Fabric Requirements:

Red stripe print 32714-2 = 2 1/4 yards (Sashing, inner border) Border print 32708-X = 2 yards (Outer border) Beige print 32720-3 = 1 /14 yards (Block piecing)

Toile $32711-1 = 1 \frac{1}{2}$ yards (Setting and corner triangles)

Cheddar 32719-8 = 1/2 yard (Block piecing)
Blue print 32712-1 = 3/8 yard (Block piecing)
Black print 32712-4 = 3/8 yard (Block piecing)

Green print 32716-7 = 3/8 yard (Block piecing)
Gold print 32715-6 = 1/4 yard (Keystones in sas


Gold print 32715-6 = 1/4 yard (Keystones in sashing) Red print 32717-2 = 1/4 yard (Corner basket blocks)

Brown print 32715-3 = 1/8 yard (Centers pieced basket blocks)



Cutting Directions

Red stripe print 32714-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" X 14 1/2 strips for sashing

Cut (2) 4" x 45 3/4" and (2) 4" X 52 3/4" strips for inner border

Cut 2 1/4" bias strips. Piece, as necessary, to make 240" of bias binding.

With the scalloped edge, bias binding is required. Miter at each indentation of binding.

Border print 32708-X

Fussy cut (4) 7 1/4" X 52 3/4" strips, placing a complete triangle at the center of each strip, for outer border.

IMPORTANT: This outer border is scalloped. Cut 1/4" below cheater cloth border. Using a pencil, draw 1/4" seam allowance along scallops printed on fabric and cut on this line.



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Cutting Directions continued

Beige print 32720-3

A - Cut (12) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (24) triangles.

B - Cut (48) 2 1/2" squares.

C - Cut (20) 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles.

E - Cut (12) 3 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (24) triangles.

Cut (4) 8" squares for corner blocks.

Toile 32711-1

Cut (1) 22" square. Cut twice diagonally to make (4) setting triangles.

Cut (2) 11" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (4) corner triangles.

Cheddar 32719-8

A - Cut (3) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (6) triangles.

D - Cut (6) 27/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (12) triangles.

Cut (12) 1" x 5" strips for basket handles.

Blue print 32712-1

A - Cut (3) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (6) triangles; one will be unused.

D - Cut (5) 27/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (10) triangles.

Cut (10) 1" x 5" strips for basket handles.

Black print 32712-4

A - Cut (3) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (6) triangles; one will be unused.

D - Cut (5) 27/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (10) triangles.

Cut (10) 1" x 5" strips for basket handles.

Green print 32716-7

A - Cut (2) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (4) triangles.

D - Cut (4) 2 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (8) triangles.

Cut (8) 1" x 5" strip for basket handles.

Gold print 32715-6

Cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

Red print 32717-2

A - Cut (2) 4 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (4) triangles.

D - Cut (4) 27/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make (8) triangles.

Cut (8) 1" x 5" strips for basket handles.

Brown print 32715-3

Cut (5) 2 1/2" squares.



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Instructions

Each 14" block features 4 baskets. Four of the blocks have baskets of four different fabrics. The center block features two cheddar print baskets, one blue print basket and one black print basket.

1. Sew one A beige print triangle to an A cheddar print triangle.



2. Sew one B beige print square to a D cheddar print triangle. Repeat to make (2) units.




3. Sew one D cheddar print strip to each side of an E beige print triangle. Trim excess portions of the cheddar strips.



4. Assemble units made in steps 1-3 into a 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" basket block.



5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of (6) cheddar print basket blocks, (5) black print basket blocks, (5) blue print basket blocks and (4) green print basket blocks.



6. Assemble (4) basket blocks, (4) beige print C's and (1) 2 1/2" brown print square to make one 14 1/2" block, as shown at left.

Repeat to make (4) blocks.



7. Assemble (4) basket blocks, (4) beige print C's and (1) 2 1/2" brown print square to make (1) 14 1/2"

block, as shown at left, for the center.



8. Referring to picture below, sew center block and two other blocks together with (10) sashing strips, (8) keystones and (2) corner triangles to make the center row of quilt center.



9. Referring to picture below and quilt picture, sew (1) block, (3) sashing strips, (2) keystones, (2) setting triangles, and (1) corner triangle to make a side row.

Repeat to make a second side row.



- 10. Referring to quilt picture, sew block strips together. Trim, leaving 1/4" seam allowance on all sides. Quilt center should measure 45 3/4" X 45 3/4."
- 11. Sew inner border strips of red stripe to quilt center. Quilt should now measure 52 3/4" X 52 3/4."



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
Instructions

12. Following instructions given earlier for basket unit assembly, sew (1) red print A, and (2) red print D's.

Repeat to make (4) baskets.



Referring to picture below, applique each unit made above and basket handles to a 8" beige print square, positioning basket in corner, and leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on all sides.



- 13. Referring to quilt picture, sew outer border strips and the (4) corner blocks in place.
- 14. Using scallop motif at top of cheater border panel, use a pencil to draw corner scallops.
- 15. Quilt and bind, as desired.
