#### Instructions


- Pre-wash all fabric and spray with Mary Ellen's Best Press Starch.
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Finished Block including seam allowance is 15-1/2" square.

### Step 1

- 1. Cutting the Fabric:
  - a. 31639-7 Yellow Cut (1) strips at 4-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (24) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
  - b. 31642-17 Multi Cut (2) strips at 9-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (12) 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles. c. 31646-17 Multi - Cut (2) strips at 9-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (12) 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
  - d. 31639-2 Navy Cut (3) strips at 5" x WOF and sub-cut into (24) 5" squares.
  - e. 31644-17 Multi Cut (4) strips at 2" x WOF.
  - f. 31636-3 Green Cut (4) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF.
  - g. 31640-10 Black-Multi Cut (2) strips at 4-1/2" x WOF.
  - h. 31641-4 Pink Cut (1) strip at 11-1/2" x WOF and (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF. i. 31636-10 Multi-Black (1) strip at 11-1/2" x WOF and (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF.
- j. 31636-10 Multi-Black Cut (6) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF for the binding.
   k. 31636-8 Orange Cut (1) strip at 11-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (12) 11-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
- 1. 31641-3 Green Cut (1) strip at 11-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (12) 11-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.

### Step 2 – Block – Make 12

- 2. Use the picture of the blocks to guide you though sewing the blocks together.
- 3. Sew (1) of each of "1a" and "1b" together at the 4-1/2" edge to make new rectangle at 4-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangle - Make 12.
- 4. Sew (1) of each of "1a" and "1c" together at the 4-1/2" edge to make new rectangle at 4-1/2" x 11-1/2" -
- 5. Using "1d" 5" squares, fold into rectangles and then into "Prairie Points" as shown in "Example A" Make 24.







The block centers are exactly the same.

The OUTSIDE pieces alternate making SIX of each color way.

6. Layer the "Prairie Points" onto the YELLOW fabric with raw edges together and pin to secure.

7. Sew the CENTER strip as follows from LEFT to RIGHT as follows: (1) "1e, (1) "1f", (1) "1g", (1) "1f", (1) "1e" to make new strip at 11-1/2" x WOF – Make 2.

8. Sub-cut into (12) 11-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

- 9. Sew (1) of #3 rectangles to the TOP of the center rectangle and (1) of #4 rectangles to the BOTTOM of the center rectangle to finish the center of the block Make 12.
- 10. Sew (1) of "1k" rectangles to the TOP and BOTTOM of (6) of the center blocks.

11. Sew (1) of "11" rectangles to BOTH SIDES of the remaining (6) center blocks.

12. Sew (1) of "1i" 2-1/2" strips to each raw edge of the "1h" 9-1/2" strip to make new strip at 15-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into (24) 15-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles – "GREEN" block.

13. Sew (1) of "1h" 2-1/2" strips to each raw edge of the "1i" 9-1/2" strip to make new strip at 15-1/2" x 1 WOF and sub-cut into (24) 15-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles – "ORANGE" block.

14. Sew (1) of #12 15-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the TOP and BOTTOM of the "GREEN" piece to finish the block – Make 6.

15. Sew (1) of #13 15-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the SIDES of the "ORANGE" piece to finish the block – Make 6.

Step 3 – Finishing the Quilt

16. Using the COVER PICTURE as your guide and sew THREE blocks together into rows – REMEMBER to rotate each block within each row – Make (4) rows.

17. Sew the rows together.

18. Layer the BACKING, BATTING and QUILT TOP and quilt as desired.

19. Sew on the BINDING "1j" to finish the quilt.
