Finished size: 48" x 48"

Fabric Requirements:

From Windham's **Empress** fabric line by Nancy Gere:

1/3 yd. #24457-1

1/3 yd. #24457-2

1/3 yd. #24457-3

Fat quarters or 4" x 7" scraps or various prints from the Empress line

1-2/3 yds. #24452-1 for border

3 yds. #24453-1 for backing

1/2 yd. #24451-2 for binding

Fan Blocks: sixteen (16) 10" finished blocks, cut:

Background: four (4) 10-1/2" squares of #24457-1, four (4) 10-1/2" squares of #24457-2, eight (8) 10 -1/2" squares of #24457-3.

Fan Blades: using template "A" and a lightweight fusible web, cut 80 fan blades from various prints.

****NOTE** – you will need to add 1/4" seam allowance to ONLY the outside edge of the first and last fan blades in each block.

Fan Centers: using template "B" and fusible web, cut four (4) #24456-1, four (4) #24456-2, eight (8) 24456-3.

Assembly:

Following the instructions for the fusible web you are using, fuse fan blades and fan center to background blocks, with fan center slightly overlapping the bottom edge of the fan blades. Before joining the blocks, it's a good idea to stitch around the blades and center with a very small zig zag stitch, using polyester monofilament thread, to secure the appliqués.

Join the blocks, as in the photo. Add the border strips: two (2) 4-1/2" x 48-1/2" and two (2) 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips, or miter, if you prefer.

Layer and quilt as desired, then bind.

Templates are 50% of original size
