## Fabric Requirements:

1 Yard 33740-X Multi  
1/2 Yard 33743-5 Rust  
1-1/8 Yards 33743-3 Brown  
1 Yard 33744-6 White  
3/8 Yard 33743-2 Green  
3/4 Yard 33741-2 Green  
5/8 Yard 33742-3 Brown  
3/8 Yard 33743-1 Tan  
5/8 Yard 33742-4 Cream

## Binding, Backing and Batting

5/8 Yards 33743-3 Brown – Binding  
4-5/8 Yards 33742-4 Cream – Backing  
72” x 82” Warm Bond Batting

## Special Notions

Mary Ellen’s Best Press Spray Starch

## Instructions

- Prewash and starch with Mary Ellen’s Best Press to reduce stretch in fabric when sewing.
- Use a 1/4” seam allowance when sewing the quilt.
- Finished Block for Borders is 5” square.
- Label the fabric when cut for less confusion.
- Borders are numbered beginning from the CENTER out.
- Width of Fabric from Selvage to Selvage = “WOF”
- Half Square Triangle = “HST”
- Quarter Square Triangle = “QST”



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## Step 1 – Preparing the Fabric

1. 33740-X Multi – Cut (1) strip at 33-1/2” x WOF – Sub-cut into (1) 33-1/2” x 23-1/2” rectangle for the center of the quilt.
2. 33743-5 Rust – Cut as follows:
  - a. Border 1: Cut (4) strips at 1-1/2” x WOF
  - b. Border 4: Cut (5) strips at 2” x WOF
3. 33743-3 Brown – Cut as follows:
  - a. Border 3: Cut (5) strips at 1-1/2” x WOF
  - b. Border 6: Cut (6) strips at 1-1/2” x WOF
  - c. Binding: Cut (8) strips at 2-1/2” x WOF.
4. 33744-6 White – Cut (7) strips at 4-3/4” x WOF for BORDER 7.
5. Border 5 – Cut as follows:
  - a. 33741-2 Green – Cut (4) strips at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (20) 6-1/4” squares – cross-cut (2) ONCE to yield (4) large triangles – cross-cut (18) TWICE to yield (72) small triangles.
  - b. 33743-2 Green – Cut (2) strips at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (11) 6-1/4” squares – cross-cut (2) ONCE to yield (4) large triangles and cross-cut (9) TWICE to yield (36) small triangles.
  - c. 33742-3 Brown – Cut as follows:
    - i. Cut (2) strips at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (9) 6-1/4” squares – cross-cut TWICE to yield (36) triangles for Border 5.
    - ii. Cut (1) strip at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (6) 6-1/4” squares and cross-cut TWICE to yield (24) triangles for Border 2.
6. Border 2 – Cut as follows:
  - a. 33743-1 Tan – Cut (2) strip at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (8) 6-1/4” squares – cross-cut (2) ONCE to yield (4) large triangles for the corners and cross-cut (6) TWICE to yield (24) small triangles.
  - b. 33742-4 Cream – Cut (3) strip at 6-1/4” x WOF – Sub-cut into (14) 6-1/4” squares – cross-cut (2) ONCE to yield (4) large triangles for the corners and cross-cut (12) TWICE to yield (48) small triangles.
  - c. 33742-3 Brown – Cut during Instruction No. 5.

## Step 2 – Border 2 “QST”

7. Layout the triangles in the position as shown in “Border 2 QST” and sew together to make (24) “QST”.
8. Sew (1) 33742-3 Brown to (1) 33742-4 Cream (small triangle) together at the short edge – Sew (1) 33742-4 Cream (small triangle) to (1) 33743-1 Tan (small triangle) together at the short edge – Sew the two pieces just sewn together to finish (1) “QST” – Square to 5-1/2” if necessary.
9. Repeat (23) more times to finish a total of (24) “QST”.
10. Sew (5) together with the DARK fabric always towards the OUTSIDE for the top/bottom – Make (2).
11. Sew (7) together with the DARK fabric always towards the OUTSIDE for the sides – Make (2).
12. Label the sides and top/bottom and set aside for use later.

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## Step 3 – Border 2 “HST”

13. Sew (1) 33742-4 Cream (large triangle) to (1) 33743-1 Tan (large triangle) at the long edge to make a “HST” – Make (4) and square off to 5-1/2” square as shown in “Border 2 – HST”.
14. Sew (1) “HST” to each 5-1/2” edge of the “QST Top/Bottom” with the 33743-1 Tan towards the OUTSIDE as shown in the COVER PICTURE – Make (2).

## Step 4 – Border 5 – “QST”

15. Layout the triangles in the position as shown in “Border 5 QST” and sew together to make (36) “QST”.
16. Sew (1) 33742-3 Brown to (1) 33741-2 Green (small triangle) together at the short edge – Sew (1) 33741-2 Green (small triangle) to (1) 33743-2 Green (small triangle) together at the short edge – Sew the two pieces just sewn together to finish (1) “QST” – Square to 5-1/2” if necessary.
17. Repeat (35) more times to finish a total of (36) “QST”.
18. Sew (8) together with the DARK fabric always towards the OUTSIDE for the top/bottom – Make (2).
19. Sew (10) together with the DARK fabric always towards the OUTSIDE for the sides – Make (2).
20. Label the sides and top/bottom and set aside for use later.

## Step 5 – Border 5 – “HST”

21. Sew (1) 33741-2 Green (large triangle) to (1) 33743-2 Green (large triangle) at the long edge to make a “HST” – Make (4) and square off to 5-1/2” square as shown in “Border 5 – HST”.
22. Sew (1) “HST” to each 5-1/2” edge of the “QST Top/Bottom” with the 33743-2 Green towards the OUTSIDE as shown in the COVER PICTURE – Make (2).

## Step 6 – Sewing the Quilt Together

23. Always refer to the Cover Picture as your example.
24. The CENTER of the quilt is the 33740-X Multi 23-1/2” x 33-1/2” rectangle.
25. When sewing the borders on it is best to sewn on the SIDES and then the TOP and BOTTOM.
26. Border 1 -Sew the 33743-5 Rust 1-1/2” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom of the CENTER – trim off excess to square the edges.
27. Border 2 – Sew the “QST” to the sides with the DARK fabric towards the inside. Sew the “QST” to the top/bottom with the DARK fabric towards the inside with the “HST” at each corner



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28. Border 3 – Sew the 33743-3 Brown 1-1/2” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom – trim off excess to square the edges.
29. Border 4 – Sew the 33743-5 Rust 2” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom – trim off excess to square the edges.
30. Border 5 – Sew the “QST” to the sides with the DARK fabric towards the inside. Sew the “QST” to the top/bottom with the DARK fabric towards the inside with the “HST” at each corner.
31. Border 6 – Sew the 33753-3 Brown 1-1/2” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom – trim off excess to square the edges.
32. Border 7 – Sew the 33744-6 White 4-3/4” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom – trim off excess to square the edges.
33. Border 8 – Sew the 33743-3 Brown 2-1/2” strips to the sides and then the top/bottom – trim off excess to square the edges to finish the quilt top.

## Step 7 – Finishing the Quilt

34. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
35. Using the 33743-3 Brown 2-1/2” strips sew on the binding to finish the quilt.
