & DIFFERENCES IN PIECING! There should be 28" left on the WOF after the borders are cut. Cut 8 strips @ 3 3/8" wide x WOF. Cut 24 rectangles 3 3/8" x 6 1/4" for flying geese units. Cut 4 strips 2 5/8" wide x WOF (28"). Cut 3 strips 4 1/2" wide. Set aside for triangles around star points.

32549-1 	32549-2 	1- 7/8 yds	Border #2 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 2 1/2" x 62 1/2" 2 @ 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" ALLOW EXTRA FOR MITERS & DIFFERENCES IN PIECING! Set aside remainder for blocks. See below.

32547-3 	32547-5 	2- 1/2 yds	Border #1 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 1" x 58 1/2" 2 @ 1" x 40 1/2" Border #3 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 1" x 62 1/2" 2 @ 1" x 44 1/2" Border #5 - Cut lengthwise borders 2 @ 1" x 67 1/2" 2 @ 1" x 49 1/2" ALLOW EXTRA FOR MITERS & DIFFERENCES IN PIECING! Size or starch heavily to stabilize the narrow strips. There should be 28" on the WOF after the borders are cut. Cut 5 strips 6" wide x WOF. Cut 48 pieces 2 1/2" x 6". The stripes should run the length of the piece (6").

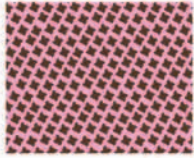

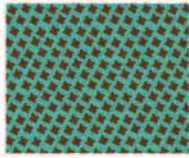

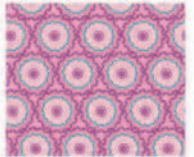

Placement & Cutting

Star centers. Cut 3 strips $8 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide x WOF. Cut 12 - $8 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut in half diagonally.

Garden centers. Cut 2 strips 6" wide x WOF. Cut 12 - 6" squares.

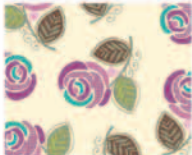

Garden edges. Cut 3 strips 6" wide x WOF (30"). Cut 12 - 6" squares.

Cut 4 strips $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide WOF.
Cut into 48 pieces $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

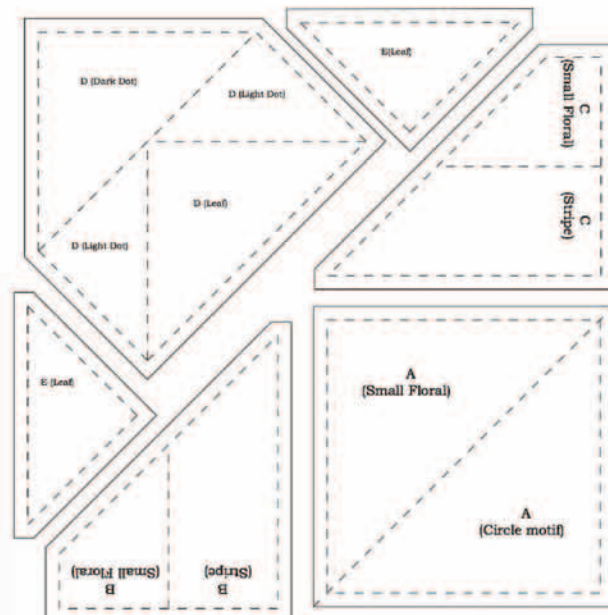

Garden edges. Cut 2 strips 6" wide x WOF (30"). Cut 12 - 6" squares.

Cut 4 strips $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide WOF.
Cut into 48 pieces $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

The following pages have the instructions for making the block below. This is the finished block and the expanded pieces to show you where you are heading!

