Size: 36" x 48"

## Fabric Requirements:

(2) 3-1/2" squares each (or a fat 1/8th): 30773-1, 30773-3, 30774-1, 30775-1, 30776-1, 30776-2, 30778-1, 30778-2, 30779-2, 30784-2, 30786-1, 30786-2

(3) 3-1/2" squares each ( or a fat 1/8th): 30773-2, 30774-2, 30774-3, 30775-2, 30775-3, 30776-3, 30777-1, 30777-2, 30779-1, 30782-2, 30784-1, 30784-3

Fat 1/8th: 30777-3, 30778-3, 30780-2, 30780-3, 30782-1, 30782-3

Fat 1/4: 30772-2, 30771-1, 30771-2, 30771-3, 30772-4, 30776-5, 30776-6, 30783-1, 30783-2, 30785-1, 30785-2, 30785-3, 30786-3, 30786-5, 30786-6

Fat 1/4 with complete circle/eagle image with flowers: 30781-1, 30781-2, 30781-3

Paper-backed Fusible Web: 5/8 yard

Backing: 1-1/2 yards

Bias Binding: 3/4 yard

## Block 1: Motif Block

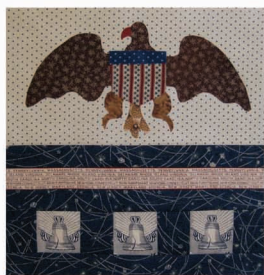


Cut: 12-1/2" square 30776-5

Cut a piece of fusible web slightly larger than eagle/circle motif on 30781-1. Fuse to wrong side of fabric.

Cut out image. Remove paper backing and fuse to fabric square, centering. Secure image with clear polyester thread using zigzag stitch.

## Block 2: Appliqué Eagle Block



Section 1: Enlarge eagle appliqué pattern 200%.

Trace pattern to paper side of fusible web, reversing the pattern. Add 1/4" to sections of leg, tail, wings and head that will tuck under the shield. Cut out images with extra paper around image. Use the following fabrics: wings and head 30777-3, beak 30781, legs 30784-3, tail 30782-3, shield 30776-2 & 30785-1. Fuse web to wrong side of fabrics, remove paper. Fuse eagle to 6-1/6" x 12-1/2" of 30776-6, following pattern. Secure with clear polyester thread using zigzag stitch.

Section 2: Cut : A: (2) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" 30772-2

B: (1) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" 30771-1, centering states stripe

Sew A to B. Sew the second A to opposite side of B. Press.

Section 3: Cut C: (3) 2-1/2" squares 30771-2, centering bell image

D: (4) 2" x 2-1/2" 30772-2

E: (1) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" 30772-2

Sew the following row together: D,C,D,C,D,C,D. Press. Attach E to bottom.

Sew the three sections of the block together as shown in photo. Block measures 12-1/2" x 12-1/2", unfinished.

## Block 3: States Block



Cut A: (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" 30771-1, centering states stripe

B: (8) 2" x 4-1/2" 30782-1

For each block, sew B to A. Sew a second B to opposite side of A. Block measures 4-1/2" x 4-1/2", unfinished. Make (4) blocks.

## Block 4: Bell Block



A: (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" 30771-2, centering bell image

A: (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" 30771-3, centering bell image

B: (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" 30780-2

B: (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" 30780-3

Follow instructions for block 3. Make 2 blocks in each color.

## Block 5: Flag Block



Cut: A: (6) 4-1/2" squares, 2 each from 30785-1, 30785-2, 30785-3.

Cut a piece of fusible web 5" x 9" and fuse to back of 30776-2. Cut (6) 2-1/4" x 2-3/4" rectangles. Fuse a rectangle to upper left corner of A. Secure edges with a zigzag stitch using clear polyester thread.

Make 6 blocks.

## Block 6: Eagle Block



Cut (2) 4-1/2" squares, one each from 30781-2 and 30781-3 centering eagle image.

## Block 7: Diamond in a Square Block



For each block cut:

A: (1) 3-3/8" square dark fabric

B: (2) 2-7/8" squares light fabric, cut once on diagonal to form (4) half-square triangles.

Sew a B to one side of A, right sides together. Repeat on opposite side. Press. Sew a B on two remaining sides.

Press. Block measures 4-1/2", unfinished.

Make (66) blocks.

## Block 8: Flower Block



Cut (8) 4-1/2" squares light fabric.

Pick (8) floral motifs from 30781-1, 30781-2, 30781-3.

Iron a piece of fusible web, slightly larger than floral motif, to wrong side of the image. Cut out. Remove paper and fuse to square. Make (8) blocks.

## Quilt Assembly:

Use the quilt photo as a guide.

Sew Blocks 1 and 2 together to form center of quilt.

Sew (6) Block 7's together in a vertical row.

Attach to left side of quilt center.

Sew the following blocks together in a vertical row: 7,7,6,7,7,7. Attach to left side of quilt.

Sew another vertical row: 5,7,7,7,7,5. Attach to left side of quilt.

Repeat the last 3 steps for the right side

Sew the following blocks together in a horizontal row: 7,7,8,7,7,8,7,7. Attach to top of quilt.

Sew a second row: 7,4,7,3,7,3,7,4,7. Attach to top of quilt.

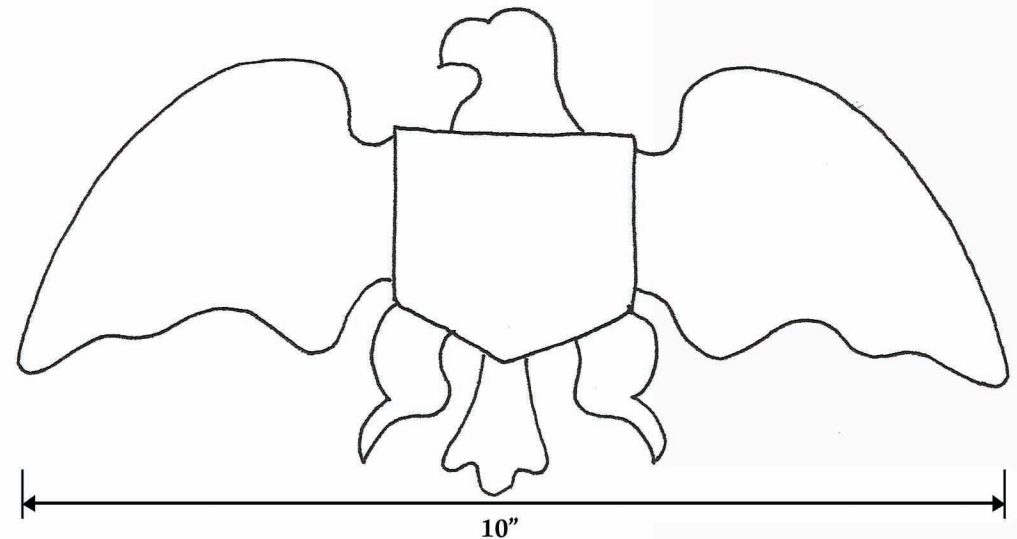
Sew a third row: 8,7,7,7,5,7,7,7,8. Attach to top of quilt.

Repeat the last 3 steps for the bottom section

Layer, quilt, and bind.

**Eagle applique pattern . Enlarge 200%.**



As all copiers will affect sizing the final measure of the eagle from wing tip at widest point should be 10"
