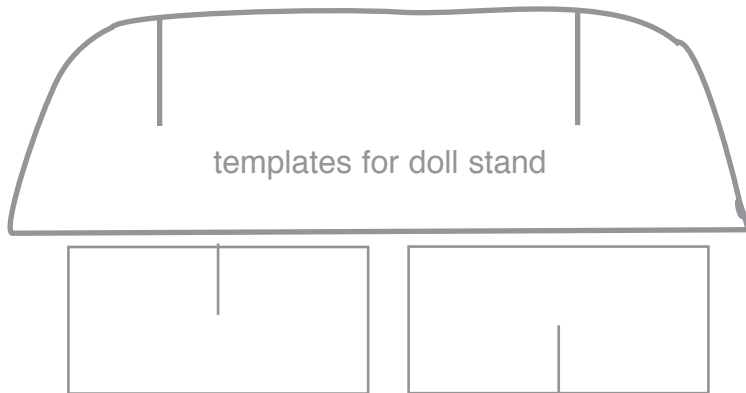


## Paper Dolls Quilt by Barbara Campbell

units to create the inner sashing units between the center square and clothes pockets and border blocks to assemble the quilt top.

6. Sew two of the 2" Red Dots border strips to the sides of the quilt. Trim excess and press. Sew the final two borders to the top and bottom, trim and press.
7. Layer with batting and backing and quilt as desired, being careful not to quilt over the pocket areas. They must be left free to hold the dolls and clothes. Bind with the 2 1/4" Red Check strips, using your favorite method.
8. Fuse the paper-backed fusible web to the wrong side of the doll. Cut out loosely around the shapes. Fuse these pieces to cardstock for added stability and cut carefully on the lines. Use the pattern provided to create the base shape around the bottom of the dolls before cutting. Cut the insertion lines on the base to insert the base squares to enable the dolls to stand.
9. Fuse the doll clothes to the fusible fleece and cut carefully on the lines, cutting off the tabs. The fleece will allow the clothes to stick to the dolls.
10. Store the dolls in the center square pockets and the clothes and accessories in the other four pockets around the edges.

# Paper Dolls Quilt

Finished Size: 39" x 39"

Star and Center Block Size: 12"

Border Blocks: 4"

Skill Level: Beginner

## Materials & Cutting List:

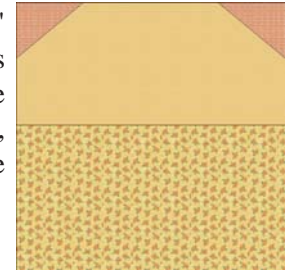
- 3/4 yard Doll Print #28116 (see fusing instructions)
- 3/4 yard Doll Clothes #28118 (see fusing instructions)
- 3/8 yard Yellow Dots #28122-4 (cut one 12-1/2" center square)
- 3/8 yard Yellow Flowers #28120-4 (cut one 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle and four 4-1/2" squares)
- 1/2 yard Green Leaves #28125-3 (cut twenty 4-1/2" squares)
- 1/2 yard Red Dots #28122-1 (cut four 2" x wof strips for borders, four 5-1/4" squares; recut diagonally twice and four 4-1/2" squares)
- 1/4 yard Green Checks #28124-3 (cut four 5-1/4" squares; recut diagonally twice and cut four 4-1/2" squares)
- 1/4 yard Green Dots #28122-3 (cut four 5-1/4" squares; recut diagonally twice and cut four 4 1/2" squares)
- 1/4 yard Yellow Stripe #28121-4 (cut four 5-1/4" squares; recut diagonally twice and cut eight 4-1/2" squares)
- 1/2 yard Red Check #28124-4 (cut four 2-1/4" x wof strips for binding and two 4-1/2" squares for center square corners)
- 1-1/4 yard Animal print #28119 (cut into a 40" square for backing)
- 1 yard fusible fleece \*
- 42" square batting
- 2 yards paper-backed fusible web to fuse dolls
- 10 - 12 sheets of heavy cardstock, also depending on the number of dolls to fuse

*\* If desired, white felt could be substituted for the fusible fleece. In that case increase the yardage of the fusible web to accommodate the clothes to be fused.*

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Fold the Yellow Flower rectangle in half lengthwise and press. Do not unfold, Fold it again to find the center. Press and open. Match the 12-1/2" raw edge with the bottom of the 12-1/2" center square. Baste just inside the seam line on the sides and bottom. Stitch down the folded center line to create two pockets to store the dolls.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4-1/2" Red Check squares. Position them, right sides together on the upper corners of the center square and sew on the drawn line. Trim excess red fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Do not trim the Yellow Dot square as it will stabilize the block.



2. Sew the Red Dot and Green Dot triangles together in pairs as shown. Repeat to make a total of sixteen pairs. Sew the Green Check and Yellow Stripe triangles in the same fashion. Join the pairs to create the Four X units shown below. Make sixteen units.



3. Sew these units together with five 4-1/2" Green Leaves squares to make four 12-1/2" star blocks.



4. Create four doll clothes pocket blocks by repeating the process used in making the center square pocket, using the 4-1/2" Yellow Dot squares for the background and folding the 4-1/2" Yellow Flower squares only once. Do not fold and stitch down the center to divide into two pockets for these smaller blocks. Sew two 4-1/2" orange dot squares to the top and bottom of these blocks to create sashing between star blocks.



5. Referring to the quilt layout diagram, sew the remaining 4-1/2" squares into units to create the inner sashing units between the center square and clothes pockets and border blocks to assemble the quilt top.
6. Sew two of the 2" Red Dots border strips to the sides of the quilt. Trim excess and press. Sew the final two borders to the top and bottom, trim and press.
