31480-5	aqua, med rose bud	¾ yd

31478-1	blue, roses	1 ¾ yd
31478-2	white, roses	1 yd



Cut out the following fabric:

Backing: 5 yards to piece backing if using standard 42" wide fabric or 2 ½ yards if using extra wide backing of 90" or 108".

Binding: 31480-1 blue med rose bud cut 8 2 ¼ x 42

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


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Piecing Directions:

1. Layout the blocks around the hankie panel in the center. Place aqua squares in the upper left and lower right corners. Place red, blue and purple bows in opposite corners (upper right and lower left). Place random blue strips on top and bottom of panel. Place random pink strips on left and right of panel. Layout all 12 blocks before sewing.



2. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam throughout. Once layout of all 12 blocks is complete, construct blocks. Arrange blocks in any order. Sew blocks together, 3 rows wide and 4 rows long.

Borders:

1. Always measure your quilt before you cut the lengths of your border strips. Always square your quilt before putting the borders on (this prevents a skewed finished quilt). Sides of quilts should always be within $\frac{1}{4}$ " in length of the opposite side of the quilt. If they are not within $\frac{1}{4}$ " of each other, now is the time to readjust seams or to trim.
2. First Inner border: Blue stripe fabric: Cut the fabric across the width of the fabric to ensure orientation of the stripes. Some piecing will be needed to get needed lengths.
3. Second Inner Border: White rose: Cut fabric, some piecing will be necessary.
4. First Outer Border: Aqua small rose buds: Cut fabric, some piecing will be necessary.
5. Last Outer Border: Blue rose: Cut fabric, some piecing will be necessary.

Backing: Either buy backing fabric, usually 90" or 108" wide, or enough yardage to piece a backing together. Backing should measure 82" x 100" to ensure a long arm quilter has enough fabric for machine.

Sandwich your quilt: Your quilt will have three layers: the top, the batting in the middle, and the backing. Pin or baste the layers together.

Quilt: As desired.

Bind: Sew $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips together, fold in half (wrong side together), press. With raw edges together and binding laying on the front of the quilt, sew $1\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge. Turn the binding to the back of the quilt and hand sew to the back. Don't forget to put a label on back of your quilt!!
