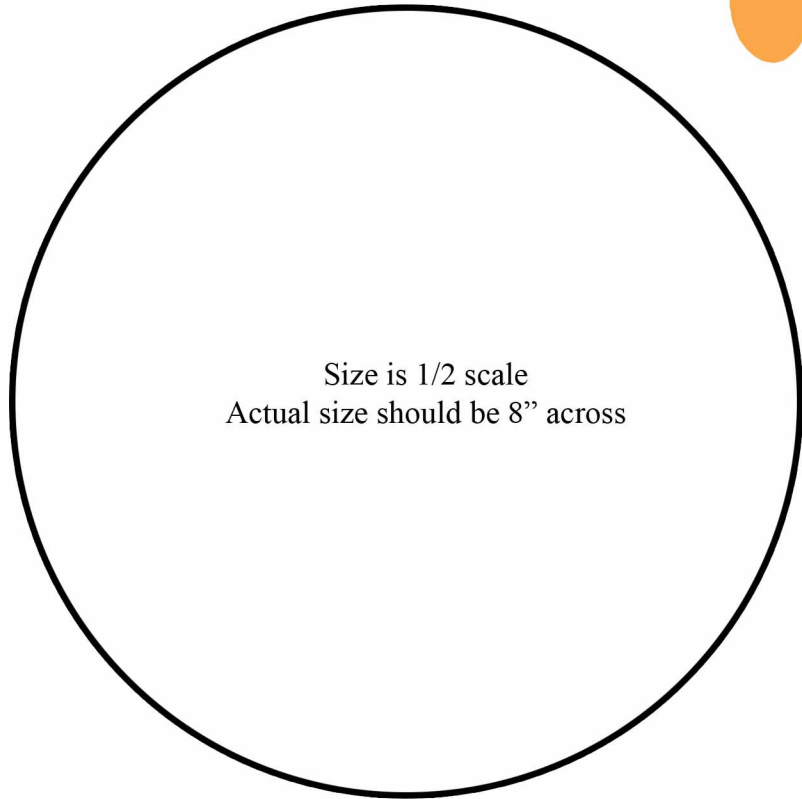
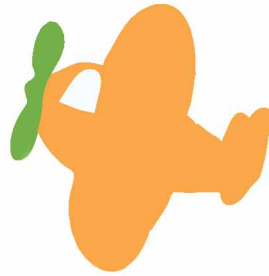


# Round About

# Round About

Quilt by Allison Jane Smith

Fabric from the Traffic Jam Collection by Allison Jane Smith

Quilt Size: 40" x 50"

## MATERIALS:

20 *Traffic Jam* fat Quarters

3/8 yard of a *Traffic Jam* print for binding

1-5/8 yards of a backing fabric

44" x 54" piece of batting

Fusible Web

## CUT:

From the fabrics, cut a total of:

(20) 10-1/2" squares

From the binding fabric cut:

(5) 2-1/2" x 42" binding strips

## THE QUILT:

Trace twenty (20) 8" circles from the template provided onto fusible web. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for use of the fusible web.

Cut around each circle approximately 1/4".

Press a circle onto the wrong side of each of the fabrics.

Cut the circle out exactly along the trace lines.

Remove the paper backing.

Place a circle centered on a 10-1/2" square, as shown in the diagram below.

Press in place.



Repeat with the remaining nineteen (19) circles.

Sew around each circle with a straight stitch, using clear or neutral color thread. Lay out the twenty (20) 10-1/2" squares, four (4) across and five (5) down.

Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, sew blocks together in each row.

Press.

Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

Press.

The quilt top should measure 40-1/2" x 50-1/2".

## FINISHING:

Layer the top, batting and backing.

Pin the layers together.

Quilt as desired.

Use the 2-1/2" x 42" strips to bind the quilt. Sew strips together to achieve desired length, fold over lengthwise and sew to quilt top. Turn binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.
