# Civil War Presidents

## 4. Fourth Border

Sew short red border strips (3"  $\times$  35-1/2") to sides of quilt. Sew long red border strips (3"  $\times$  40-1/2") to top and bottom of quilt. Press. Quilt should now measure 40-1/2"  $\times$  40-1/2".

## 5. Fifth Border

Construct (20) blocks, as shown in Diagram 2. Blocks may be as "scrappy" as desired. IMPORTANT: Template C must be from #30171-5, brown stripe, and template E must be from #30181-3, beige print, to re-create the quilt as shown.




Diagram 2

For each block:

A's Cut (4) 2" X 2" squares of dark fabric

B's Cut (8) 2" X 3" rectangles of light fabric

C's See cutting directions for #30171-5 brown stripe

D's Cut (2) light and (2) dark 3-1/2" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (4) light triangles and (4) dark triangles..

Sew (1) light triangle to (1) dark triangle across longest side. Press and trim unit to 3" X 3". Repeat to make (4) units for each block.

E's See cutting directions for #30181-3 beige print

Press and trim each block to 10-1/2" X 10-1/2".

Sew blocks into (2) strips of (4) blocks and (2) strips of (5) blocks.

Sew short strips of (4) blocks to sides of quilt and sew long strips of (5) blocks to top and bottom of quilt.

Press. Quilt should now measure 60-1/2" X 60-1/2".

## **FINISHING**

Layer. Quilt and bind as desired.

## **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

1 panel (approximately 5/8 yard) SKU #30164-1 Decorative Panel -- center block, piecing

1 yard SKU #30167-1 Red print -- second and fourth borders, piecing and binding

1/2 yard SKU #30177-6 Beige with paisley-- first border, background piecing

l yard SKU #30171-5 Brown stripe -- piecing

1/2 yard SKU #30181-3 Beige print, piecing

1/4 yard SKU #30165-3 Large motifs -- Corners Border #3, piecing

1 FAT ROLL  $^{\text{TM}}$  of Lincoln Bicentennial fabrics from Windham for piecing

OR 3-4 yards of 1/4 yards such as: SKU# 30175-4, 30168-5, 30180-3,

30174-1, 30182-3, 30172-3, 30181-3, 30165-3, 30179-3, 30169-5, 30173-2, 30170-5, 30178-5, 30169-1

# **CUTTING DIRECTIONS:**

SKU #30164-1 Decorative Panel -- center block

Fussy cut 18-1/2" X 18-1/2" section, centering panel.

IMPORTANT: If the panel does not fill this area, cut strips from #30167-1 so that this center section measures 18-1/2" X 18-1/2" Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

SKU #30177-6 Beige with paisley print -- first border

Cut (2) strips across width of fabric. Cut EACH strip to make (1) strip 2-1/4" X 18-1/2" and (1) strip 2-1/4" X 22" for total of (2) short side strips and (2) longer top and bottom strips.

Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

SKU #30167-1 Red print -- second and fourth borders, binding

Cut (5) strips across width of fabric. Piece strips, as necessary, to make (2) strips 2-1/4" X 22" for Border #2 side strips and (2) strips 2-1/4" X 25-1/2" for Border #2 top and bottom strips. Also, (2) strips 3" X 35-1/2" for Border #4 side strips and (2) strips 3" X 40-1/2" for Border #4 top and bottom strips.

Cut (6) 2 1/2" strips, lengthwise, for binding. Piece, as needed to make 260" of binding.

Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

SKU #30171-5 Brown stripe -- piecing

Cut (5) 4-1/2" strips lengthwise fabric. Cut (80) 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles from strips for template C of blocks in fifth border. Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

SKU #30181-3 Beige print, piecing

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips across width of fabric. Cut (80) 2-1/2" X 2-1/2" squares for template E of blocks in fifth border.
Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

SKU #30165-3 Large motifs -- Corners, third border

Fussy cut (4) 5-1/2" X 5-1/2" squares

Use remainder of fabric for piecing blocks in borders 3 and 5.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

## 1. First Border

Sew short beige border strips (2-1/4" X 18-1/2") to sides of center panel. Sew long beige border strips (2-1/4" X 22") to top and bottom of center panel and side strips.

Press. Quilt should now measure 22" X 22".

# 2. Second Border

Sew short red border strips (2-1/4" X 22" to sides of quilt. Sew long red border strips (2-1/4" X 25-1/2") to top and bottom of quilt. Press. Quilt should now measure 25-1/2" X 25-1/2".

# 3. Third Border

Construct (20) blocks, as shown in diagram 1. Blocks may be as "scrappy" as desired.



For each block:

Cut (1) 6-1/4" X 6-1/4" square from dark fabric and (1) 6-1/4" X 6-1/4" square from light / medium fabric. Cut each square twice diagonally to make (4) triangles per square. Use (2) light triangles and (2) dark triangles to make block 1. Use left over triangles for other blocks in this border.

Trim and press each block to measure 5-1/2" X 5-1/2". Repeat to make (20) blocks.

Diagram 1

Sew blocks together in strips of (5) blocks. Repeat to make (4) strips. Sew a 5-1/2" X 5-1/2" fussy cut block from #30165-3 to the ends of (2) strips of blocks.

Sew short strips to sides of quilt.

Sew long strips (with fussy cut corner blocks) to top and bottom of quilt. Press.

Quilt should now measure 35-1/2" x 35-1/2"
