

# FAIRLY THERE

## Step 4: Constructing the Quilt Top

6. Vertical Sashing – sew (1) 30947-4 Brown, (1) Pink, (1) Brown, (1) Pink, (1) Brown, (1) Pink, (1) Brown together to make (1) really long strip – Make 2.
7. Sew the COLUMNS together as shown in QUILT PICTURE and remember to add (1) 30951-1 Red (Horizontal Sashing) between each Block – Make 3 Columns – Each Column will include (4) Blocks and (3) Horizontal Sashing rectangles.  
*NOTE: Keep in mind the position of each BLOCK.*
8. Sew COLUMNS together and remember to add (1) VERTICAL SASHING between each Column.
9. Add the Border to finish the Top – Sew the Sides and then the Top and Bottom.

## Step 5: Backing, Batting, Binding – The 3 B's

10. Quilt as desired.
11. Sew the Binding on to finish the quilt.

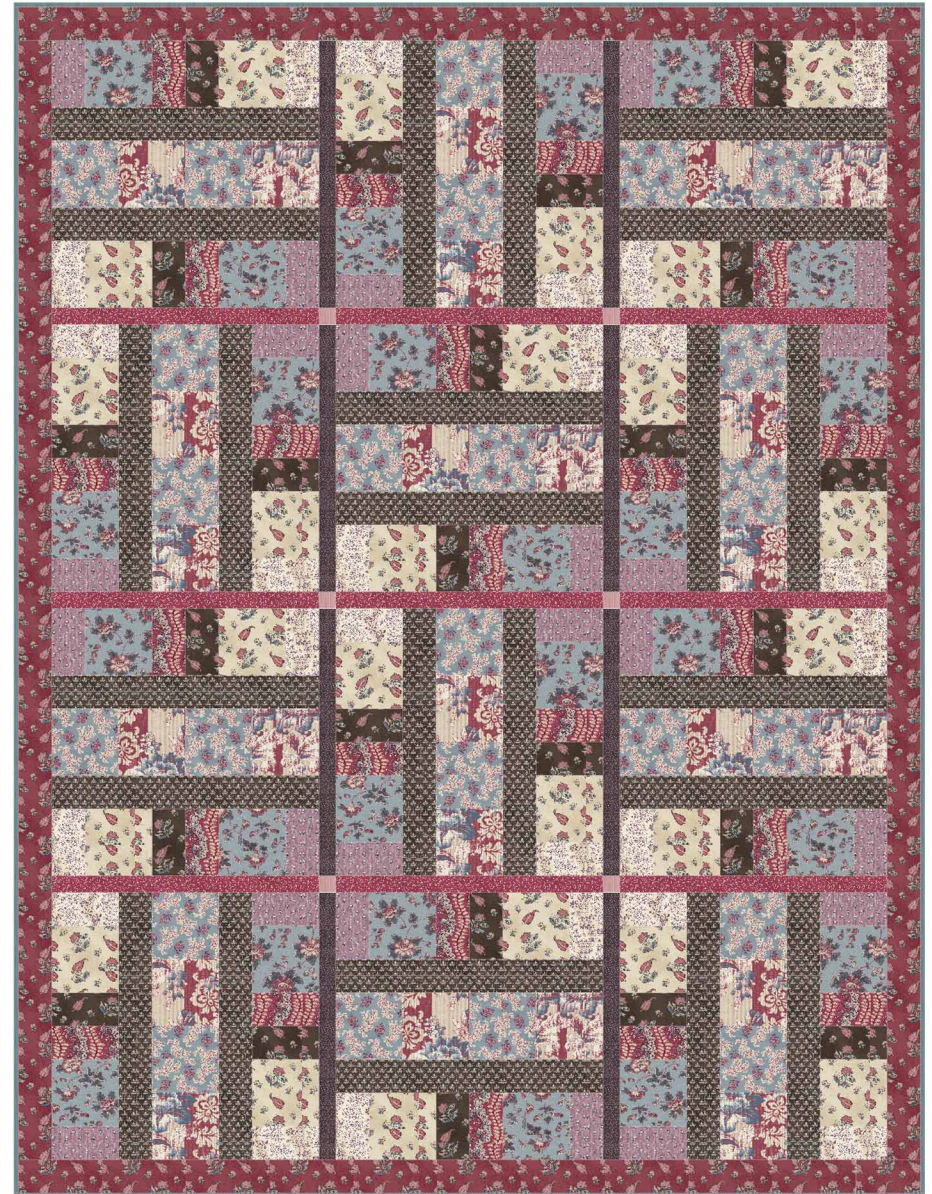

Finished Block Size: 16"  
Sashing Width: 1" Finished  
Border: 2" Finished

## General Information

All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.  
Pre-wash and press with spray starch. WOF = Width of Fabric.  
Press all seams open unless directed as will decrease bulk.  
These instructions are designed to cut a little and sew a little for less confusion.

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting

### Block – Center Strip

30942-1 Red 1/2 Yard (4) 4 1/2" Strips  
30954-2 Blue 1/2 Yard (4) 4 1/2" Strips

### Block – Side Strip – From Top to Bottom

30945-3 Purple 1/4 Yard (A) (3) 2 1/2" Strips  
30953-2 Blue 3/8 Yard (B) (3) 4 1/2" Strips  
30943-1 Red 1/4 Yard (C) (3) 2 1/2" Strips  
30952-4 Brown 1/4 Yard (D) (3) 2 1/2" Strips  
30952-5 Cream 3/8 Yard (E) (3) 4 1/2" Strips  
30950-3 Purple 1/4 Yard (F) (3) 2 1/2" Strips

### Sashing for Block

30947-4 Brown (Vertical) 1/4 Yard (4) 1 1/2" Strips  
Re-cut into (8) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" Rectangles  
30952-1 Red (Border) 1/2 Yard (7) 2 1/2" Strips  
30946-4 Brown 7/8 Yard (1) 16 1/2" Strip & (4) 2 1/2" Strips  
Re-Cut into (24) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Rectangles (Use in STEP 3)

### Sashing between Blocks and Border

30951-1 Red (Horizontal) 1/4 Yard (5) 1 1/2" Strips  
Re-cut into (9) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" Rectangles  
30948-6 Pink (Joining Squares) 1/8 Yard (6) 1 1/2" Squares

### Backing, Batting and Binding – The 3 B's

Backing 3 1/2 Yards  
Soft & Bright Batting 60" x 80"  
30948-7 Teal 1/2 Yard – Binding --- (8) 2" Strips

## Special Notions

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Rulers, & Straight Pins  
Sewing machine and threads to match your fabrics.

### Step 1: Block – Center Strip

1. 30942-1 Red and 30954-2 Blue – Sew (1) of each together to make new strips at 8 1/2" by WOF – Sew (2) of the 8 1/2" strips together to make the final strip at 16 1/2" x WOF as shown in "EXAMPLE A" – Make (4) strips.  
2. Re-cut the (4) strips into (12) 16 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles – Set aside for use later.



### Step 2: Block – Side Strip

3. Sew (1) strip of "A, B, C, D, E, and F" together to make new strip at 16 1/2" x WOF – Make (3) strips – See EXAMPLE B.  
4. Re-cut into (24) 16 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles – Set aside for use later.

### Step 3: Constructing the Block

5. Sew (1) Side Strip (Bottom), (1) Sashing for Block, (1) Center Strip, (1) Sashing for Block and (1) Side Strip (Top) together to make the 16 1/2" block – Make (12) Blocks – See EXAMPLE C.
