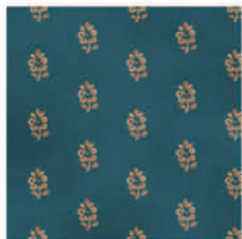

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Directions:

1. Sew 31704-5 green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of 31700-3 cream $7\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Sew 31704-5 green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to each side. Set Aside.



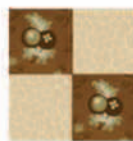
2. For sawtooth border - with right sides together place one 31701-4 red $2\frac{1}{2}$ " on top of one 31705-3 cream square. Draw a line diagonally from one corner to the other. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of drawn line. Cut apart on diagonal line. Press open. Yield: (2) right triangle squares. Trim each to an accurate 2" square. Make (96) total. Sew together (8) rows of six squares each. Sew one row to the top and bottom of each $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew together (8) rows of six squares each. Sew one 31705-3 cream 2" square to each end of each pieced strip. Sew one strip to each side of each square as shown.



3. Sew 31701-2 blue 1" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of each square. Sew one 31701-2 blue 1" x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to each side of each square.



4. Sew two 31703-1 brown $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to two 31700-3 cream $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square checkerboard block. Make nine total.



5. For sashing begin and end with a checkerboard block alternating with two 31702-5 green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew together a row. Make three total. Beginning and ending with a 31702-5 green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, sew together two blocks alternating with the 31702-5 green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Make two rows. Sew together checkerboard rows alternating with block rows for quilt top.



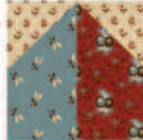
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6. For picket border - place one 31707-4 red 2 ½” square right sides together at the top of one 31709-2 blue 2 ½” x 4 ½” piece. Sew diagonally from the lower left corner to the upper right corner. Trim away excess from the back. Press open. Make (16) blue pickets. Repeat sewing diagonally from the lower right corner to the upper left corner. Make (16).



Repeat using 31707-4 red 2 ½” squares and 31703-4 red 2 ½” x 4 ½” pieces sewing (16) pieces from the lower right corner to the upper left corner and (16) pieces from lower left corner to upper right corner.



Sew together in pairs of one of each color. Make four rows of eight pairs each. Sew one row to the top and bottom of the quilt. For the cornerstones sew one 31707-4 red 2 ½” square on each of three corners on each 31709-2 blue 4 ½” square and 31703-4 red 4 ½” square in the same manner as shown. Sew one 4 ½” block of each color to the top and bottom of the remaining picket rows.



Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.



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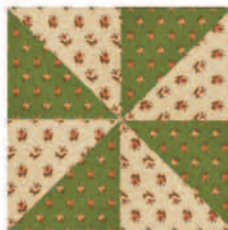
7. Sew one 31707-5 green 1 ½” x 40 ½” strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 31707-5 green 1 ½” x 42 ½” to each side.



8. Sew one 31706-2 blue 4 ½” x 42 ½” to the top and bottom of the quilt.



Following the directions in step #2 for a right square triangle make (16) total using 31707-4 red 3” square and 31707-5 green 3” square. Trim each to an accurate 2 ½” square. Sew together four right square triangles into one 4 ½” pinwheel block as shown. Make four total.



Sew one pinwheel block to each end of each 31706-2 blue 4 ½” x 42 ½” strip. Sew one row to each side of the quilt.



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9. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Bind quilt using 31701-1 brown pieced as needed for length.