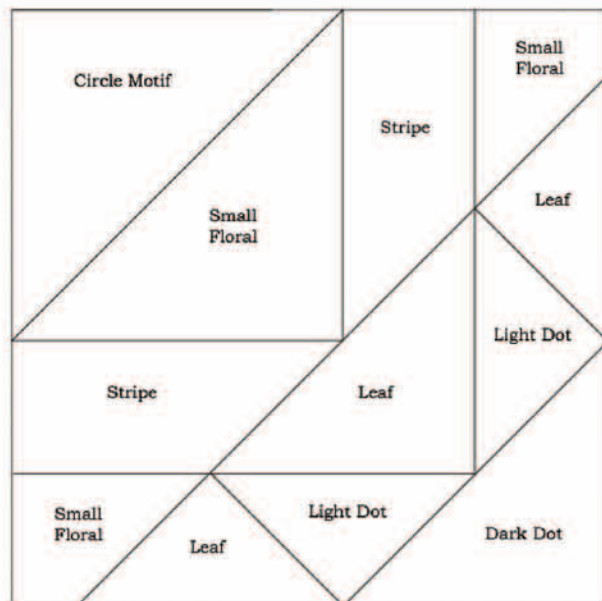




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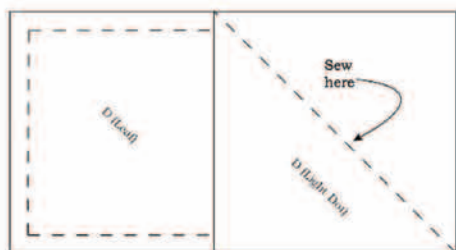
Making the quilt:

NOTE! The leaf print is directional. Follow the arrows when cutting the pieces. The border will wrap around the quilt, keeping the lengthwise grain.

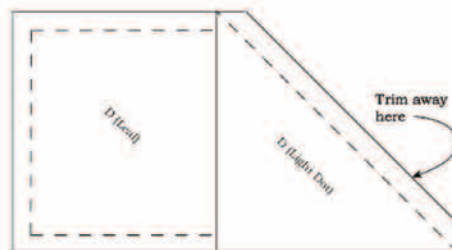
NOTE! The stripes should also be cut according to the arrows. The borders are lengthwise grain, but the binding should be cut on the cross.

NOTE! Check the scale of the templates when you print them out. If they are not exactly the right measurement, reduce or enlarge them as needed to be the correct size. Cut all of them from template plastic.

1. Cut 7 strips from stripe 2 1/2" wide x WOF. Set aside for binding.
2. Cut the rest of the borders from the lengthwise grain of the goods. Allow extra length for mitering and differences in piecing. Do not trim to final length until quilt is completed.
3. Using the 6 1/4" x 3 3/8" rectangles of the leaf print, create a flying geese unit with the 3 3/8" light dot print as the triangle on the corners. Use your favorite method or:
 - a. Place light dot square on leaf rectangle with right sides together as shown.
 - b. Draw a line diagonally from one corner of the light dot square to the other.
 - c. Stitch along line, then trim 1/4" away from the stitch line.
 - d. Press seams toward dot. Repeat on other side. Make 24.

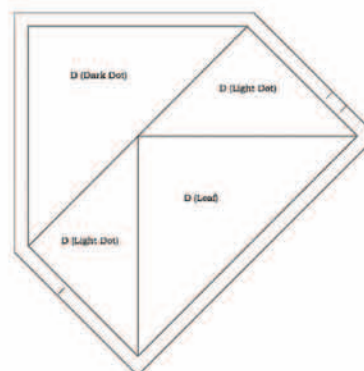
4. Using the templates, cut leaf triangles as shown below. Watch the direction of the leaf! Be sure to mark or cut the notches.

