Fabric Requirements

1/2 yard each

37022-1 Blue / 37023-3 Orange / 37023-4 Coral / 37023-5 Green / 37024-2 Lilac
37024-5 Green / 37024-6 Pink / 37025-2 Lilac / 37025-6 Pink / 37025-7 Yellow
37026-2 Lilac / 37026-7 Yellow / 37027-1 Blue / 37027-2 Lilac / 37027-3 Orange
37026-6 Pink / 37027-6 Pink

1/2 yard 37022-2 Lilac for binding

3 3/4 yards for Backing

Cutting

From the 1/2 yard pieces shown above (leaving aside 37022-2 for binding), cut (2) 6 1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Recut the strips into (8) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" blocks each. [Note: You will have excess from the second strip.]

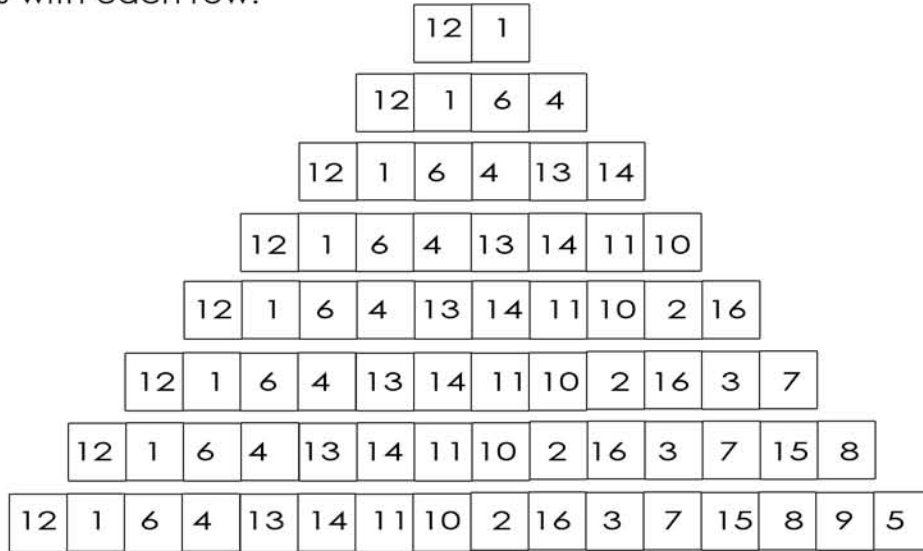

Assembly:

All seam allowances are 1/4"

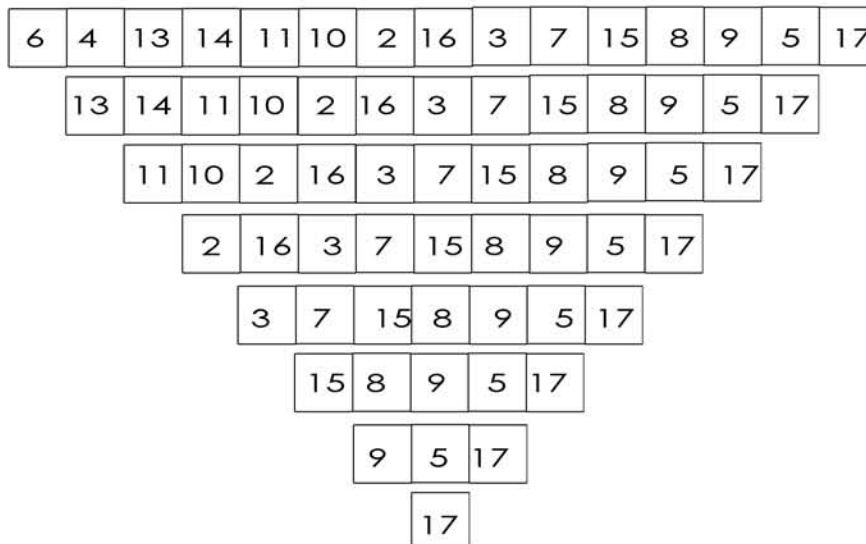
1. Arrange the blocks in rows that 'rainbow' from left to right. Start with the middle row illustrated below. This is the longest row and will have 16 blocks.
2. Progressing up the diagram, assemble the blocks into strips, dropping two blocks from right of the strips with each row.



3. The longest row of 16 blocks will have the spectrum of colors as shown below.



4. For the other half of the quilt, you will create rows with an odd amount of blocks starting with the longest comprised of 15 blocks. Here you will remove two blocks from the left of the strips each time and add in color 17 shown on the right.

