

**Sewing continued:**

10. Sew the vertical fabric B borders to opposite sides of the quilt and the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**Finishing:**

11. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt the layers together using beige quilting thread.

12. Fold the binding strips in half lengthwise and press fold line. Align raw edges of binding with raw edges of the quilt top. Sew in place then turn folded edge to the back and stitch in place.

# Flora Fantasy

Quilt Size: 62" x 62"

Center Square In Square block: 16"

Corner Square In Square blocks and Nine Patch blocks: 6"

## Fabric Requirements:

Fabric A 1-1/3 yd SKU# 29329-3 purple

Fabric B 1-1/4 yd SKU# 29330-7 red/blue

Fabric C 1-1/2 yd SKU# 29331-8 multi

Fabric D 1/2 yd SKU# 29332-4 blue

Fabric E 1/2 yd SKU# 29333-4 blue

Fabric F 1/2 yd SKU# 29334-2 red

Binding: 2/3 yd SKU# 29329-3 purple - cut (8) 2-1/4" strips and sew together end-to-end for binding.

Backing: 3 yds SKU# 29328-2 purple, Cut (1) 66" piece, then cut remainder in half from top to bottom and sew into a long strip. Sew this strip to the selvage side of the 66" piece. Trim completed backing to 66" square.

## Cutting:

fabric A: Cut (2) 1-1/2" x width of fabric (wof) strips, recut into (2) 16-1/2" strips and (2) 18-1/2" strips. Cut (9) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (144) 2-1/2" squares. Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips and recut into (16) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B: Cut (6) 4-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end, then recut into (2) 54-1/2" vertical borders and (2) 62-1/2" horizontal borders. Cut (1) 8-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (4) 8-1/2" squares.

Fabric C: Cut (1) 16-1/2" x wof strip, recut (1) 16-1/2" square. Cut remainder of strip into (2) 6-1/2" pieces, then recut these pieces into (4) 6-1/2" squares. Cut (9) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (144) 3-1/2" squares.

Fabric D: Cut (4) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut (2) 32-1/2" vertical borders, and (2) 40-1/2" borders.

Fabric E: Cut (2) 6-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (4) 18-1/2" borders.

Fabric F: Cut (8) 1-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (2) 30-1/2" vertical borders and (2) 32-1/2" horizontal borders. Cut (2) 40-1/2" vertical borders and (2) 42-1/2" horizontal borders.

## Sewing:

1. Position a fabric B 8-1/2" square in one corner of the fabric C 16-1/2" square. Sew in a diagonal line from opposite corners. Trim away excess fabric, fold fabric B out and press the seam. Repeat in each of the remaining three corners to complete the center square in square block.

2. Sew a fabric A vertical border to opposite sides of the quilt center and the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

3. Sew a fabric A 3-1/2" square in each of a fabric C square to make the corner square in square blocks (see step 1). make 4

4. Sew a fabric E border to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew a fabric A/C corner square to each end of the two remaining borders and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

5. Sew a fabric F vertical border to opposite sides of the quilt. Sew a fabric F horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt.

6. Sew a fabric D vertical border to opposite sides of the quilt and Fabric D horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

7. Sew a fabric F vertical border to opposite sides of the quilt. Sew a fabric F horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt.

8. Using fabric A and fabric C squares, sew a total of 32 Nine Patch blocks. there are 16 Block One with 5 fabric A and 4 fabric C squares and 16 Block Two with 5 fabric C and 4 fabric A squares. See Nine Patch Diagram

9. Sew two vertical borders with 4 Blocks One and 3 Blocks Two. Sew two horizontal borders with 5 Blocks Two and 4 Blocks One. Sew the vertical borders to the opposite sides of the quilt and the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