5. Cut 24 of each template.

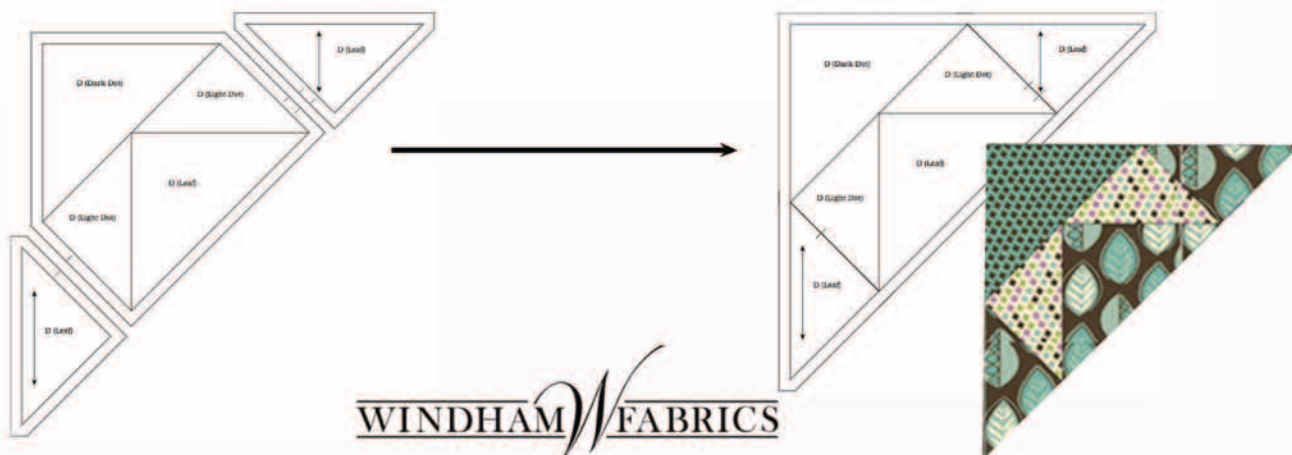


6. Sew a dark dot triangle to top of flying geese unit as shown at right.

7. Using the template, trim to size. Mark the notches.



8. Sew leaf triangles to each side of flying geese unit, matching notches to create half a block.



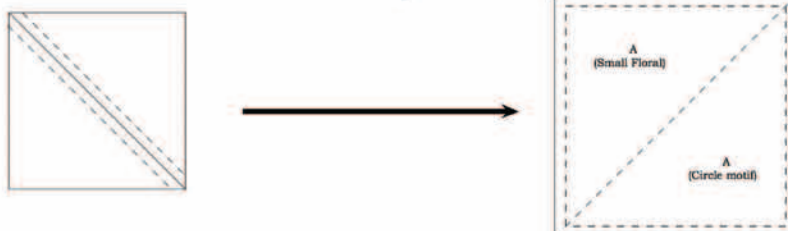


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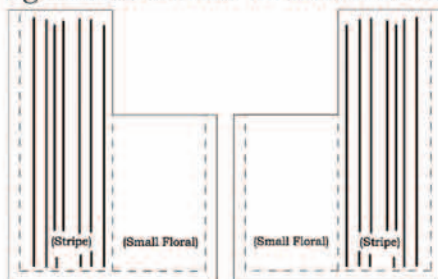


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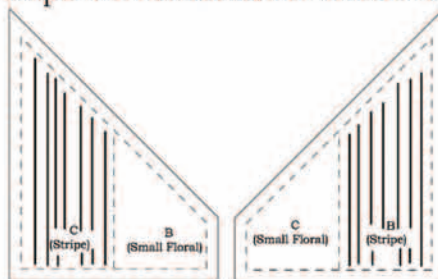
9. Put right sides together of a circle motif 6" square and a small floral 6" square.
10. Mark diagonally from corner to corner.
11. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the line. Make 12.
12. Cut in half diagonally along the marked line.
13. Open and press toward circle motif to make 24 squares. Trim to 5 1/2" if necessary.



