

Fabric Requirements

32407-3 2 3/4 yards 32405-1 1 1/4 yards 32408-1 3/4 yard 32403X 1 yard 32409X 1 yard 32404X 1 1/2 yard red plaid large beige print tan stripe large deer print pebble print

First border, third border Second border Piecing in Star blocks, Snowball blocks Piecing in Star blocks

Piecing in Star blocks, Snowball blocks black deer head print Piecing in Snowball blocks

Cutting Directions

32407-3 red plaid

Cut (2) 2 1/2" X 40 1/2" for top and bottom of first border Cut (2) 2 1/2" X 60 1/2" for sides of first border

Cut (2) 5 1/2" X 56 1/2" for top and bottom of third border Cut (2) 5 1/2" X 70 1/2" for sides of third border

Cut 2 1/4" strips. Piece, as necessary, to make 285" of binding.

32405-1 large beige print

Cut (2) 3 1/2" X 46 1/2" for top and bottom of second border Cut (2) 3 1/2" X 64 1/2" for sides of second border

32408-1 tan stripe


Cut (16) 3 1/2" squares for corners of Star blocks Cut (8) 7 1/4" squares.

Cut each square twice diagonally to make (32) triangles for Star blocks

Cut (6) 3 7/8" squares.

Cut each square once diagonally to make (12) triangles for corners of Snowball blocks.

Cutting Directions Continued

32403X large deer print

Fussy cut (8) 6 1/2" squares for centers of Star blocks

32409X pebble print

Cut (16) 3 1/2" squares for corners of Star blocks

Cut (32) 3 7/8" squares.

Cut each square once diagonally to make (64) triangles for Star blocks

Cut (8) 3 7/8" squares.

Cut each square once diagonally to make (16) triangles for corners of Snowball blocks.

32404X black deer head print

Cut (7) 12 1/2" squares for Snowball blocks

Instructions

Star Blocks



IMPORTANT: The pebble fabric corner square will vary in each block. Two of the blocks will have two pebble corner squares Refer to quilt picture.

Referring to Diagram 1 for fabric placement, make (6) Star blocks. Each block should measure 12 1/2" X 12 1/2"



Referring to Diagram 2 for fabric placement, make (2) Star blocks. Each block should measure 12 1/2" X 12 1/2"

Diagram 2

Snowball Blocks

IMPORTANT: Corner edges of triangles need to extend beyond the black deer head print square. Seam should be 3 1/4" from corner of black dear head print. Use 1/4" seam allowance.

Referring to pictures below, make (7) blocks. Place (1) triangle in each corner of a 12 1/2" black deer head print square. Sew diagonally across the corners with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Each block should measure 12 1/2" X 12 1/2".

Instructions Continued



Make (1) Snowball block with pebble triangles at the top and tan stripe triangles at the bottom.

This block is fifth row, center block.



Make (1) Snowball block with pebble triangles at the bottom and tan stripe triangles at the top.

This block is first row, center block.



Make (1) Snowball block with pebble triangles in the corners. This block is third row, center block.



Make (2) Snowball blocks with pebble triangles on the left side and tan stripe triangles on the right side.

These blocks are second row, right block and fourth row, right block.



Make (2) Snowball blocks with pebble triangles on the right and tan stripe triangles on the left.

These blocks are second row, left block and fourth row, left block.



Page 4

Assembly

Referring to quilt picture, arrange Star blocks and Snowball blocks. Sew together. Quilt center should measure 36 1/2" X 60 1/2"

First Border

Sew 2 1/2" red plaid strips to top and bottom and sides. Quilt center should now measure 40 1/2" X 64 1/2"

Second Border

Sew 3 1/2" large beige print strips to top and bottom and sides. Quilt center should now measure 46 1/2" X 70 1/2"

Third Border


Sew 5 1/2" red plaid strips to top and bottom and sides. Quilt center should now measure 56 1/2" X 80 1/2"

Quilt and bind, as desired.
