	1 ½ yards	37005-1 Indigo	Background Corner Square  Background Triangles	Cut 2 – 14 ½" strip. Then cut 4 - 14 ½" squares. Cut 1 – 21 ½" strip. Then cut 1 – 21 ½" squares. Cut diagonal twice. 
	3/8 yard	37006-2 Tan	Star Fabric 1	Cut 4 – 2 ½" strips
	1/8 yard	37007-1 Indigo	Star Fabric 2	Cut 1 – 2 ½" strips
	¼ yard	37008-1 Indigo	Star Fabric 3	Cut 3 – 2 ½" strips
	¼ yard	37008-3 Cream	Star Fabric 4	Cut 2 – 2 ½" strips
	¼ yard	37010-3 Cream	Star Fabric 5	Cut 3 – 2 ½" strips

- 66" x 66" Backing Fabric
- 66" x 66" Quilt Batting

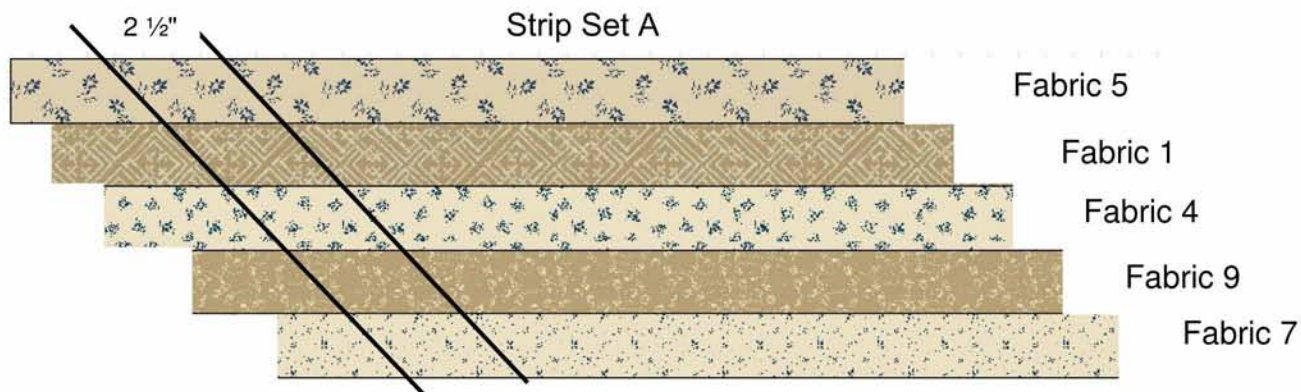


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## Making the Quilt

You will need to make one of each of the five different strip sets shown below. Stagger the strips by 2 inches. Press all seams open. Then cut each set into 8 - 2 ½" strips using the 45° line on your ruler.

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Sew a strip from each Strip Set together to form 8 large diamond shapes



Sew the 8 diamond shapes together to form the star making sure the cream fabric is the outside tip and the blue is in the center of the star.

Leave ¼" open at both ends of each seam to make it easier to add to background squares and triangles and keep the center flat.



To add background triangles and squares stop stitching a 1/4" before the end of the fabric on the inside corners of the background triangles and squares. Press seams toward background.

Sew together border strips end to end. Add border in order indicated on picture. Press and trim. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. The last step is to bind and add label.