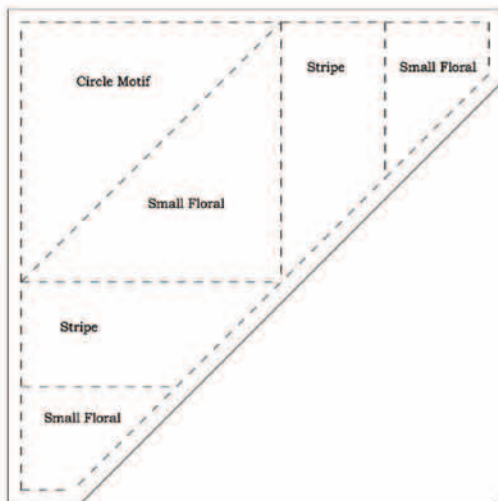
14. With right sides together, sew a 2 1/2" x 6" stripe rectangle to a 2 1/2" x 3 3/4" small floral rectangle matching at the bottoms. Make 24 rights and 24 lefts as shown below.



15. Press seams toward stripe.
16. Using the template, trim pieces to shape. Be careful not to stretch or distort the bias edge while cutting. Make 24 of each side.



17. Sew a stripe/small floral unit to each side of the circle/small floral square as shown below.
18. Make 24.



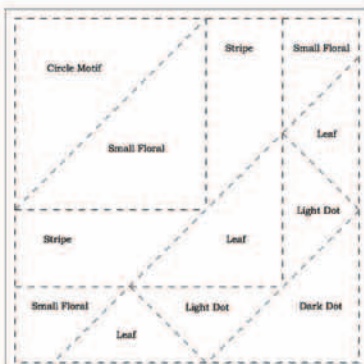


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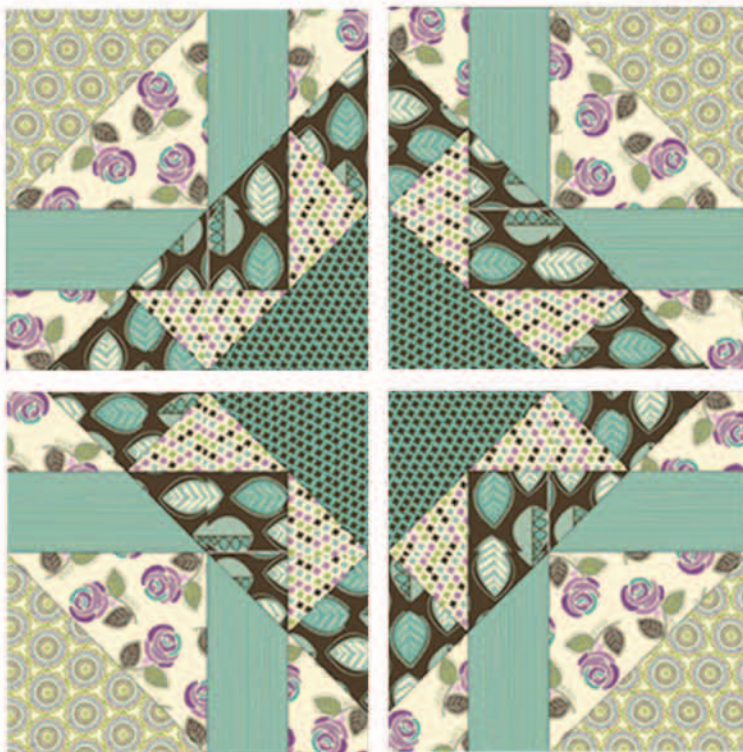


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- Sew the two different halves of the block together match seams. Make 24.
- The complete block should look like the illustration below.



- Sew 4 blocks together with the dark dot triangles meeting in the middle as shown below. Make 6 units.

