## Cutting Instructions

(8) $2-5 / 8$ " squares, fussy cut
(1) $3-1 / 2$ " square
(4) $2-1 / 2^{"} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
(4) 2 " $\times 3-1 / 2$ " strips
(2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
(2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
(4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(10) $3-7 / 8$ " squares, cut in half on diagonal once to make 20 half-square triangles
(6) 3-7/8" squares, cut in half on diagonal to make 12 half-square triangles
(8) $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 6-1 / 2$ " strips
(8) $4-1 / 2$ " squares, cut in half on diagonal twice to make 32 quarter-square triangles
(2) $3-1 / 2$ " x $26-1 / 2$ " strips
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
(12) $1-1 / 2$ " $\times 6-1 / 2$ " strips
(4) 2 " squares
(4) $2-1 / 2$ " squares
(8) $1-1 / 2$ " $\times 2-1 / 2$ " strips
(16) $2-3 / 8 "$ squares, cut in half on diagonal once to make 32 half-square triangles
*Extra yardage needed for binding and backing

## Quilt Assembly

Follow diagram for fabric placement.
Step 1: Center Block - Sew two 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric C strips to left and right sides of 3-1/2" Fabric B square. Sew two 2" Fabric J squares to left and right sides of two remaining Fabric C strips. Sew these strips to top and bottom of square.
Step 2: Corner Blocks - Sew one each Fabric K half-square triangles to each side of one $2-5 / 8$ " Fabric A square. Sew one each Fabric G quarter-square triangle to each side of completed square. Sew one each Fabric D half-square triangles to three sides of completed square. Sew one Fabric E half-square triangle to remaining side of square. Make four blocks.
Step 3: Top, Bottom and Side Blocks - Repeat Step 2 above, this time sewing two each Fabric D and Fabric E half-square triangles to fabrics A, K and G center square. Make four blocks (top, bottom and two sides).
Step 4: Sashings - Following diagram, arrange blocks into position. Note that all Fabric E corner triangles face towards center of quilt. Sew 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric I sashing strips to left and right sides of the top square, center square, and bottom square. Attach corner and side squares to complete three rows. Alternate sewing three $1-1 / 2$ " x $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strips to two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D squares, making two sashing rows. Sew blocks rows and sashing rows together.
Step 5: Border \#1 - Following diagram, arrange $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F and 2-1/2" x 6 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips with $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strips and 2-1/2" Fabric J corner squares. Sew side borders first, then attach top and bottom borders.
Step 6: Border \#2 - Sew $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strips to left and right sides of quilt. Sew $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top and bottom of quilt.
Step 7: Border \#2 - Sew 3-1/2" x 26-1/2" Fabric H strips to left and right sides of quilt. Sew 3-1/2" $\times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top and bottom of quilt.

## Finishing the Quilt

Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
