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## **Fabric Requirements:**

From Garibaldi II fabric collection

1/4 yd. of the various prints

(Note: you will need full length 1/4 yards, not fat quarters).

1/4 yd. #25017-2 – corner triangles

1/2 yd. #25019-2 - sashing & inner border

1/2 yd. #25011-1 – second border

1/2 yd. #25015-2 - outer border

3 yds.#25015-1 - backing

1/2 yd. #25019-2 - binding

## **Spider Web Blocks:**

Make four 15" blocks (15-1/2" unfinished). For each block, cut:

(1)2-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strip of a dark print

(1)2-1/2" x WOF strip of a light print

(1)1-1/2" x WOF strip of a dark print

(1)1-1/2" x WOF strip of a light print

(1)1-1/2" x WOF strip of a dark print

(1)1-1/2" x WOF strip of a light print

Note: We used a different print for each strip to assure some value change between the strips and make the overall look more effective.

**Corner triangles:** (2) 6 -1/2" #25017-2, cut once on the diagonal. These will be oversized.

## **Block Assembly:**

Make strip sets, by sewing the strips together carefully with 1/4" seam allowance, in the following order:

Dark 2-1/2" strip; light 1-1/2" strip; dark 1-1/2" strip; light 1-1/2" strip; dark 1 -1/2" strip; light 2-1/2" strip.

Press all the seams in one direction being careful not to distort the strips while ironing. Now begin cutting 45 degree wedges from the strip set, rotating the ruler so the wide end is at the top, then flipping, so the wide end is at the bottom.

**NOTE:** You can use a standard quilt ruler, but this process is highly simplified by using a purchased "kaleidoscope wedge" ruler.

You will need 8 accurate cuts from your strip of fabric.

Arrange your wedges in a circle and sew them together two wedges at a time and carefully piece them matching seams. Sew them into groups of four and then one long seam down the middle, joining the eight wedges. You may want to press the center seam open in order to reduce bulk.

Sew corner triangles on, these will be oversized and will need to be trimmed to square your block to 15 -1/2" unfinished.

## **Sashings:**

Cut: (2) 2" x 15-1/2" strips,

(3) 2"x 32-1/2" strips

(2) 2" x 36-1/2" strips

## **Inner Border:**

Cut: (2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips & (2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" ..

## **Outer Border:**

Cut: (2) 4" x 38-1/2" strips & (2) 4" x 46"