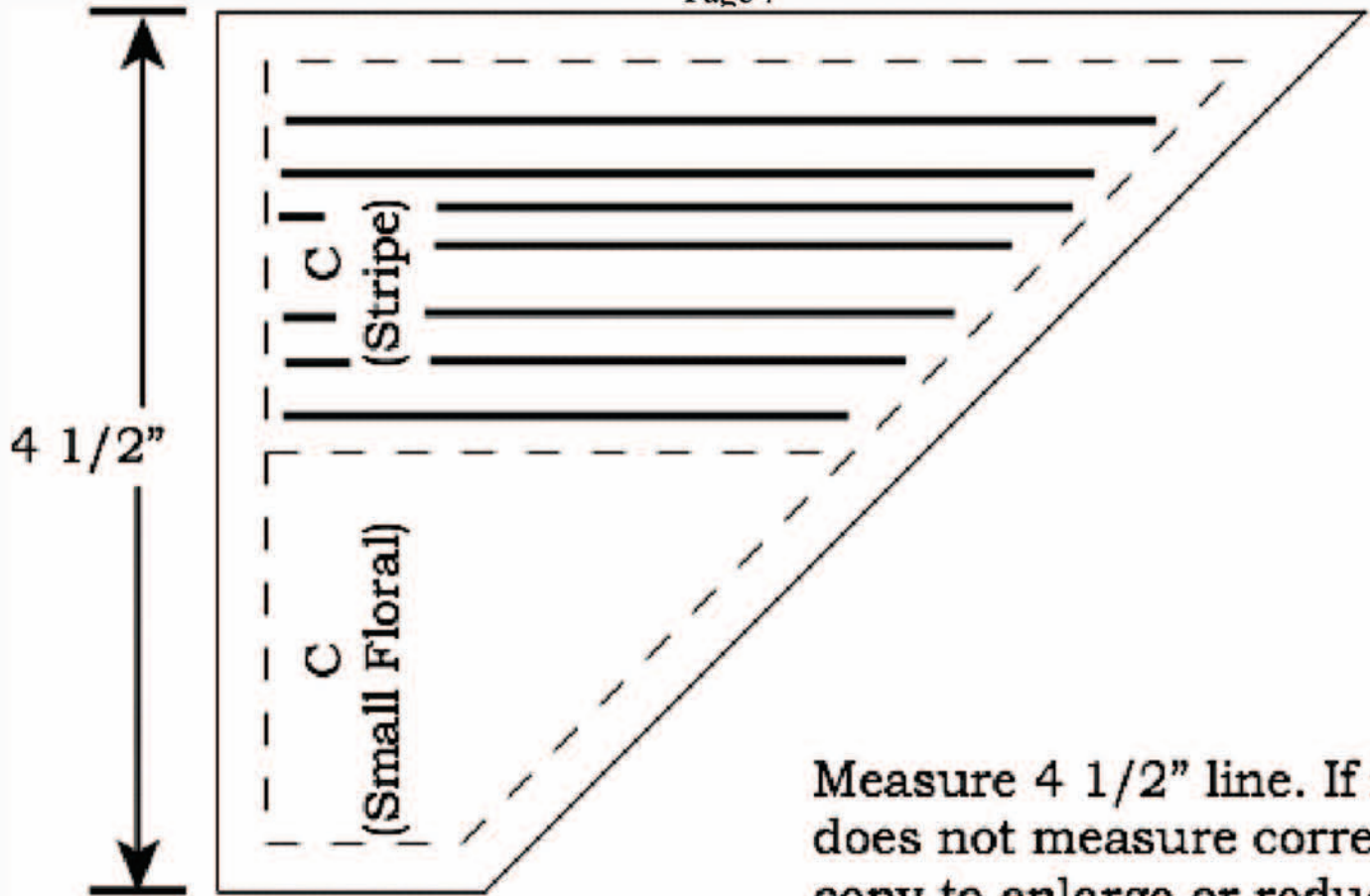


- Sew two 4-squares together to create a row. Make 3 rows.
- Sew rows together to create center of quilt.
- Add borders, one at a time, in numerical order, mitering corners.
- Create a sandwich of backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim and square quilt.
- Join binding pieces with diagonal seams. Press in half and sew to edge of quilt with 1/4" seam.
- Turn binding to back and blind stitch down.
- ENJOY!!

