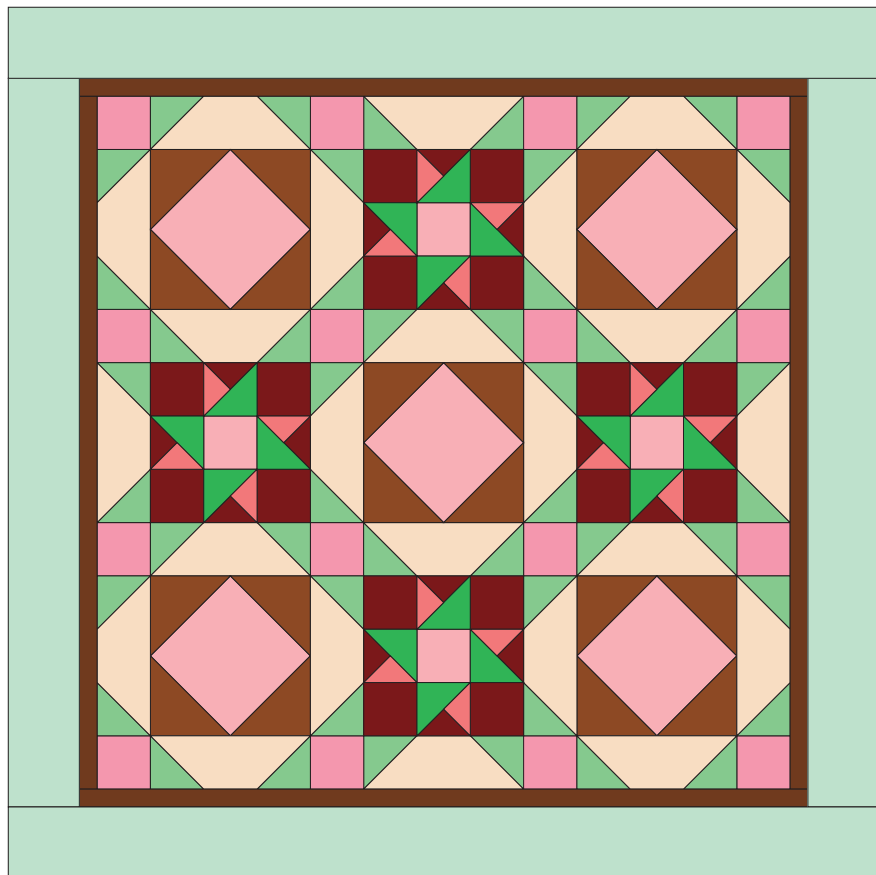

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Square-in-a-Square Block		
Fabric A #26571 Pink Large Flowers	5/8 yd	(5) 9" squares
Fabric B #26575 Brown Print	1/2 yd	(10) 6-7/8" squares <i>(cut in half on diagonal once to make 2 triangles)</i>
Star of Hope Block		
Fabric C #26576 Pink & Green Flowers	1/4 yd	(4) 4-1/2" squares
Fabric D #26568 Brown Flowers	1/2 yd	(16) 4-1/2" squares (4) 5-1/4" squares <i>(cut in half on diagonal twice to make 4 triangles)</i>
Fabric E #26573 Green Dots	1/4 yd	(8) 4-7/8" squares <i>(cut in half on diagonal once to make 2 triangles)</i>
Fabric F #26573 Pink Dots	1/4 yd	(4) 5-1/4" squares <i>(cut in half on diagonal twice to make 4 triangles)</i>
Sashings		
Fabric G #26574 Pink Stripe	1-1/3 yd	(24) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips <i>(cut 12 vertically and 12 horizontally)</i>
Fabric F #26570 Green on Green Flowers	7/8 yd	(48) 4-1/2" squares
Fabric H #26566 Pink Circles	1/2 yd	(16) 4-1/2" squares
Borders and Binding		
Fabric I #26573 Brown Dots	1 yd	(2) 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips (2) 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips (7) 2-1/4" strips <i>(binding)</i>
Fabric J #26568 Green Flowers	1 yd	(2) 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips (2) 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips

Square-in-a-Square Block Assembly

1. Sew one Fabric B triangle to each side of one 12-1/2" Fabric A square (Fig 1). Make five blocks.

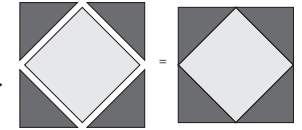

Star of Hope Block Assembly

2. To make star points sew Fabric D and Fabric F small triangles together. Sew this unit to one Fabric E large triangle to make a square (Fig. 2). Make four star point squares.

3. Sew one Fabric D square to each side of one star point square to make top and bottom strips of the star block. Sew one star point square to each side of one Fabric C square for center strip and assemble the block as shown in Fig. 3. Make four blocks.

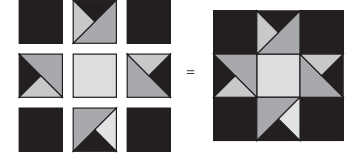

Sashings

4. Sew two Fabric F squares to each side of a Fabric G rectangle diagonally. Flip each square towards corner, press, and trim 1/4" away from seams (Fig. 4). To keep striped pattern in a vertical position, make 12 strips with vertical stripes and 12 with horizontal stripes (Fig. 4). Make 24 sashing strips.

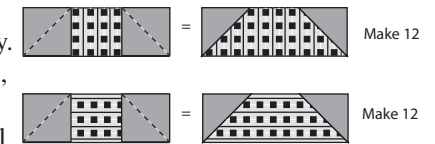

Quilt Top Assembly

5. Following Fig. 5 diagram, assemble blocks in rows, using Fabric H squares for sashing cornerstones.

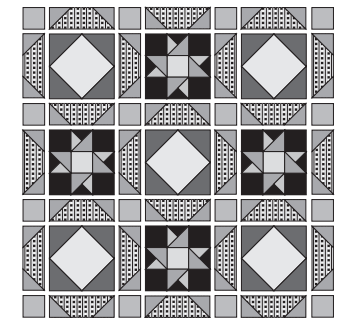

Borders

6. Sew two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric I strips to left and right sides of quilt and two 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt.
7. Sew two 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric J strips to left and right sides of quilt and two 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing the Quilt

Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
