

Fabric Requirements:

1/2 yard each 39773-X Multi 31835 Solid White

Cutting and Assembly:

- 1. Following template provided, cut out (1) scalloped round in each of the fabrics.
- 2. With right sides together, sew around each scallop with a 1/4" seam allowance leaving a small portion open on the last scallop for turning. Before you turn, carefully clip around all curves and at the join of each scallop round so that each scallop will be smooth and round.
- 3. Turn and carefully press each scallop flat.
- 3. Turn back the seam allowance at the opening where you turned the centerpiece to the outside. Pin to hold the opening in place and slipstitch the opening closed.

You can now use your centerpiece to dress up a table for a party. May we suggest some cupcakes!
