

Cutting Directions

34212-3 Red Garden Fun

- Cut (2) 4 1/2" X 47 3/4" strips for sides of fourth border.
- Cut (2) 4 ½" X 55 ¾" strips for top and bottom of fourth border.
- Cut (2) 4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (3) E triangles for basket base. There is one unused triangle.
- Cut (1) 2 1/2" square. Cut once diagonally to make (2) B triangles for basket base.
- Cut (1) 4 1/4" square. Cut twice diagonally to make (2) **C** triangles for basket flowers. There are two unused triangles.
- Cut (1) 2 1/2" square. Cut once diagonally to make (2) B triangles for basket flowers.
- Cut (1) 2" A square for basket flowers.
- Cut 2 1/2" strips and piece together as necessary to make 240" of binding.

34211-1 Green Little Bo Peep

- Cut (2) 2" X 44 3/4" strips for sides of third border.
- Cut (2) 2" X 47 3/4" strips for top and bottom of third border.
- Cut (4) 3 1/4" squares. Cut in half once diagonally to make (8) F triangles for center block.

34218-2 Yellow Baby Chicks

- Cut (2) 2" X 41 3/4" strips for sides of second border.
- Cut (2) 2" X 44 3/4" strips for top and bottom of second border.
- Cut (4) 3 1/4" squares. Cut in half once diagonally to make (8) **F** triangles for center block.
- Cut (12) 2" squares for sashing squares.

34222-4 Blue Ring Around The Rosy

- Cut (2) 2" X 38 3/4" strips for sides of first border.
- Cut (2) 2" X 41 3/4" strips for top and bottom of first border.
- Cut (8) 2" X 8" strips for sashing..
- Cut (4) 2" X 10" strips for blue sashing at top and bottom center and side centers.

34219-1 Purple in the Clover

- Cut (2) 4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (3) E triangles for basket base. There is one unused triangle.
- Cut (1) 2 1/2" square. Cut once diagonally to make (2) B triangles for basket base.
- Cut (1) 4 1/4" square. Cut twice diagonally to make (2) **C** triangles for basket flowers. There are two unused triangles.
- Cut (1) 2 1/2" square. Cut once diagonally to make (2) B triangles for basket flowers.

- Cut (10) 2" X 8" strips for sashing..
- Cut (8) 2" X 10" strips for blue sashing at corners.

- Cut (4) 4 1/4" square. Cut twice diagonally to make (16) C triangles for basket block background.

2. Sew first borders in place. Quilt should measure 41 5/8" X 41 5/8"

3. Sew second borders in place. Quilt should measure 44 5/8" X 44 5/8"

4. Sew third borders in place. Quilt should measure 47 5/8" X 47 ½"

5.
Sew fourth borders in place.
Quilt should measure 55 5/8" X 55 5/8"
Quilt and bind, as desired.
