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Prairie Winds

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Finished quilt size: 23-1/2" x 32"

Finished block size: 6"

Fabric Requirements:

1/4 yard of the 6 dark rose, 6 blue, and 6 cream prints

1/2 yard of brown print #23818-3

1/4 yard of brown print #23821-3

1/4 yard of brown print #23823-3

1/2 yard of blue print #23821-4 (border)

1 yard of brown print #23822-3 (backing)

1/4 yard of blue print #23822-4 (binding)

Cutting Instructions:

The 6 pieced blocks consist of 5 four-patch blocks and 4 solid' blocks.

Four-Patch Blocks:

From assorted dark rose and blue prints, cut 1-1/2" squares. Assemble squares into four patches, alternating the two colors (refer to photo). You will need 5 four-patches per block, a total of 30.

Solid blocks:

From assorted cream fabrics, cut 2-1/2" squares. You will need 4 per block, a total of 24.

2 large alternate squares: cut (2) 6-1/2" squares of brown print #23818-3.

6 side setting triangles : cut (2) 10" squares, cut twice on the diagonal, from brown print #23818-3. You will only use 6 of the triangles.

4 corner triangles:

cut (1) 5 -1/4" square of brown print #23821-3, cut in half

cut (1) 5 -1/4" square of brown print #23823-3, cut in half



Border:

From blue print #23821-4, cut (2) strips 3-1/2" x 17 -1/2", and (2) strips 3-1/2" x 32-1/2" .

Quilt Assembly:

Make four-patches using two blue and two dark rose squares. Sew the four patches together with the alternating solid cream squares, completing the pieced blocks.

Lay out the blocks and setting pieces, according to the quilt photograph. Sew together in diagonal rows, adding the corner pieces. Add the shorter strips of the border, then the longer strips. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired and bind the edges.
