
Lay out pink and green blocks on point, beginning with a green row and alternating with a pink row. Sew the rows together diagonally.

Square the quilt, trimming off points of green squares.

Sew green border in place, mitering corners. Then sew white w/green outer border, mitering corners.

Back and bind

Pink w/ flower 26225-2	1-1/3 yard	3 – 5 1/2" strips
		4 – 2 1/2" strips
		$6 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips for binding
Piink stripe 26226-2	3/4 yard	$2 - 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips $6 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips
Green vine 26221-6	1-1/2 yard	$10 - 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips $6 - 2$ " strips (for inner boarder)
Green circle 27746-6	1-2/3 yard	$8-3 \frac{1}{2}$ " (3 for center 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips) $6-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " (strips for outer boarder)

Backing:

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Sew 2 pink stripe strips (2-1/2") to each side of the pink flower strip (5-1/2").

You should sew a total of 3 sets.

Cut these strips into 5-1/2" You should have 15 Set A's



Next sew 2 of the pink flower strips (2-1/2") to the pink stripe strips (5-1/2").

You should sew 2 of these sets.



You should have 30 Set B's

Cut these strips into 2-1/2"strips.


Sew 2 of Set B to the top and bottom of Set A to create the square.

You will have 15 squares.



Sew 2 green tone strips (3-1/2") to each side of a white/green circle strip (3-1/2").

You should sew a total of 5 sets.



Cut these into 3-1/2" strip sets. You should have 48 Set C's



Next sew these Set C's to one of the white w/green circle strips (3-1/2").



Sew across the cut edge and butt the next set to the previous.

Continue down the strip until no room is left.

Repeat until you have 24 sewn on the strips.

Press seam allowance.



Now cut the sets apart, squaring as you go. Sew the new set to the remaining Set C pieces to create the green blocks.

You will have 24 blocks.
