## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

31678-7	1 1/2 yards	black print	piecing, all blocks and border 2
31688-X	1/2 yard	toile	centers, all blocks
31668-1	1/2 yard	beige and red print	piecing Block 1
31670-2	fat 1/4 yard	blue clamshells	piecing Block 1
31669-7	1/2 yard	black and beige stripe	piecing Block 2
31680-6	fat 1/4 yard	olive green print	piecing Block 2
31677-1	1/2 yard	red on beige print	piecing Block 3
31672-4	fat 1/4 yard	brown stripe	piecing Block 3
31684-4	1/2 yard	camel print	piecing Block 4
31682-5	fat 1/4 yard	purple stripe	piecing Block 4
31683-1	1 3/4 yards	red print	sashing
31673-4	1/4 yard	tan and brown print	keystones in sashing
31674-3	3/4 yard	cream print	borders 1 and 3
31667-2	2 1/4 yards	blue print	border 4 and binding

Also needed: 5 yards for Backing

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

31678-7 black print

Cut (32) 4 7/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally once to make (64) triangle (B) for block piecing.

Cut (2) 2 1/2 x 62 1/2" strips for border 2.

Cut (2) 2 1/2 x 66 1/2" strips for border 2.

31688-X toile

Fussy cut (4) 8 1/2" square (E) for centers of the pieced blocks.

Referring to Fabric Requirements above, lay out fabrics for pieced blocks. There are four lighter fabrics and four darker fabrics. Lighter fabrics are 31668-1, 31669-7, 31677-1 and 31684-4. Darker fabrics are 31670-2, 31680-6, 31672-4 and 31682-5.

From each of the four lighter fabrics, cut:

(4) 4 1/2" squares (A).

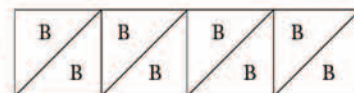
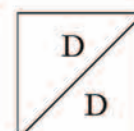
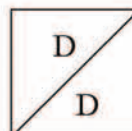
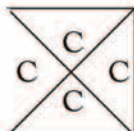
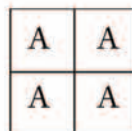
(4) 4 7/8" squares.

Cut each square once diagonally to make (8) triangle (B).

Cut (1) 9 1/4" square. Cut each square twice diagonally to make 4 triangles (C).

Cut (2) 8 7/8" square.

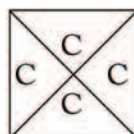
Cut each square once diagonally to make (4) triangles (D).



From each of the four darker fabrics, cut:

(1) 9 1/4" square.

Cut each square twice diagonally to make (4) triangles (C).



31683-1 red print

Cut (12) 4 1/2" X 24 1/2" strips for sashing.

31673-4 tan and brown print

Cut (9) 4 1/2" squares for keystones in sashing.



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31674-3 cream print

Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips for border 1, cut crosswise and pieced.

Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips for border 1.

Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips for border 3.

Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips for border 3.

31667-2 blue print

Cut (2) 4 1/4" x 68 1/2" strips for border 4.

Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips for border 4.

Cut 2 1/4" strips for binding. Piece, as necessary, to make 320".

## INSTRUCTIONS:

### Blocks

1. For center of each block, refer to quilt picture and Diagram 1.

Sew (4) matching darker fabric (C) to the sides of (1) (E).

Press and trim.

Unit should now measure 11 7/8" x 11 7/8".

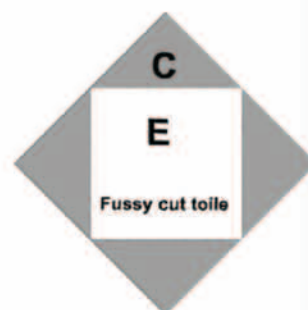

2. Referring to quilt picture and Diagram 2, sew (4) matching lighter fabric (D) to the sides of the unit made in Step 1.

Press and trim.

Block center should now measure 16 1/2" x 16 1/2".

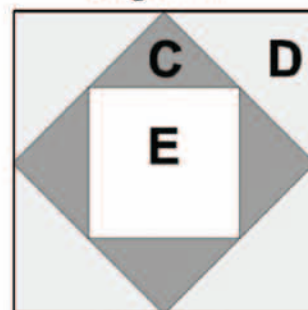

3. Sew (2) black print (B) triangles to opposite sides of a lighter fabric (C).

Press and trim.

Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 8 1/2".

Repeat to make (4) units alike for each block.

4. Sew (1) black print (B) triangle to (1) light fabric (B) triangle to form a half-square triangle unit.

Press and trim.

Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Repeat to make (8) units alike for each block.

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5. Referring to quilt picture and Diagram 5, assemble units made in Steps 1-5 and (A's) to make (1) block.

Press and trim.

Block should measure  $24 \frac{1}{2}" \times 24 \frac{1}{2}"$ .

Repeat to make (4) blocks.

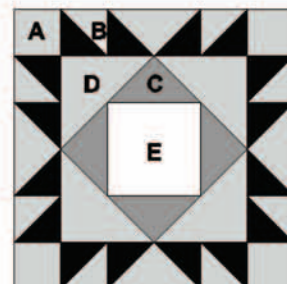

6. Referring to Diagram 6, sew a sashing strip between two blocks.

Sew a sashing strip on each outside edge of the blocks.

Repeat to make a second row of blocks and sashing strips.

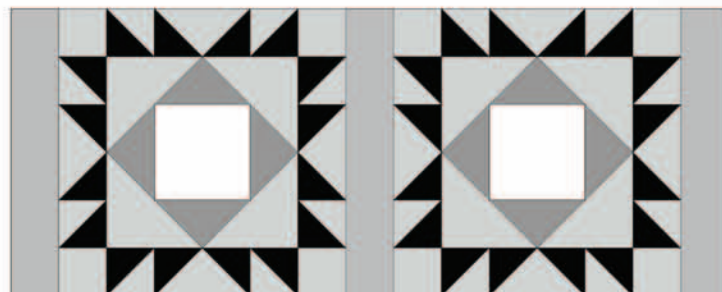

7. Referring to Diagram 6, sew a sashing row with (3) keystones and (2) sashing strips.

Repeat to make a total of 3 sashing rows.

8. Arrange blocks and sashing rows to make quilt center.

Quilt center should now measure  $60 \frac{1}{2}" \times 60 \frac{1}{2}"$ .

9. Sew first border to quilt center.  
Quilt should now measure  $62 \frac{1}{2}" \times 62 \frac{1}{2}"$

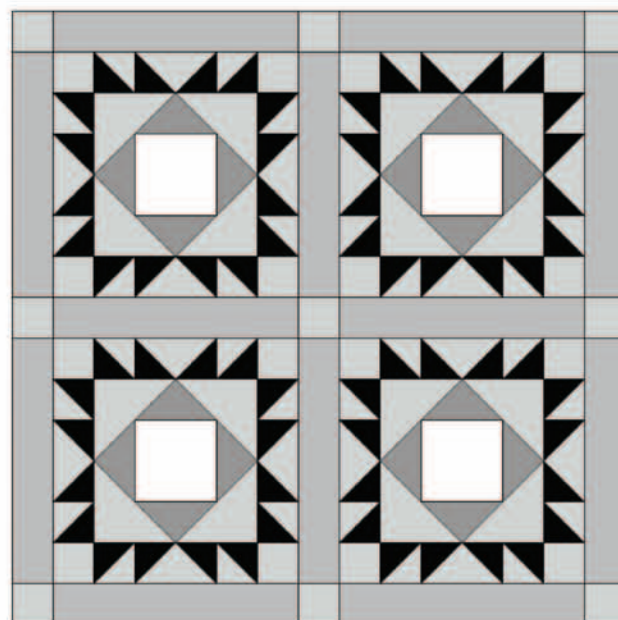
10. Sew second border to quilt center.  
Quilt should now measure  $66 \frac{1}{2}" \times 66 \frac{1}{2}"$

11. Sew third border to quilt center.  
Quilt should now measure  $68 \frac{1}{2}" \times 68 \frac{1}{2}"$

12. Sew fourth border to quilt center.  
Quilt should now measure  $76 \frac{1}{2}" \times 76 \frac{1}{2}"$

13. Quilt and bind, as desired.