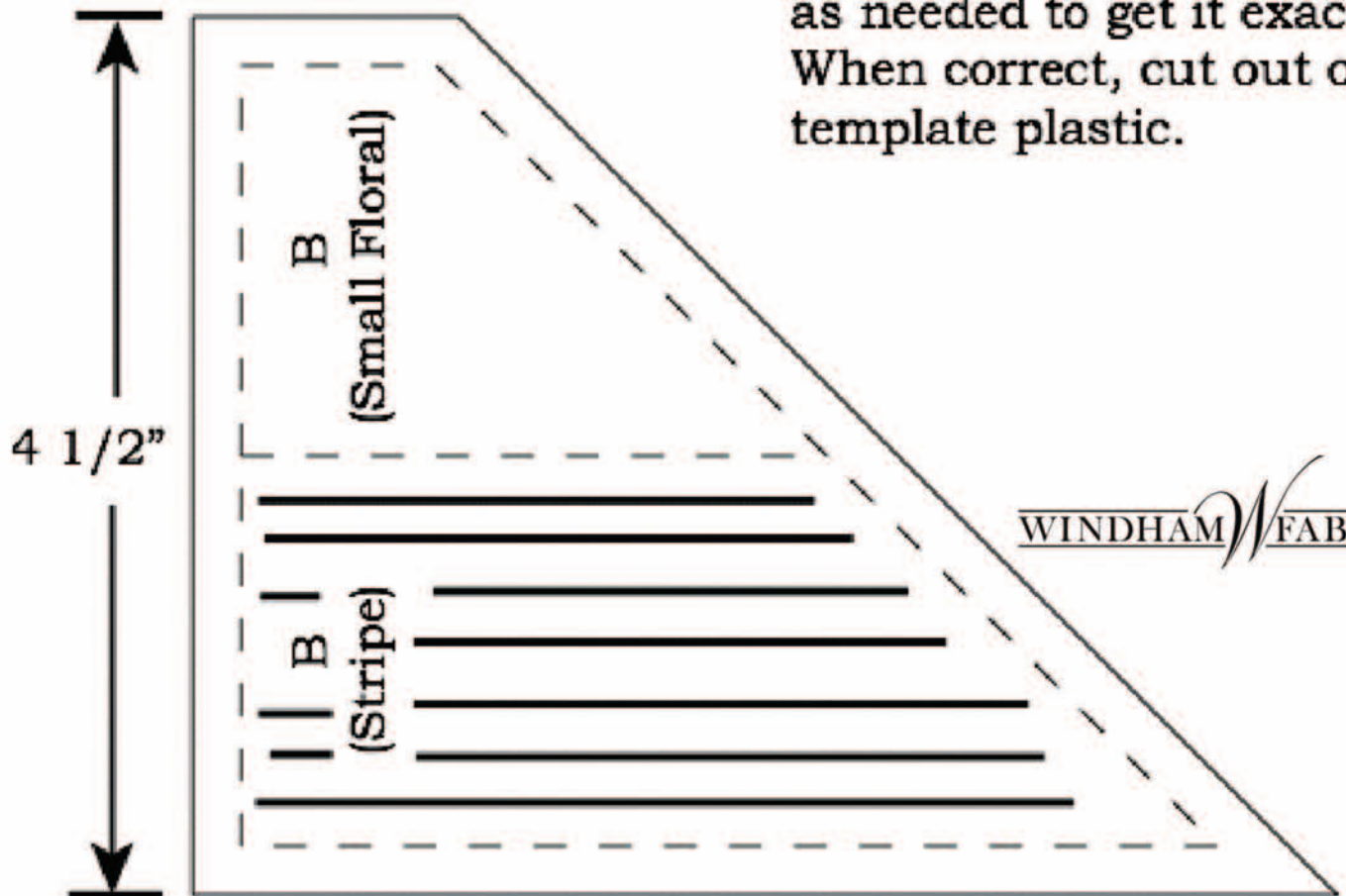
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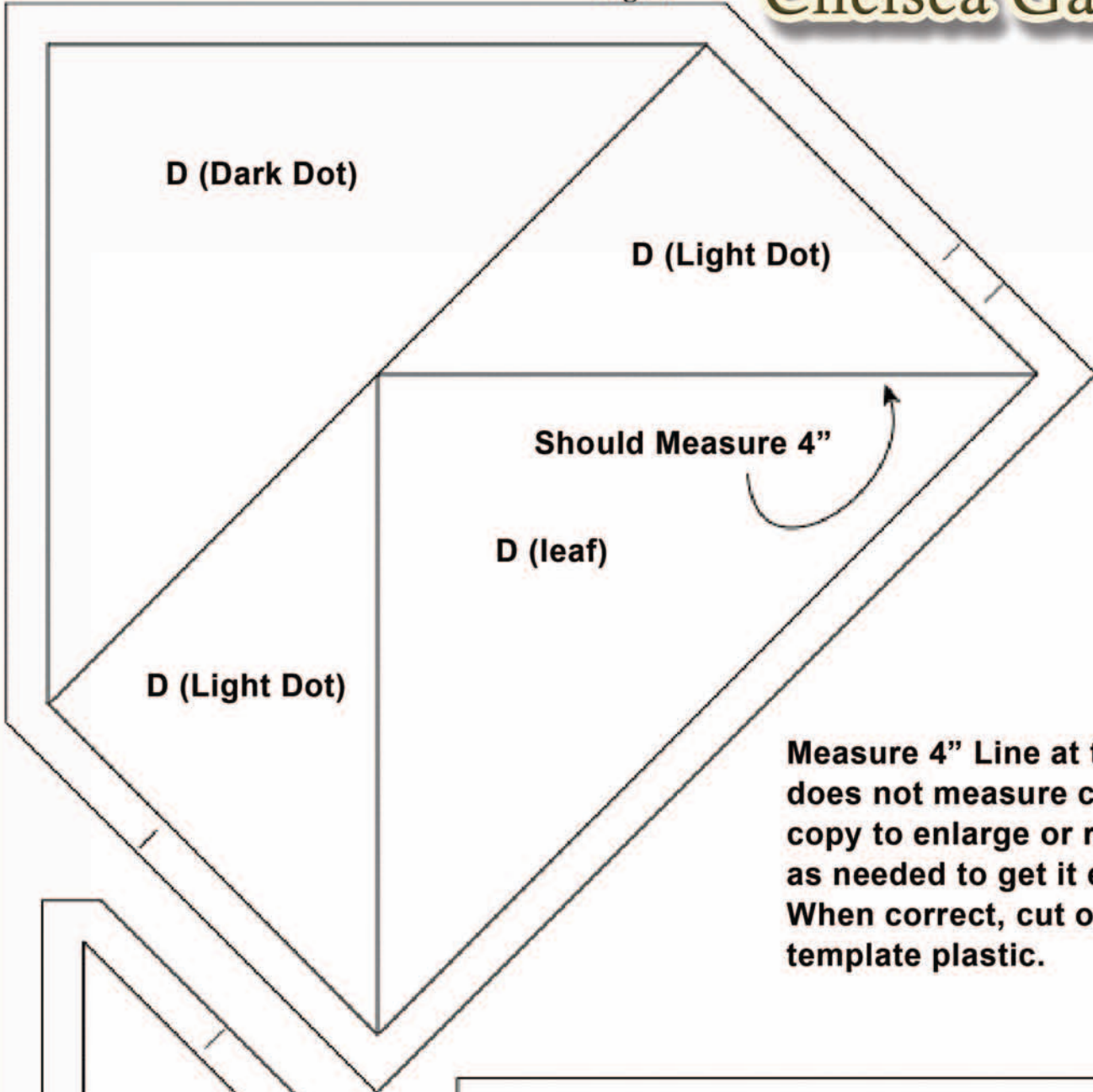
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Measure 4 1/2" line. If it does not measure correctly, copy to enlarge or reduce as needed to get it exact. When correct, cut out of template plastic.
