## Assembling the Quilt

Using the color photograph as your guide, please construct the following:

- Sew the blocks together in 3 blocks across and 3 blocks down alternating Blocks A & B.
- Finished pieced center should measure 30-1/2" x 30-1/2" square.
- Sew a yellow 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" border strip to each side of the quilt.
- Sew a yellow 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- Sew a pink 5-1/2" x 34-1/2" border strip to each side of the quilt.
- Sew a pink 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- Sew a yellow 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" border strip to each side of the quilt.
- Sew a yellow 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- Sew a blue floral 8-1/2" x 48-1/2" border strip to each side of the quilt.
- Sew a blue floral 8-1/2" x 64-1/2" border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.

## Finishing

Layer, quilt, scallop according to attached scallop template and bind as desired.

Yellow Inner Borders	27829-2	3/4 yd.
Pink Floral Middle Border	27826-1	1-1/3 yds.
Blue Floral Outer Border	27827-4	1/3-4 yds.
Backing		4 yds.
Bias Binding	27829-1	1 yd.

## **Cutting Directions**

From the **blue AND yellow basket block prints:**

- Cut (1) strip 4-7/8" x WOF and subcut into (3) 4-7/8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal.
- Cut (2) strips 2-7/8" x WOF and subcut into (15) 2-7/8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal.

From the **blue AND pink basket block prints:**

- Cut (2) strips 2-7/8" x WOF and subcut into (18) 2-7/8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal.

From the **blue basket block print:**

- Cut (3) strips 2-1/2" x WOF and subcut into (10) 2-1/2" squares AND (10) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.

From the **blue floral bouquet block print:**

- Fussycut (4) 10-1/2" squares making sure the large floral bouquet is centered.

From the **pink floral bouquet block print:**

- Cut (3) strips 5-1/2" x WOF and subcut into (16) 5-1/2" squares.

From the **yellow inner borders print:**

- Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" for the side borders.
- Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" for the top and bottom borders.
- Cut and piece (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" for the side borders.
- Cut and piece (2) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" for the top and bottom borders.

From the **pink floral middle border print:**

- Fussycut, lengthwise, (2) 5-1/2" x 34-1/2" for the side borders.
- Fussycut, lengthwise, (2) 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" for the top and bottom borders.

From the **blue floral outer border:**

- Cut and piece (2) 8-1/2" x 48-1/2" for the side borders.
- Cut and piece (2) 8-1/2" x 64-1/2" for the top and bottom borders.

## **Piecing the Blocks**

Block A: Basket Block

From the **blue and yellow basket block 4-7/8" squares cut on the diagonal:**

- Place a blue and yellow triangle right sides together and sew on the diagonal. Be careful not to stretch the fabric.
- Press open. Trim to 4-1/2" square for a half square triangle.
- Make 5.

From the **blue and yellow basket block 2-7/8" squares cut on the diagonal:**

- Place a blue and yellow triangle right sides together and sew on the diagonal. Be careful not to stretch the fabric.
- Press open. Trim to 2-1/2" square for a half square triangle.
- Make 30.
- Sew a blue and yellow half square triangle to each end of the (10) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" blue rectangles

From the **blue and pink basket block 2-7/8" squares cut on the diagonal:**

- Place a blue and pink triangle right sides together and sew on the diagonal. Be careful not to stretch the fabric.
- Press open. Trim to 2-1/2" square for a half square triangle.
- Make 35.

## **Constructing the Basket Blocks**

Using the color photograph as your guide and the above pieced units, construct the basket blocks.

- Block should measure 10-1/2" square.
- Make 5.

Block B: Floral Bouquet Block

From the **pink floral bouquet block print:**

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 5-1/2" square.
- Place above square, right sides together, on the upper left corner of the blue floral bouquet print.
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim ?" from the stitch line. Press open and repeat on the remaining three corners.
- Block should measure 10-1/2" square.
- Make 4.
