

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Fabric Requirements:

3 Charm Packs

(assortment in charm pack shown above - each pack has 40 pieces)

- 3 3/4 yards 35362-2 Grey Solid
- 1 1/8 yards 37515-1 Green Stripe (includes binding)
- 5 3/8 yards Backing





Cutting:

35362-2 Grey Solid

Cut all strips are cut the length of the fabric (LOF) or parallel to the selvage

Cut (4) 5" x 81" strips for sides, top and bottom outside border

Cut (4) 5" x 68" strips for sides, top and bottom inner borders

Cut (1) 5" x 45 1/2" strip

Cut (1) 5" x 41" strip

Cut (1) 5" x 36 1/2" strip

Cut (1) 5" x 32" strip

Cut (2) 5" x 27 1/2" strips

Cut (2) 5" x 23" strips

Cut (3) 5" x 18 1/2" strips

Cut (4) 5"x 14" strips

Cut (4) 5" x 5" squares

37515-1 Green Stripe

Cut (8) 2 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Join strips to:

Make (2) 5" x 77" strips for the side borders

Make (2) 2 1/2" x 72" for top and bottom borders

Cut (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips joined to make binding

(111) charm squares assorted colors (you have 120 pcs to chose from).

Hint: use the extra charm square pieces to add interest to your backing or make a fun pillow to go with your quilt!

Assembly:


- 1. All seam allowances are 1/4" wide.
- 2. Quilt top is built in sections. Following the layouts on the next few page, build the quilt in small sections to create the right side of the quilt, then the left and finally the borders.
- 3. The grey sections in the diagrams represent the grey solid fabric. The pink blocks are the assorted colors that can be placed randomly from your charm squares.
- 4. Measurements given diagrams are the cut sizes.





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RIGHT SIDE SECTION OF QUILT




Build each section of the right side putting together the smaller quadrants together as to pieces are laid out in the diagram. Take your time to be sure you don't trap yourself in the maze!

Build each section of the left side putting together the smaller quadrants together as to pieces are laid out in the diagram.

Border Assembly:

Following the diagram layout on the next page, join the left and right sides of the top together. Add the top and bottom 13 block multi color strips. (refer to color picture of quilt if necessary) Add the grey solid inner borders starting with the sides, then top and bottom.

Add the green border strips to the sides, then top and bottom

Finally add the outer grey borders - sides, then top and bottom.

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind and start using your quilt! ENJOY!
