

## Borders

Refer to Figure 5 for border placement.
7. Sew one each $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $L$ strips to sides of quilt top.
8. Beginning and ending with a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric N strip, alternate sewing with two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $M$ strips. Repeat for a total of four border strips. Sew two of these strips to sides of quilt top.
9. Sew one each $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $L$ strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
10. Sew one each $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric L strips to one 3-1/2" Fabric M square. Repeat for a total of four corner units.
11. Sew corner units to the remaining two pieced border strips and attach to top and bottom of quilt top.

| Fabric A | \#28183-1 Red | 1/4 yard | (13) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric B | \#28177-1 Red | $1 / 2$ yard | (26) $3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half on diagonal once to make 52 half-square triangles |
| Fabric C | \#28182-2 Black | 1/3 yard | (13) $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half on diagonal twice to make 52 quarter-square triangles |
| Fabric D | \#28186-1 Red | 1/2 yard | (26) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares <br> (13) $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half on diagonal twice to make 52 quarter-square triangles |
| Fabric E | \#28186-3 Slate | 1/3 yard | (26) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric F | \#28177-3 Slate | 1/8 yard | (12) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric G | \#28178-5 Cream | $1 / 3$ yard | (48) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric H | \#28185-1 Red | $1 / 3$ yard | (48) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric I | \#28178-2 Black | 1/4 yard | (48) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric J | \#28184-3 Slate | $1 / 2$ yard | (24) 2 " x 6-1/2" strips |
| Fabric K | \#28180-3 Slate | $1 / 2$ yard | (24) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Fabric L | \#28180-1 Red | $1 / 3$ yard | (4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips <br> (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips <br> (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Fabric M | \#28182-1 Red | $3 / 8$ yard | (4) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares <br> (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Fabric N | \#28179-2 Black | 1/3 yard | (12) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |

## Backing and Binding

## Yardage and Cutting Instructions:

Fabric O \#28177-5 Cream 3-1/2 yards
Cut and piece to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap for backing
Fabric P \#28182-4 Navy 1/2 yard
(6) $2-1 / 4$ " strips width of fabric, pieced together for binding

## Star of Hope Block

1. To make star points sew Fabric C and Fabric D small triangles together. Sew this unit to one Fabric B large triangle to make a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square

Figure 1 (Fig. 1). Make 52 star point squares.
2.Sew one Fabric D square to left side of one star point square, and sew one Fabric E square to the right side to make top and bottom strips of the star block. Sew one star point square to each side of one Fabric A square for center strip. Watching orientation, assemble the block as shown in Fig. 2.

## Bordered 9-Patch Block

3. Sew one each 2-1/2" Fabric H squares to sides of one 2-1/2" Fabric G square for top row. Repeat for bottom row.
4. Sew one each $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G squares to sides of one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square to make center row. Sew rows together. Make 12 6-1/2" 9-patch squares.
5. Sew one each 2" Fabric I squares to left and right sides of one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip. Repeat. Sew two each 2" x 61/2" Fabric K strips to sides of


Figure 4 one $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} 9$-patch square, then attach the previously pieced top and bottom strips. Make 12 blocks.

## Row Assembly

6. Watching orientation, begin with a Star of Hope block and alternate with Bordered 9-Patch blocks. There will be five rows of five blocks each.
