Finished size: 30" x 30"

Block size: 6"

Materials & Cutting List

1/2 yard #27393-7 brown stripe for inner border and Block A (cut four 1-1/2" x wof strips and two 7" squares)

1/2 yard #27391-8 multi-colored print for Block A, Block C and outer border (cut four 3" x wof strips for borders and eight 3-1/2" squares)

1/3 yard 27396-1 for binding (cut four 2-1/4" strips)

1/6 yard 29106-9 orange floral for Block A (cut four 3-7/8" squares; recut diagonally once)

1/6 yard 29106-19 small black floral print for Block C (cut four 4 1/4" squares; recut diagonally twice)

1/6 yard 29389-1 red dots on brown for Block C (cut eight 4" squares; recut diagonally once)

Fat eighth 29107-7 brown large floral print and 29107-10 black large floral print for Block B (cut four each Piece C using the templates provided)

1/4 yard #27389-2 yellow dots on white for Block B (cut eight Piece A and eight Piece B)

Sewing Instructions

Block A

Sew two orange floral triangles on either side of a multi 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make four units. Sew a brown stripe triangle to complete the block. Repeat to make four of Block A.



Block B

Sew a Piece A yellow dots on white on the left side of large black floral Piece C triangle and a yellow dots on white Piece B on the right. Repeat to make a total of four black and four brown blocks.





Block C

Sew four small black floral triangles on the sides of each 3-1/2" multi-colored square. In the same fashion, sew four red dots on brown triangles on the four sides. Repeat to make four of Block C.




Quilt Assembly


Referring to the quilt layout diagram (or photograph), sew the Block A, Block B and Block C pieces together in rows. Sew the rows together to complete the 24" square quilt top. Cut two brown stripe border pieces to measure 24-1/2" and attach to the sides of the quilt. Trim two other strips to measure 26" and attach to the top and bottom.

Cut two multi print border strips to measure 26" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut the remaining two strips to measure 30" and sew to the top and bottom.

Finishing

Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired. Trim the quilt top to 30" square and apply the 2-1/4" binding strips, using your favorite method.
