Fabric Requirements

Fat 1/8's of 6 fruit prints for basket bottoms (32174-1, 32174-2, 32174-3, 32175-1, 32176-3, 32176-5)

Fat 1/8's of 3 tonal dark prints for basket points (32180-1, 32180-2, 32182-3)

5/8 yd of cream print for basket backgrounds (32179-5)

1/4 yd of grape print for basket (32178-6)

5/8 yd of stripe for sashing (32181-X)

1/8 yd purple for cornerstones (32180-6)

1 1/4 yds of large fruit print for setting (32173-X)

7/8 yd green for inner border and binding (32182-3)

1 3/4 yds of outer border (32172-X)

4 yards backing

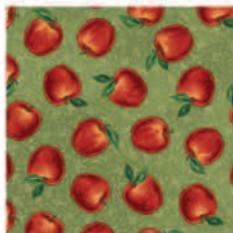

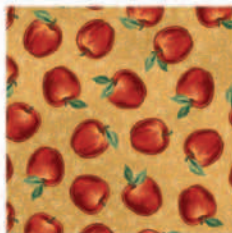

Cutting Instructions

From EACH fruit print for basket bottoms, cut:

- 1 – 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares.
- 2 – 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” square. Cut these squares in half diagonally once.

From EACH dark print for basket points, cut:

- 9 – 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares.
- 3 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares.

From cream print for backgrounds, cut:

- 2 – 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” strips; cut into 27 – 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares.
- 1 – 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strip; cut into 18 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” rectangles.
- 1 – 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” strip; cut into 5 – 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares, cut squares in half diagonally once.

From grape print, cut:

- 1 – 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” strip; cut into 6 – 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares.

From sashing stripe, cut:

- 9 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” strips; cut into 36 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” rectangles.

From purple for cornerstones, cut:

- 1 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” strip; cut into 24 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” squares.

From green for inner border and binding, cut:

- 6 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” strips for inner border.
- 7 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strips for binding.

From large fruit print for setting, cut:

- 1 – 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strip; cut into 4 – 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares.
- 1 – 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strip; cut into 2 – 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares, cut in half diagonally twice for side triangles.
- 1 – 8” strip; cut into 2 – 8” squares, cut in half diagonally once for corner triangles.

From focus print for outer border, cut 4 – LENGTHWISE 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strips.

**Tip: use the remaining fabric for your backing. This added to one width of fabric should be just the right size!*

Piecing Instructions

From fruit prints and grape print 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares, make Half Square Triangles. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of the grape print squares. Pair, right sides together, with a fruit print and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ ” on both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on drawn line and press to one side. Trim to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” if necessary. You should have 12 Half Square Triangles.

From dark prints and background 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ” squares, make Half Square Triangles, following the same method as described above. Trim to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” if necessary. You should have 18 of each color.

At this point you need to choose which 9 blocks you're going to use. 3 of the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” Half Square Triangles will not be used. When you've made this decision, collect the matching cut triangles for the basket bottoms from the fruit prints.

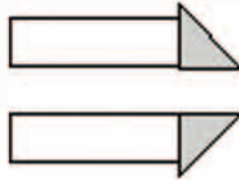

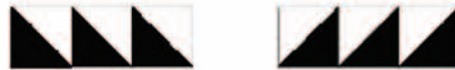

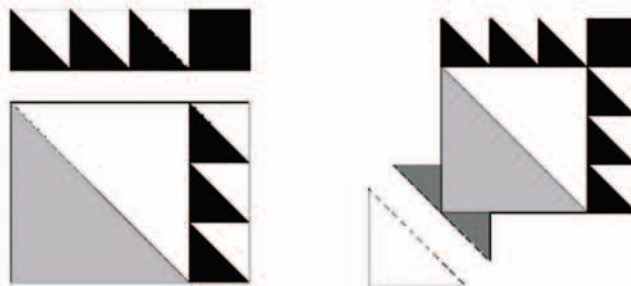
Sew these triangles to the ends of the background $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, one side in each direction.



Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Half Square Triangles together into sets of 3, 3 sets each direction.



Piece blocks together following diagrams.



Arrange blocks on point in 3 rows of 3 with the alternate squares and setting triangles. Sew into diagonal rows, then sew rows together. Trim edges to $\frac{1}{4}$ " if necessary.

Measure your quilt through the middle and cut borders accordingly.

Quilt and bind!