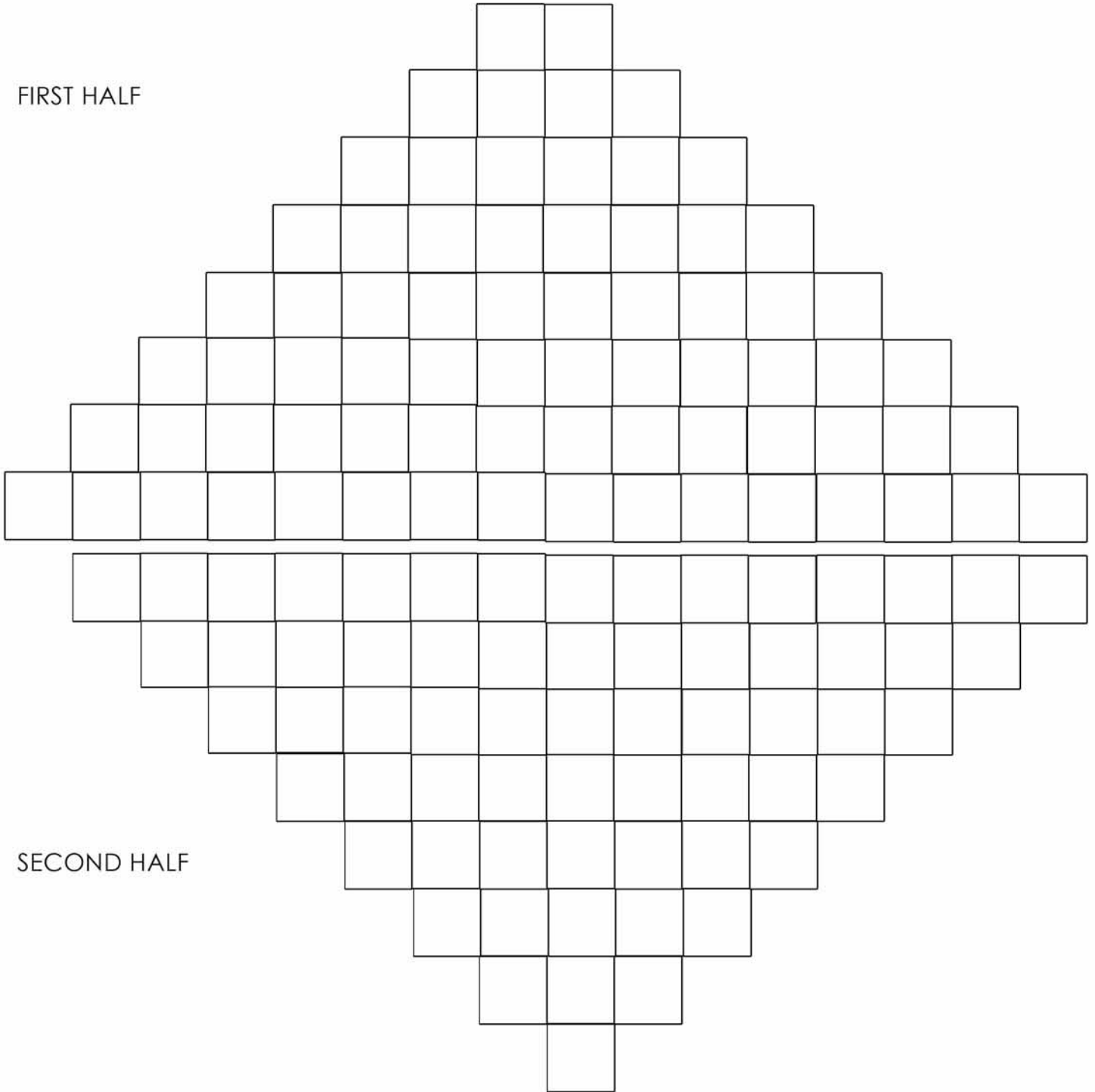

4. Join the first half of the quilt to the second half as shown.

FIRST HALF

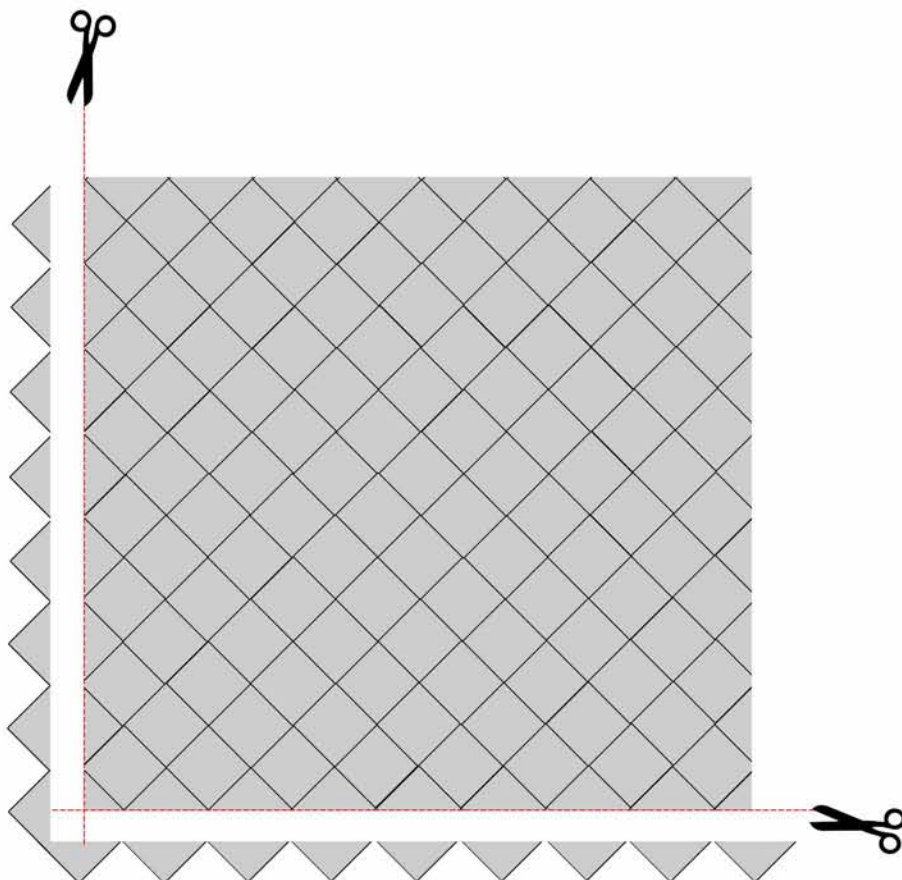


SECOND HALF

5. Rotate the quilt to a square instead of the diamond. True up the sides as shown.



6. Quilt and bind using your favorite method.
